The water user shall install, maintain, and operate fish screening and fish passage devices consistent with current Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) standards. Fish screening is to prevent fish from entering the proposed diversion, while passage devices provide adequate upstream and downstream passage for fish. The required screen and passage devices are to be in place and functional, and approved in writing by ODFW prior to diversion of water. The water user may submit evidence in writing that ODFW has determined screens and/or passage devices are not necessary.

If beneficial use of permitted water has not been made before this date, the permittee may submit an application for extension of time, which may be approved based upon the merit of the application.

HI John - I wanted to make sure I understood correctly. Are you "not" planning to move your existing surface water rights on the Little Applegate River to instream use and use BOR stored water in its place?

If you're not planning to complete the instream transfer application, you may not need to obtain a contract with the BOR and a permit from our Department to use stored water. You could continue to use your existing surface water rights from the Little Applegate River at the new POD you have on the mainstem Applegate River. We would also then move forward to deny the time-limited instream transfer application that's pending under the name of Robert and Linda Murphy.

Please let me know what you're thinking with regard the instream transfer part of this project and we can go from there. Also, please feel free to give me a call and we can talk through the process over the phone. I'll be in the office until 3pm today and should be in the office all day tomorrow (8am to 4:30).

I also understand that it takes Water Resources a considerable time to process such applications, but that there is an expedited option for an additional fee.

WHEREAS, The United States has constructed and operates Applegate and Lost Creek Reservoirs in the Rogue River Basin, Oregon, herein styled the Rogue River Basin Project, from which there is a flow of water that can be used for irrigation of land and other beneficial uses, which flow, as it has been developed or as it will be augmented, has been appropriated by the United States pursuant to the laws of Oregon for beneficial use under the Federal Reclamation Laws; and

3.25 acres, NE1/4 NE1/4, Section 4, T. 39 S., R. 3 W., W.M.

Of the land described, not more than <u>3.25</u> acres are to be irrigated. The amount of water to be released hereunder shall be that quantity which may be applied beneficially in accordance with good usage in the irrigation of the land above described, up to a maximum diversion of <u>10</u> acre-feet of stored water annually, measured at the point of diversion of said water.

#### **Payments for Water**

6. (a) An annual payment of \$\$0 for the first irrigation season shall be made to the United States at the time of executing this contract, and subsequent annual payments of \$80 will be due on or before April 1 of each succeeding irrigation season in advance of water use. This payment will entitle the Contractor to divert up to a maximum of <u>10</u> acre-feet of stored water for irrigation of the lands described in Article 5 of this contract. The Contracting Officer will consider adjusting the water service payment downward based on information received from the Contractor, the State of Oregon, or other reliable sources as to the actual amount of stored water diverted each month by the Contractor during the irrigation season and on other factors in addition to the amount of stored water actually diverted, as deemed appropriate by the Contracting Officer.

Any such adjustment will be determined and subtracted from the payment for the next year by the Contracting Officer: <u>Provided</u>, that for an adjustment to be made, information on the amounts of stored water diverted each month must be received in writing by the Contracting Officer by **December 1** of that year.

(b) The annual charge set forth in (a) above is based on an initial rate of <u>\$8</u> per acre-foot of stored water; <u>Provided</u>, that such annual charge shall as a minimum be the greater of either the product of <u>\$2</u> multiplied by the number of acres described in Article 5 of this contract or <u>\$50</u>. From time to time, but not less often than once every 5 years, the rate per acre-foot of stored water and the minimum payment shall be reviewed by the Contracting Officer and revised, if necessary, by the United States for the irrigation water marketing program of the Rogue River Basin Project. Any revision by the Contracting Officer will apply only to future payments and shall be announced by written notice to the Contractor at least 3 months prior to the beginning of the irrigation season to which the new rate would be applicable.

(c) All payments from the Contractor to the United States under this contract shall be made by the medium requested by the United States. The required medium of payment may include checks, wire transfers, or other types of payment specified by the United States. Except when otherwise specified by the United States, all payments shall be made by check.

(d) Upon execution of the contract, the Contractor shall furnish the Contracting Officer with the Contractor's taxpayer's identification number (TIN). The purpose for requiring the Contractor's TIN is for collecting and reporting any delinquent amounts arising out of the Contractor's relationship with the United States.

(e) Payments required hereunder shall be made to the Bureau of Reclamation at the location described in Article 16 of this contract.

#### Contract Administration Fee

7. (a) Upon execution of this contract, a \$100 fee for the preparation of this

contract is due and payable by the Contractor to the United States.

(b) All future contract actions, including new contracts, contract amendments,

supplements, and assignments will be charged a \$100 fee: Provided, that the fee shall be reviewed

by the Contracting Officer and revised from time to time to cover costs to the United States.

