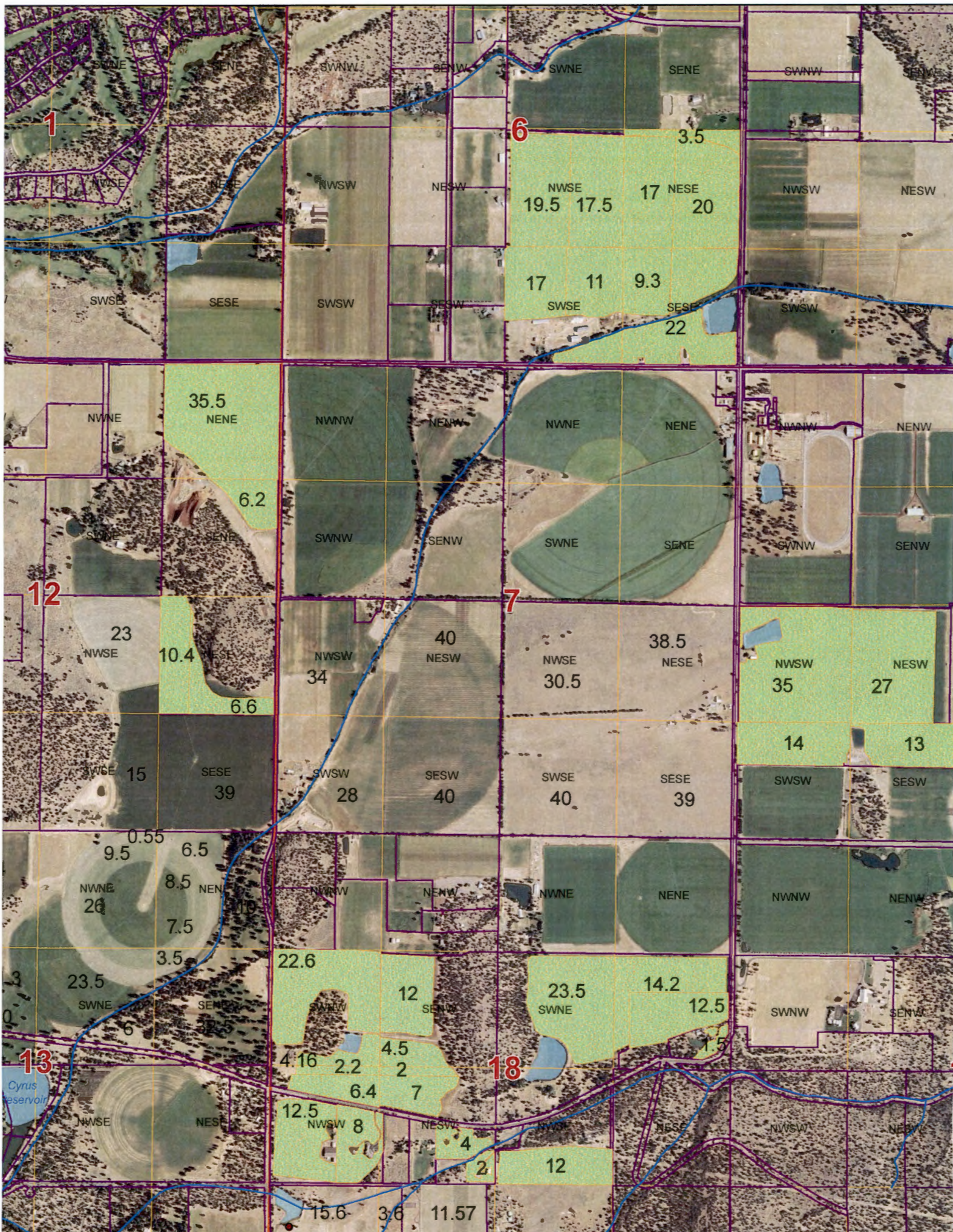

Permit to Appropriate the Public Waters of the State of Oregon

This is to certify that I have examined the foregoing application and do hereby grant the same, **SUBJECT TO EXISTING RIGHTS INCLUDING THE EXISTING MINIMUM FLOW POLICIES ESTABLISHED BY THE WATER POLICY REVIEW BOARD** and the following limitations and conditions:

The right herein granted is limited to the amount of water which can be applied to beneficial use and shall not exceed 7.4 cubic feet per second measured at the point of diversion from the well or source of appropriation, or its equivalent in case of rotation with other water users, from two wells.