#### **Charges for Delinquent Payments**

8. (a) The Contractor shall be subject to interest, administrative, and penalty charges on delinquent payments. If a payment is not received by the due date, the Contractor shall pay an interest charge on the delinquent payment for each day the payment is delinquent beyond the due date. If a payment becomes 60 days delinquent, in addition to the interest charge, the Contractor shall pay an administrative charge to cover additional costs of billing and processing the delinquent payment. If a payment is delinquent 90 days or more, in addition to the interest and administrative charges, the Contractor shall pay a penalty charge for each day the payment is delinquent beyond the due date, based on the remaining balance of the payment due at the rate of 6 percent per year. The Contractor shall also pay any fees incurred for debt collection services associated with a delinquent payment.

(b) The interest charge rate shall be the greater of the rate prescribed quarterly in the <u>Federal Register</u> by the Department of the Treasury for application to overdue payments or the interest rate of 0.5 percent per month. The interest charge rate will be determined as of the due date and remain fixed for the duration of the delinquent period.

(c) When a partial payment on a delinquent account is received, the amount received shall be applied first to the penalty charges, second to the administrative charges, third to the accrued interest, and finally to the overdue payment.

#### Release of Water

9. (a) Upon payment of the annual payment specified in subarticle 6(a) above, the

United States will release water to the Contractor from the Rogue River Basin Project pursuant to

this contract. No water shall be released if the Contractor is delinquent in payment of the required

annual payment.

(b) Water diverted pursuant to this contract shall be measured at the following

point(s) of diversion in accordance with Oregon State lavv:

800 feet south and 650 feet west of northeast corner of Section 4, T. 39 S., R. 3 W., W.M.

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The Contractor shall be wholly responsible for securing said water at that point and diverting, conveying, and utilizing it. The Contractor shall be required to conform its diversions and releases to the control of the stream as established by the appropriate State-appointed watermaster. The water to be diverted hereunder shall be measured by means of measuring or controlling devices satisfactory to the Contracting Officer. Such devices shall be furnished, installed, and maintained by and at the expense of the Contractor, but they shall be and remain at all times available for reading and monitoring by the United States or the watermaster whose representative may at all times have access to them over any lands of the Contractor. All losses of water from seepage, evaporation, or other cause, below said point of measurement, shall be borne by the Contractor.

The Contractor shall maintain all fish screens used to divert stored water (c) under this contract at all times in compliance with applicable guidelines from the Oregon Department of Fish & Wildlife and the National Marine Fisheries Service and remain available at all times for inspection by representatives of these agencies at no cost to the United States.

The Contractor hereby acknowledges Reclamation's authority to conduct (d) periodic contract compliance reviews in accordance with Reclamation Manual Policy, Periodic Review of Water Deliveries with Respect to Contract Terms (WTR P08), and Reclamation Manual Directives and Standards, Periodic District Reviews of Water Deliveries with Respect to Contract Terms – Processing for Resolving Unauthorized Use (WTR 08-01).

#### **Special Conditions**

It is the responsibility of the Contractor to comply with the laws of the State 10. (a) of Oregon regarding the obtaining and perfecting of permits to divert water to the lands described in Article 5. Prior to executing this contract, the Contractor shall secure any easements from the RECEIVED BY OWRD

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Corps of Engineers which may be required for constructing facilities to divert and convey the stored water and provide written verification of such agreements to the Contracting Officer. The obligation of the United States to release water under this contract is subject to an operating plan for the Rogue River Basin Project determined in accordance with the law governing the project.

(b) If, at some future date, the Contracting Officer determines there is sufficient demand for irrigation water from the Rogue River Basin Project to justify the formation of an irrigation district, water supply company, or other water user organization, future water service may then be made contingent upon the establishment of such an organization. Under this condition, the Contractor will be notified at least 1 year in advance of the date this contract is terminated and continued water service to the lands described in Article 5 becomes dependent upon membership in the organization established for that purpose.

(c) In the interest of conservation and protection of environmental resources, from time to time, but not less often than once every 5 years, this contract shall be reviewed by the Contracting Officer. The terms and conditions of this contract may be modified, if deemed necessary by the Contracting Officer, to avoid or minimize impacts to candidate, listed or proposed threatened and endangered species, or other valuable natural resources. Any modification by the Contracting Officer shall be announced by written notice to the Contractor.

#### **Term of Contract**

11. This contract shall become effective as of the date first above written and will continue in effect for a period of 40 years unless sooner terminated in accordance with the provisions of Articles 10 or 12 or by agreement of the parties hereto: <u>Provided</u>; that upon expiration of the 40-year term, renewals may be made by the Secretary of the Interior for successive periods not to exceed 40 years and under terms and conditions mutually agreeable to the

<u>Provided further</u>; that the terms and conditions of each renewal shall be negotiated in light of circumstances prevailing at the time of renewal and agreed upon not later than 1 year prior to the expiration of the then existing contract.