The use to which this water is to be applied is irrigation and supplemental irrigation; being 1.5 c.f.s. from well # 1, and 5.9 c.f.s. from well # 2.

If for irrigation, this appropriation shall be limited to 1/80th of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year; provided further that the right allowed herein shall be limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land and shall not exceed the limitation allowed herein,

and shall be subject to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon.

The works constructed shall include an air line and pressure gauge or an access port for measuring line, adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times.


The permittee shall install and maintain a weir, meter, or other suitable measuring device, and shall keep a complete record of the amount of ground water withdrawn.

The priority date of this permit is August 1, 1977

Actual construction work shall begin on or before February 8, 1979 and shall thereafter be prosecuted with reasonable diligence and be completed on or before October 1, 1979




Complete application of the water to the proposed use shall be made on or before October 1, 1980

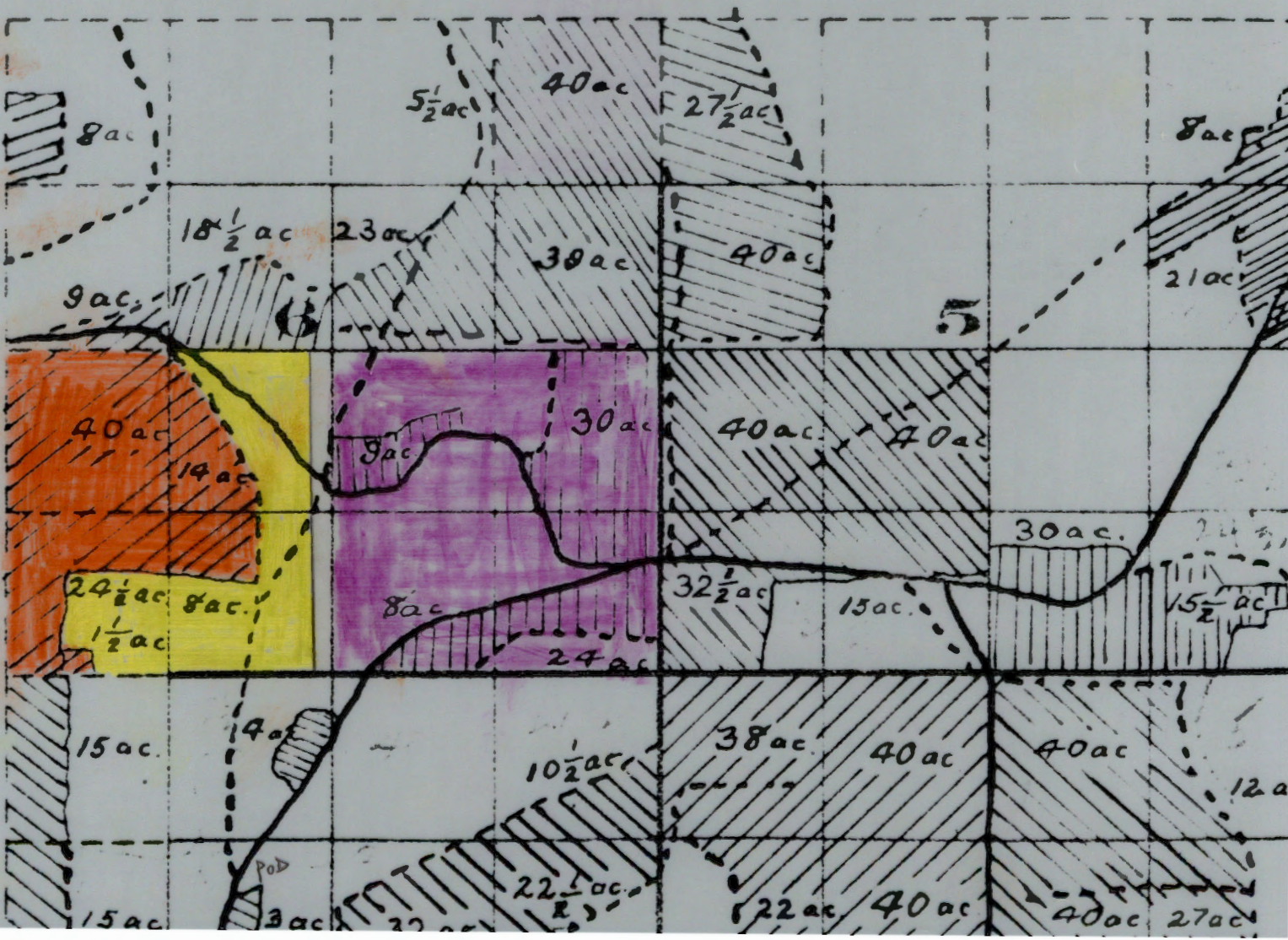

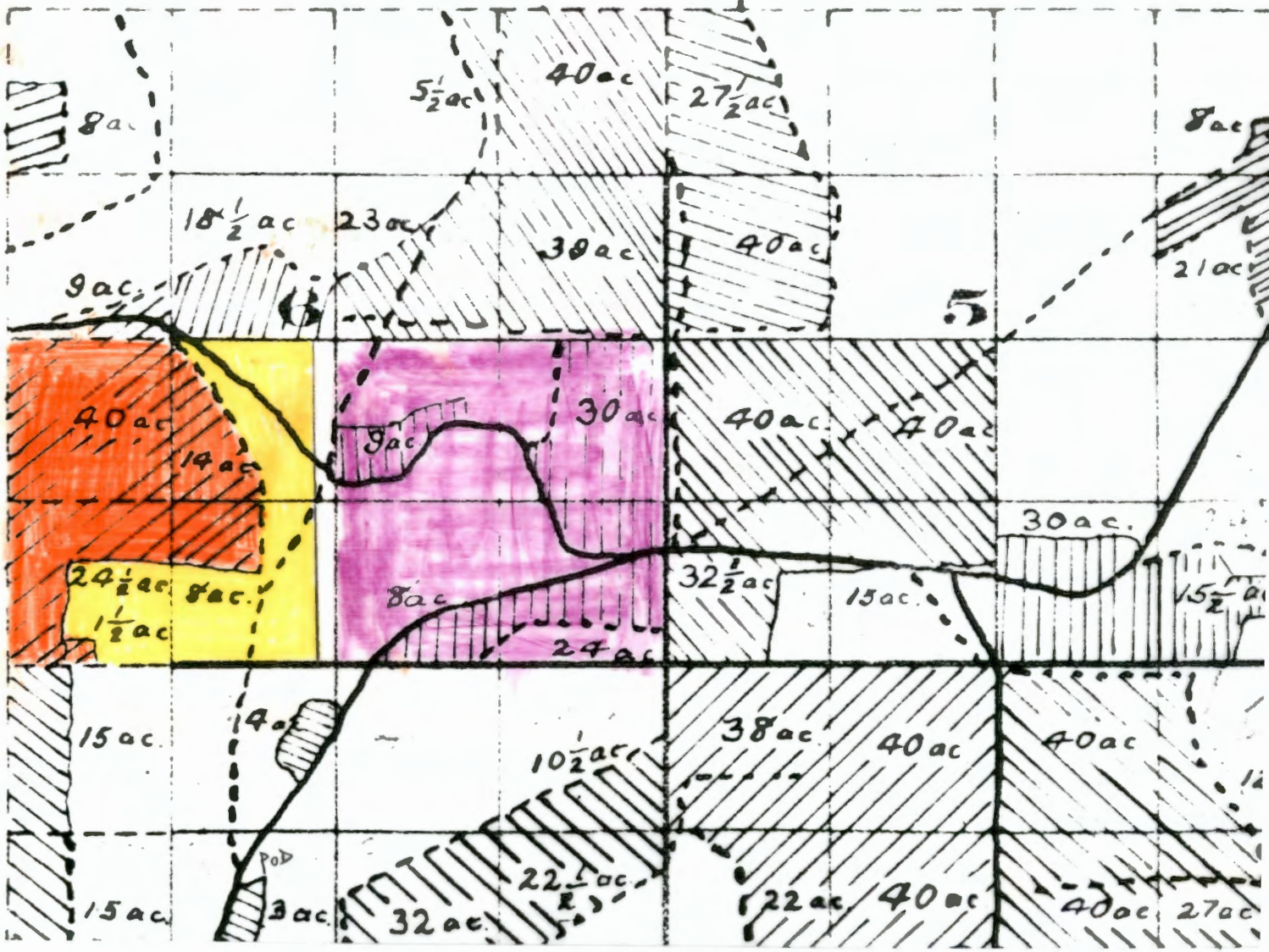

THIS AGREEMENT entered into this 12th day of August, ~~1979~~, ¹⁹⁸⁰ ~~7/1~~ between SQUAW CREEK IRRIGATION DISTRICT, hereinafter called "District", and KEITH CYRUS and ARLAND KEETON, hereinafter called "Cyrus and Keeton".

W I T N E S S E T H :

WHEREAS, District distributes water rights on property within the District through canal system including the main canal and the Cloverdale Ditch, and

WHEREAS, Cyrus and Keeton own and operate a well on their property adjacent to Cloverdale Ditch, and

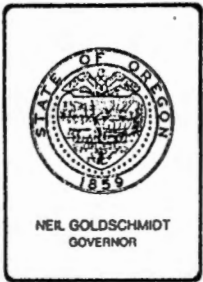
WHEREAS, the District and Cyrus and Keeton have been engaged in negotiations over placing the well water in the Cloverdale Ditch and issues concerned therewith, and

WHEREAS, the parties with the assistance of recommendation from a 3-man panel desire to enter into an agreement respecting this matter, now, therefore,

IN CONSIDERATION OF THE PROMISES, COVENANTS AND AGREEMENTS CONTAINED HEREIN, THE PARTIES AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

(1) Cyrus and Keeton agree to pay to District the sum of FIFTY CENTS (.50¢) per acre foot of well water that is delivered from the Cyrus and Keeton pump through the facilities of the District to lands of Cyrus and Keeton. Payment to be made by Cyrus and Keeton to the District upon presentation of billing from the District.

In order to deliver water to some of the lands included in the above mentioned permits, it is necessary to use the delivery system of the Squaw Creek Irrigation District.

To use this delivery system, you must have some agreement with the District regarding how the water will be distributed. This is especially critical for the lands which are upland from the wells.

The Final Proof will not include the lands which must use District canals to receive groundwater from your wells without some type of current written agreement.

- 1) We propose to measure the level in wells #1, #4, and #5 on or about March 1st of each year.
- 2) The stipulated well depth will be the depth measured in March of 2000.
- 3) Well depths will be measured using an eclectic tape.
- 4) The manufacturer's stated accuracy is to the 1/100 of a foot.
- 5) Measurement will be taken prior to starting the irrigation season. In any event, measurement will be taken after at least an hour of non-use.
- 6) Testing will be done by persons qualified and trained to use testing equipment.
- 7) Reports will be mailed to the Ground Water and Hydrology Section of the Oregon Water Resources Department on or before May 1 of each year.