#### **Termination of Contract**

12. This contract may be terminated and water service hereunder shall cease at the option of the United States or at any time if the Contractor is delinquent in payment of the water service charge for a period of 90 days or upon failure of the Contractor to abide by any notice, order, rule, or regulation of the United States or the State of Oregon now or hereafter established affecting water service hereunder.

#### **Constraints on the Availability of Water (Water Shortages)**

13. In its operation of the Project, the United States will use all reasonable means to guard against a Condition of Shortage in the quantity of water to be made available to the Contractor pursuant to this Contract. In the event the United States determines that a Condition of Shortage appears probable, the Contracting Officer will notify the Contractor of said determination as soon as practicable.

If there is a Condition of Shortage because of errors in physical operations of the Project, drought, other physical causes beyond the control of the United States, or actions taken by the Contracting Officer to meet current and future legal obligations, then no liability shall accrue against the United States or any of its officers, agents or employees for any damage, direct or indirect, arising there from.

#### **Title To Project Works**

14. Title to all of the Rogue River Basin Project and associated works shall be and

remain in the United States until otherwise provided for by the Congress.

#### **Disclaimer**

15. No provision of this contract, nor of any renevval thereof, nor the release of water

hereunder will be construed to bind the United States after the expiration of this contract as the

basis of a permanent water right. Because of possible fluctuations in reservoir surface elevations

and downstream flows associated with the Rogue River Basin Project, the United States does not

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guarantee the availability of water at the point of the Contractor's diversion facilities as they may now be constructed or constructed hereafter. Further, the United States will not be held responsible for any acts or omissions of the Contractor's agents or of persons for whom water is released.

#### **Notices**

16. Any notice, demand, or request authorized or required by this contract shall be deemed to have been given, on behalf of the Contractor, when mailed, postage prepaid, or delivered to the Program Manager, Repayment and Acreage Limitation, Pacific Northwest Region, Bureau of Reclamation, 1150 N. Curtis Road, Suite 100, Boise, ID 83706-1234, and on behalf of the United States, when mailed, postage prepaid, or delivered to <u>The ITALIAN Trust, c/o John or</u> <u>Bonnie Rinaldi, 375 Hamilton Road, Jacksonville, OR 97530</u>. The designation of the addressee or the address may be changed by notice given in the same manner as provided in this article for other notices.

#### GENERAL PROVISIONS --- ROGUE RIVER BASIN PROJECT

#### GENERAL OBLIGATION-BENEFITS CONDITIONED UPON PAYMENT

(a). (1) The obligation of the Contractor to pay the United States as provided in this contract is a general obligation of the Contractor notwithstanding the manner in which the obligation may be distributed among the Contractor's water users and notwithstanding the default of individual water users in their obligation to the Contractor.

(2) The payment of charges becoming due pursuant to this contract is a condition precedent to receiving benefits under this contract. The Contractor shall not deliver water under the terms and conditions of this contract for lands or parties that are in arrears in the advance payment of water rates as levied or established by the Contractor.

#### CONTINGENT UPON APPROPRIATION OR ALLOTMENT OF FUNDS

(b). The expenditure or advance of any money or the performance of any obligation of the United States under this contract shall be contingent upon appropriation or allotment of funds. Absence of appropriation or allotment of funds shall not relieve the Contractor from any obligations under this contract. No liability shall accrue to the United States in case funds are not appropriated or allotted.

#### OFFICIALS NOT TO BENEFIT

(c). No Member of or Delegate to the Congress, Resident Commissioner, or official of the Contractor shall benefit from this contract other than as a water user or landowner in the same manner as other water users or landowners.

#### ASSIGNMENT LIMITED--SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS OBLIGATION

(d). The provisions of this contract shall apply to and bind the successors and assigns of the parties hereto, but no assignment or transfer of this contract or any right or interest therein by either party shall be valid until approved in writing by the other party.

#### BOOKS, RECORDS, AND REPORTS

(e). The Contractor shall establish and maintain accounts and other books and records pertaining to administration of the terms and conditions of this contract, including the Contractor's financial transactions; water supply data; project operation, maintenance, and replacement logs; project land and rights-of-way use agreements; the water users' land-use (crop census), land-ownership, land-leasing, and water-use data; and other matters that the Contracting Officer may require. Reports shall be furnished to the Contracting Officer in such form and on such date or dates as the Contracting Officer may require. Subject to applicable Federal laws and regulations, each party to this contract shall have the right during office hours to examine and make copies of the other party's books and records relating to matters covered by this contract.

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#### COMPLIANCE WITH FEDERAL RECLAMATION LAWS

(f). The parties agree that the delivery of irrigation water or use of Federal facilities pursuant to this contract is subject to Federal reclamation law, including but not limited to the Reclamation Reform Act of 1982 (43 U.S.C. 390aa *et seq.*), as amended and supplemented, and the rules and regulations promulgated by the Secretary of the Interior under Federal reclamation law.

#### PROTECTION OF WATER AND AIR QUALITY

(g). (1) Project facilities used to make available and deliver water to the Contractor shall be operated and maintained in the most practical manner to maintain the quality of the water at the highest level possible as determined by the Contracting Officer: <u>Provided</u>, That the United States does not warrant the quality of the water delivered to the Contractor and is under no obligation to furnish or construct water treatment facilities to maintain or improve the quality of water delivered to the Contractor.

(2) The Contractor shall comply with all applicable water and air pollution laws and regulations of the United States and the State of Oregon and shall obtain all required permits or licenses from the appropriate Federal, State, or local authorities necessary for the delivery of water by the Contractor; and shall be responsible for compliance with all Federal, State, and local water quality standards applicable to surface and subsurface drainage and/or discharges generated through the use of Federal or Contractor facilities or project water provided by the Contractor within the Contractor's Project Water Service Area.

(3) This article shall not affect or alter any legal obligations of the Secretary to provide drainage or other discharge services.

#### WATER CONSERVATION

(h). Prior to the delivery of water provided from or conveyed through federally constructed or federally financed facilities pursuant to this contract, the Contractor shall develop a water conservation plan, as required by Section 210(b) of the Reclamation Reform Act of 1982 and 43 C.F.R. 427.1 (Water Conservation Rules and Regulations).

#### EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY

(i). During the performance of this contract, the Contractor agrees as follows:

(1) The Contractor will not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of race, color, religion, sex, disability, or national origin. The Contractor will take affirmative action to ensure that applicants are employed, and that employees are treated during employment, without regard to their race, color, religion, sex, disability, or national origin. (5) The Contractor will furnish all information and reports required by EO 11246, and by the rules, regulations, and orders of the Secretary of Labor, or pursuant thereto, and will permit access to his books, records, and accounts by the Contracting Agency and the Secretary of Labor for purposes of investigation to ascertain compliance with such rules, regulations, and orders.

(6) In the event of the Contractor's noncompliance with the nondiscrimination clauses of this contract or with any of such rules, regulations, or orders, this contract may be canceled, terminated or suspended in whole or in part and the Contractor may be declared ineligible for further Government contracts in accordance with procedures authorized in EO 11246, and such other sanctions may be imposed and remedies invoked as provided in EO 11246, or by rule, regulation, or order of the Secretary of Labor, or as otherwise provided by law.





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

### CONTRACT FOR WATER SERVICE

THIS CONTRACT, made this <u>18<sup>th</sup></u> day of <u>December</u>, <u>2013</u>, pursuant to section 9(e) of the Act of August 4, 1939 (53 Stat. 1187) and section 8 of the Act of December 22, 1944 (58 Stat. 887, 891) (which acts are commonly known and referred to as the Reclamation Laws), and the Flood Control Act of 1962 (76 Stat. 1173), between the UNITED STATES OF AMERICA, hereinafter referred to as the United States, represented by the Contracting Officer executing this contract, and <u>The ITALIAN Trust</u>, hereinafter referred to as the Contractor;

WITNESSETH, THAT:

#### **Explanatory Recitals**

2. WHEREAS, The United States has constructed and operates Applegate and Lost Creek Reservoirs in the Rogue River Basin, Oregon, herein styled the Rogue River Basin Project, from which there is a flow of water that can be used for irrigation of land and other beneficial uses, which flow, as it has been developed or as it will be augmented, has been appropriated by the United States pursuant to the laws of Oregon for beneficial use under the Federal Reclamation Laws; and

3. WHEREAS, Reclamation has met all environmental compliance requirements for the execution of this contract through preparation and issuance of Categorical Exclusion Checklist, 2013-CCAO-59C, approved on July 24, 2013; and

4. WHEREAS, the Contractor owns land hereinafter described, for which a water supply from Applegate Reservoir is desired to be secured from the United States;

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the premises and the payment by the Contractor to the United States of the charges in the manner hereinafter provided, it is agreed:

#### Lands for Which Water is Released: Limitations on Diversions

5. The United States shall release each year to the Contractor during the irrigation season from April 1 to October 31, inclusive, water from the Rogue River Basin Project for the irrigation of land owned by the Contractor described as follows:

3.25 acres, NE1/4 NE1/4, Section 4, T. 39 S., R. 3 W., W.M.

Of the land described, not more than 3.25 acres are to be irrigated. The amount of water to be released hereunder shall be that quantity which may be applied beneficially in accordance with good usage in the irrigation of the land above described, up to a maximum diversion of 10 acre-feet of stored water annually, measured at the point of diversion of said water.