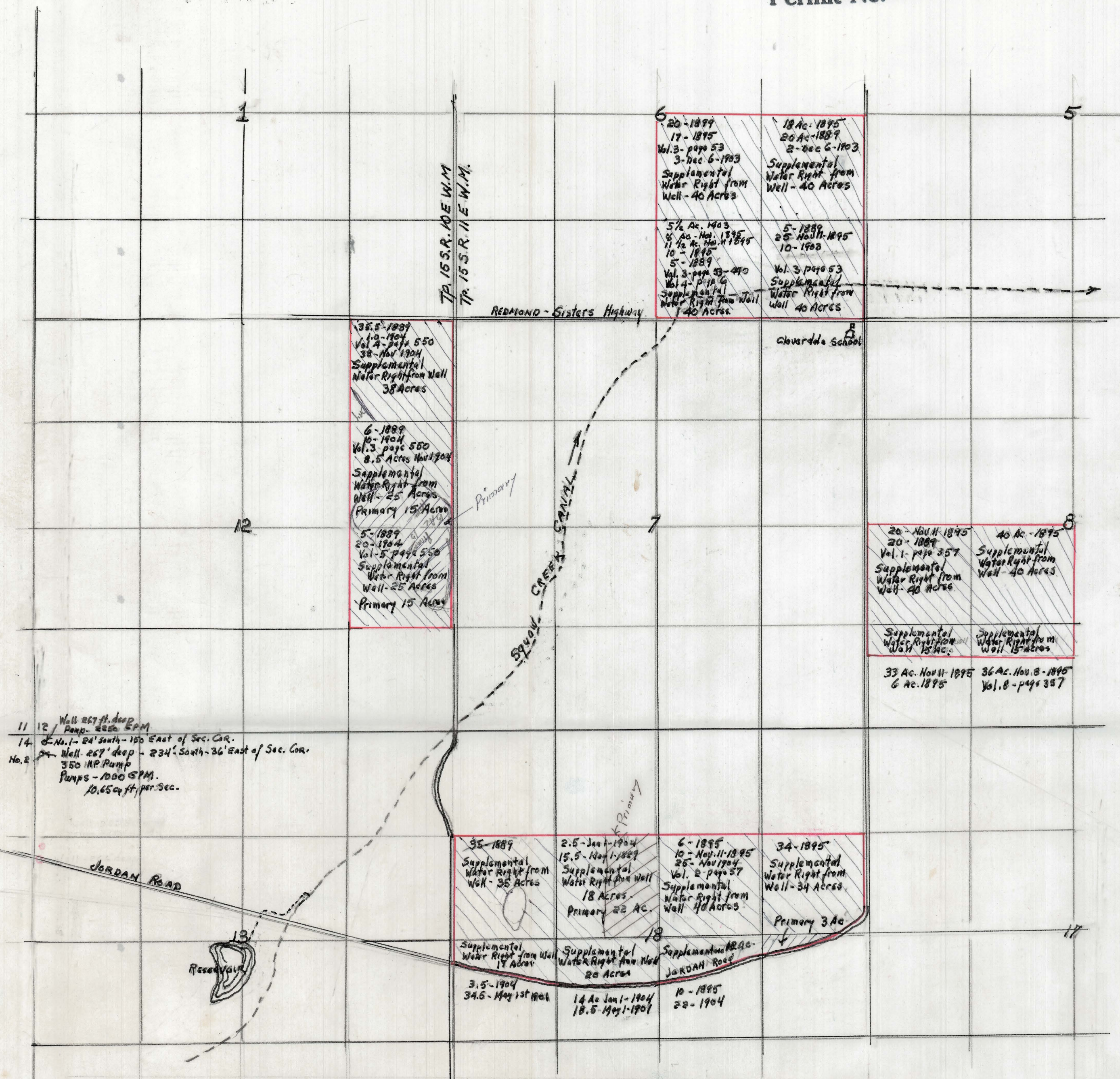

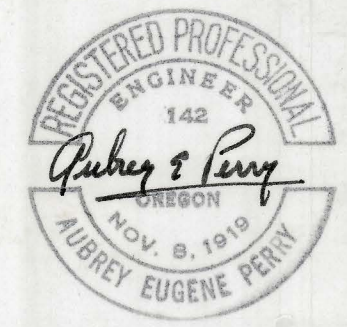