#### **Payments for Water**

6. (a) An annual payment of \$80 for the first irrigation season shall be made to the United States at the time of executing this contract, and subsequent annual payments of \$80 will be due on or before April 1 of each succeeding irrigation season in advance of water use. This payment will entitle the Contractor to divert up to a maximum of 10 acre-feet of stored water for irrigation of the lands described in Article 5 of this contract. The Contracting Officer will consider adjusting the water service payment downward based on information received from the Contractor, the State of Oregon, or other reliable sources as to the actual amount of stored water diverted each month by the Contractor during the irrigation season and on other factors in addition to the amount of stored water actually diverted, as deemed appropriate by the Contracting Officer. Any such adjustment will be determined and subtracted from the payment for the next year by the Contracting Officer: <u>Provided</u>, that for an adjustment to be made, information on the amounts of stored water diverted each month must be received in writing by the Contracting Officer by **December 1** of that year.

(b) The annual charge set forth in (a) above is based on an initial rate of <u>\$8</u> per acre-foot of stored water; <u>Provided</u>, that such annual charge shall as a minimum be the greater of either the product of <u>\$2</u> multiplied by the number of acres described in Article 5 of this contract or <u>\$50</u>. From time to time, but not less often than once every 5 years, the rate per acre-foot of stored water and the minimum payment shall be reviewed by the Contracting Officer and revised, if necessary, by the United States for the irrigation water marketing program of the Rogue River Basin Project. Any revision by the Contracting Officer will apply only to future payments and shall be announced by written notice to the Contractor at least 3 months prior to the beginning of the irrigation season to which the new rate would be applicable.

(c) All payments from the Contractor to the United States under this contract shall be made by the medium requested by the United States. The required medium of payment may include checks, wire transfers, or other types of payment specified by the United States. Except when otherwise specified by the United States, all payments shall be made by check.

(d) Upon execution of the contract, the Contractor shall furnish the Contracting Officer with the Contractor's taxpayer's identification number (TIN). The purpose for requiring the Contractor's TIN is for collecting and reporting any delinquent amounts arising out of the Contractor's relationship with the United States.

(e) Payments required hereunder shall be made to the Bureau of Reclamation at the location described in Article 16 of this contract.

# **Contract Administration Fee**

7. (a) Upon execution of this contract, a \$100 fee for the preparation of this

contract is due and payable by the Contractor to the United States.

(b) All future contract actions, including new contracts, contract amendments,

supplements, and assignments will be charged a \$100 fee: Provided, that the fee shall be reviewed

by the Contracting Officer and revised from time to time to cover costs to the United States.

# **Charges for Delinquent Payments**

8. (a) The Contractor shall be subject to interest, administrative, and penalty charges on delinquent payments. If a payment is not received by the due date, the Contractor shall pay an interest charge on the delinquent payment for each day the payment is delinquent beyond the due date. If a payment becomes 60 days delinquent, in addition to the interest charge, the Contractor shall pay an administrative charge to cover additional costs of billing and processing the delinquent payment. If a payment is delinquent 90 days or more, in addition to the interest and administrative charges, the Contractor shall pay a penalty charge for each day the payment is delinquent beyond the due date, based on the remaining balance of the payment due at the rate of 6 percent per year. The Contractor shall also pay any fees incurred for debt collection services associated with a delinquent payment.

(b) The interest charge rate shall be the greater of the rate prescribed quarterly in the <u>Federal Register</u> by the Department of the Treasury for application to overdue payments or the interest rate of 0.5 percent per month. The interest charge rate will be determined as of the due date and remain fixed for the duration of the delinquent period.

(c) When a partial payment on a delinquent account is received, the amount received shall be applied first to the penalty charges, second to the administrative charges, third to the accrued interest, and finally to the overdue payment.

# **Release of Water**

9. (a) Upon payment of the annual payment specified in subarticle 6(a) above, the United States will release water to the Contractor from the Rogue River Basin Project pursuant to this contract. No water shall be released if the Contractor is delinquent in payment of the required annual payment.

(b) Water diverted pursuant to this contract shall be measured at the following

point(s) of diversion in accordance with Oregon State law:

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800 feet south and 650 feet west of northeast corner of Section 4, T. 39 S., R. 3 W., W.M.

The Contractor shall be wholly responsible for securing said water at that point and diverting, conveying, and utilizing it. The Contractor shall be required to conform its diversions and releases to the control of the stream as established by the appropriate State-appointed watermaster. The water to be diverted hereunder shall be measured by means of measuring or controlling devices satisfactory to the Contracting Officer. Such devices shall be furnished, installed, and maintained by and at the expense of the Contractor, but they shall be and remain at all times available for reading and monitoring by the United States or the watermaster whose representative may at all times have access to them over any lands of the Contractor. All losses of water from seepage, evaporation, or other cause, below said point of measurement, shall be borne by the Contractor.

(c) The Contractor shall maintain all fish screens used to divert stored water under this contract at all times in compliance with applicable guidelines from the Oregon Department of Fish & Wildlife and the National Marine Fisheries Service and remain available at all times for inspection by representatives of these agencies at no cost to the United States.

(d) The Contractor hereby acknowledges Reclamation's authority to conduct periodic contract compliance reviews in accordance with Reclamation Manual Policy, *Periodic Review of Water Deliveries with Respect to Contract Terms* (WTR P08), and Reclamation Manual Directives and Standards, *Periodic District Reviews of Water Deliveries with Respect to Contract Terms – Processing for Resolving Unauthorized Use* (WTR 08-01).

#### **Special Conditions**

10. (a) It is the responsibility of the Contractor to comply with the laws of the State of Oregon regarding the obtaining and perfecting of permits to divert water to the lands described in Article 5. Prior to executing this contract, the Contractor shall secure any easements from the

Corps of Engineers which may be required for constructing facilities to divert and convey the stored water and provide written verification of such agreements to the Contracting Officer. The obligation of the United States to release water under this contract is subject to an operating plan for the Rogue River Basin Project determined in accordance with the law governing the project.

(b) If, at some future date, the Contracting Officer determines there is sufficient demand for irrigation water from the Rogue River Basin Project to justify the formation of an irrigation district, water supply company, or other water user organization, future water service may then be made contingent upon the establishment of such an organization. Under this condition, the Contractor will be notified at least 1 year in advance of the date this contract is terminated and continued water service to the lands described in Article 5 becomes dependent upon membership in the organization established for that purpose.

(c) In the interest of conservation and protection of environmental resources, from time to time, but not less often than once every 5 years, this contract shall be reviewed by the Contracting Officer. The terms and conditions of this contract may be modified, if deemed necessary by the Contracting Officer, to avoid or minimize impacts to candidate, listed or proposed threatened and endangered species, or other valuable natural resources. Any modification by the Contracting Officer shall be announced by written notice to the Contractor.

#### Term of Contract

11. This contract shall become effective as of the date first above written and will continue in effect for a period of 40 years unless sooner terminated in accordance with the provisions of Articles 10 or 12 or by agreement of the parties hereto: <u>Provided</u>; that upon expiration of the 40-year term, renewals may be made by the Secretary of the Interior for successive periods not to exceed 40 years and under terms and conditions mutually agreeable to the

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<u>Provided further</u>; that the terms and conditions of each renewal shall be negotiated in light of circumstances prevailing at the time of renewal and agreed upon not later than 1 year prior to the expiration of the then existing contract.

# **Termination of Contract**

12. This contract may be terminated and water service hereunder shall cease at the option of the United States or at any time if the Contractor is delinquent in payment of the water service charge for a period of 90 days or upon failure of the Contractor to abide by any notice, order, rule, or regulation of the United States or the State of Oregon now or hereafter established affecting water service hereunder.

# Constraints on the Availability of Water (Water Shortages)

13. In its operation of the Project, the United States will use all reasonable means to guard against a Condition of Shortage in the quantity of water to be made available to the Contractor pursuant to this Contract. In the event the United States determines that a Condition of Shortage appears probable, the Contracting Officer will notify the Contractor of said determination as soon as practicable.

If there is a Condition of Shortage because of errors in physical operations of the Project, drought, other physical causes beyond the control of the United States, or actions taken by the Contracting Officer to meet current and future legal obligations, then no liability shall accrue against the United States or any of its officers, agents or employees for any damage, direct or indirect, arising there from.

# **Title To Project Works**

14. Title to all of the Rogue River Basin Project and associated works shall be and

remain in the United States until otherwise provided for by the Congress.

# Disclaimer

15. No provision of this contract, nor of any renewal thereof, nor the release of water

hereunder will be construed to bind the United States after the expiration of this contract as the

basis of a permanent water right. Because of possible fluctuations in reservoir surface elevations

and downstream flows associated with the Rogue River Basin Project, the United States does not

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guarantee the availability of water at the point of the Contractor's diversion facilities as they may now be constructed or constructed hereafter. Further, the United States will not be held responsible for any acts or omissions of the Contractor's agents or of persons for whom water is released.

16. Any notice, demand, or request authorized or required by this contract shall be deemed to have been given, on behalf of the Contractor, when mailed, postage prepaid, or delivered to the Program Manager, Repayment and Acreage Limitation, Pacific Northwest Region, Bureau of Reclamation, 1150 N. The designation of the addressee or the address may be changed by notice given in the same manner as provided in this article for other notices.

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#### **GENERAL PROVISIONS --- ROGUE RIVER BASIN PROJECT**

#### **GENERAL OBLIGATION--BENEFITS CONDITIONED UPON PAYMENT**

(a). (1) The obligation of the Contractor to pay the United States as provided in this contract is a general obligation of the Contractor notwithstanding the manner in which the obligation may be distributed among the Contractor's water users and notwithstanding the default of individual water users in their obligation to the Contractor.

(2) The payment of charges becoming due pursuant to this contract is a condition precedent to receiving benefits under this contract. The Contractor shall not deliver water under the terms and conditions of this contract for lands or parties that are in arrears in the advance payment of water rates as levied or established by the Contractor.

#### CONTINGENT UPON APPROPRIATION OR ALLOTMENT OF FUNDS

(b). The expenditure or advance of any money or the performance of any obligation of the United States under this contract shall be contingent upon appropriation or allotment of funds. Absence of appropriation or allotment of funds shall not relieve the Contractor from any obligations under this contract. No liability shall accrue to the United States in case funds are not appropriated or allotted.

#### OFFICIALS NOT TO BENEFIT

(c). No Member of or Delegate to the Congress, Resident Commissioner, or official of the Contractor shall benefit from this contract other than as a water user or landowner in the same manner as other water users or landowners.

#### ASSIGNMENT LIMITED--SUCCESSORS AND ASSIGNS OBLIGATION

(d). The provisions of this contract shall apply to and bind the successors and assigns of the parties hereto, but no assignment or transfer of this contract or any right or interest therein by either party shall be valid until approved in writing by the other party.

#### BOOKS, RECORDS, AND REPORTS

(e). The Contractor shall establish and maintain accounts and other books and records pertaining to administration of the terms and conditions of this contract, including the Contractor's financial transactions; water supply data; project operation, maintenance, and replacement logs; project land and rights-of-way use agreements; the water users' land-use (crop census), land-ownership, land-leasing, and water-use data; and other matters that the Contracting Officer may require. Reports shall be furnished to the Contracting Officer in such form and on such date or dates as the Contracting Officer may require. Subject to applicable Federal laws and regulations, each party to this contract shall have the right during office hours to examine and make copies of the other party's books and records relating to matters covered by this contract.

#### COMPLIANCE WITH FEDERAL RECLAMATION LAWS

(f). The parties agree that the delivery of irrigation water or use of Federal facilities pursuant to this contract is subject to Federal reclamation law, including but not limited to the Reclamation Reform Act of 1982 (43 U.S.C. 390aa *et seq.*), as amended and supplemented, and the rules and regulations promulgated by the Secretary of the Interior under Federal reclamation law.

#### PROTECTION OF WATER AND AIR QUALITY

(g). (1) Project facilities used to make available and deliver water to the Contractor shall be operated and maintained in the most practical manner to maintain the quality of the water at the highest level possible as determined by the Contracting Officer: <u>Provided</u>, That the United States does not warrant the quality of the water delivered to the Contractor and is under no obligation to furnish or construct water treatment facilities to maintain or improve the quality of water delivered to the Contractor.

(2) The Contractor shall comply with all applicable water and air pollution laws and regulations of the United States and the State of Oregon and shall obtain all required permits or licenses from the appropriate Federal, State, or local authorities necessary for the delivery of water by the Contractor; and shall be responsible for compliance with all Federal, State, and local water quality standards applicable to surface and subsurface drainage and/or discharges generated through the use of Federal or Contractor facilities or project water provided by the Contractor within the Contractor's Project Water Service Area.

(3) This article shall not affect or alter any legal obligations of the Secretary to provide drainage or other discharge services.

#### WATER CONSERVATION

(h). Prior to the delivery of water provided from or conveyed through federally constructed or federally financed facilities pursuant to this contract, the Contractor shall develop a water conservation plan, as required by Section 210(b) of the Reclamation Reform Act of 1982 and 43 C.F.R. 427.1 (Water Conservation Rules and Regulations).

#### EQUAL EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITY

(i). During the performance of this contract, the Contractor agrees as follows:

(1) The Contractor will not discriminate against any employee or applicant for employment because of race, color, religion, sex, disability, or national origin. The Contractor will take affirmative action to ensure that applicants are employed, and that employees are treated during employment, without regard to their race, color, religion, sex, disability, or national origin. By executing this contract, the Contractor agrees to immediately take any measures necessary to implement this obligation, including permitting officials of the United States to inspect premises, programs, and documents.

JESSE L SWORD, herinafter referred to as "SWORD". A legal description for Sword's real property is attached hereto as Exhibit "C" and by this reference incorporated herein.

JACK W. FITCH and MARCIA E. FITCH, husband and wife, herinafter referred to as "FITCH". A legal description for the Fitchs' real property is attached hereto as Exhibit "D" and by this reference incorporated herein.

WILLIE L. RATILUFF, Trustee of the Willie L. Ratiluff Trust, herinafter referred to as "RATILUFF". A legal description for Ratiluff's real property is attached hereto as Exhibit "E" and by this reference incorporated herein.

A map showing the location of the point of diversion from the Applegate River, the group intigation main pipeline, the main pump station, the booster pump station and the point of connections with the PARTIES' real properties is attached hereto as Exhibit "F" and by this reference incorporated herein.

For the reasons recited above and in consideration of the following mutual promises and covenants, the PARTIES hereby agree as follows:

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A. Each PARTY hereby grants to the others a non-exclusive, perpetual easement over and across each PARTY'S respective parcel for the purpose of constructing, operating, repairing and maintaining pump stations and a buried intigation mainline. This easement shall be over and across the real properties described in Exhibits "A", "B", "C", "D" and "E" and shall be for the benefit of the real properties described in "Exhibits "A", "B", "C", "D" and "E". The easement shall be ten (10) feet in width the centerline of which shall be the underground pipeline in the approximate location shown on the map attached as Exhibit "F". Except for the rights granted herein the PARTIES shall have the full use and control of their respective real properties.

B. The PARTIES shall have all rights of ingress and egress to and from this easement, including the right to cut, remove, or trim all vegetation, excepting trees with a diameter of greater than 5 inches (as measured at 4.5 feet above the ground) necessary for the PARTIES' use, operation and maintenance of the easement hereby granted, and all rights and privileges incident thereto. To realize the ingress and egress provisions in this easement, a PARTY must give notice to the other PARTY at least twenty-four hours in advance, excepting emergencies, in which case the PARTIES will give as much notice as possible.

The PARTIES agree not to plant any trees or shrubs, to construct any building or other obstruction in the right-of-way of the easement. The PARTIES agree to install a ten-foot wide gate in any future fencing that crosses the easement, and to provide the other PARTIES with keys to any such gate.

C. The imigation system installed on this easement will be connected to the on-farm systems of the PARTIES and its use shall be shared amongst the PARTIES.

D. Each PARTY agrees to indemnify and hold any other PARTY or PARTIES harmless from any loss, claim or flability resulting from that PARTY'S use of the easement located on another PARTY'S real property. Each PARTY assumes all risk arising out of their use of the easement and each PARTY shall have no liability to the other PARTY or PARTIES or others for any condition or hazard existing on their respective real properties. However, each PARTY agrees to maintain comprehensive public liability insurance in the amount of at least \$300,000.00.

E. This easement shall be appurtenant to the real properties described in Exhibits "A", "B", "C", "D" and "E". In the event of any subdivision or sale of all or any portion of such property this easement shall remain appurtenant to all of the parcels that such property may be divided into.

F. Each PARTY acknowledges that it will be their responsibility to maintain their own respective water rights with the State of Oregon. All PARTIES will operate the aforementioned pump station in accordance with Oregon water law. If the Oregon Water Resources Department terminates the water right(s) attached the property of any of the PARTIES pertaining to this easement, then the rights of the affected PARTY under this easement, including access to water delivered by this irrigation system, will terminate.

G. The cost of routine maintenance and repair of the irrigation system installed on this easement shall be shared amongst the PARTIES pursuant to a percentage basis. This shall be broken down into two parts. The first part shall be the portion of the easement up to but not including the booster pump. This shall be shared by all five PARTIES according to the following percentage: Janet Barker, 27.2%; Jesse L. Sword, 11.9%; Jack W. Fitch and Marcia E. Fitch, 20.4%; Willie L. Ratiluff Trust, 13.6%; Howard R. Juul and Diane M. Juul, 26.9%. That portion of the easement leading from the booster pump on shall be shared by the following PARTIES according to the following percentages: Janet Barker, 23.1%; Jack W. Fitch and Marcia E. Fitch, 46.1%; Willie L. Ratiluff Trust, 30.8%.

H. The noise level due to the operation of the pump station, measured a distance of 25 feet from the pumps should not exceed 65 decibels (db), hereinafter the "sound threshold". If said sound threshold is exceeded, the offended PARTY may require that the pump station cease operation until the other PARTIES demonstrate to the offended PARTY that further operation of the pump will not exceed the sound threshold. The PARTIES shall install, or have installed, and maintain, noise suppression devices around the irrigation pump stations located in the easement to insure that said sound threshold is not exceeded.

I. If the rights of any individual PARTY expires as a result of the failure of that PARTY to comply with the terms and conditions of this Agreement, the rights of the other PARTIES shall continue in full force and effect provided that the cost sharing ratios set forth in Section G shall be adjusted to reflect the resultant revised ratio of the imigation acreage of the remaining PARTIES sharing the easement.

J. In the event a suit or action is brought concerning this Agreement, the losing PARTY agrees to pay the prevailing PARTY'S reasonable attorney fees as determined by the trial court, or, if on appeal, similar fees as fixed by the appellate court.

K. This easement shall run with the land and shall be binding upon the PARTIES hereto, their heire, assigns, personal representatives and successors in interest. This easement is subject to all prior liens, encumbrances, easements and exceptions of record.

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
