The ranch was first taken up by Calvin Burnside West (DLC #1248) from Ohio in 1853 and settled in 1854/1855. This was one year after the section lines were surveyed. The next year he went back to Ohio to bring his family to Oregon. They started for Oregon but Calvin West died on the return trip. The widow (Elizabeth Ludlow Hudson West) and four minor children continued on to the claim. She finished proving up on this claim, later selling her interest to her oldest son David West. He then purchased the interest of his brothers and sisters. David added to the property by homesteading two pieces and buying his cousin's claim. In 1885 he was elected Douglas County Treasurer.

In 1885 Henry Nieman Bacon, wife, two sons and three daughters emigrated to Oregon from east Tennessee joining thirty other families in this area from Tennessee. John Gannaway Bacon (my father) was six months old and the youngest.

The Bacon family stayed the first winter with relatives. In 1886 David West moved to Roseburg to be Douglas County Treasurer and needed someone on the ranch. The Henry Bacon family moved on the property renting or share cropping until January 20th, 1890 when they purchased the ranch. A portion on the north was sold to his cousin. Henry Bacon ran sheep, cattle, hogs, horses, raised turkeys and planted fruit and prune orchards.

When they moved on the ranch there was a dug well (not much water). The stock water came from the Umpqua River and Turkey Crick. My grandmother washed at the river, tying my Father up so he wouldn't fall in the river. By 1892 there was a prune dryer, there weren't many dryers as he was drying prunes for people who lived nearly ten miles away.

The reason for the early pumping of water was the need of water for the dryer, the large garden and a poor well.

My own memory (Gerald Bacon) only goes back to the 1920's. At that time they were pumping water from the river with Fordson Tractor power (one was 1914 and the other a 1918) There was a 2,000 gallon redwood tank on the hill near the house, 80 or 90 feet above low water level with pipe to house, garden and prune dryer (I have a piece of house pipe, it was pure lead). There was 25 acres of prunes by then. There was an old tank tower near the house that I was told to stay off of as it was rotten, there was also a old building near high water mark called a pump house. There was and old pump and 2 horse-power Fairbanks-Morris gas motor in it no longer in use. I never heard of using steam power, though one was available for sawmill and threshing machine. I am sure this building and tower were 30 years old or more.


My grandfather (Henry Bacon) died in 1923 and my father (John G. Bacon) purchased the interest of two sisters and one brother, one widowed sister continued to live on the ranch. She raised turkeys, chickens, kept cow and had a garden. Water continued to be pumped from the river and my father ran sheep and cattle, horses , operated the dryer and harvested prunes. The dryer on this place was not operated after 1930 as the family had a large dryer and orchards four miles away. We flood irrigated alfalfa in the 1930's from the river and continued to pump water from the river for house and garden with tractor until after WWII when electricity became available. At that time I (Gerald Bacon) purchased the interest of the other sister and built a new house. I drilled a well, but had small pump in the river for yard and garden. In 1951 I started to irrigate 10 acres and made application for a permit. In 1952 I purchased more pipe and 2 more pumps. (I had single phase power), and watered more and secured more water right. Three phase power was obtained about 1960 and I bought a 40 horsepower 300 foot head pump.

page 3 The History of Turkey Crick Ranch cont.

John G. Bacon passed away in 1971 and I inherited the ranch. Today (1992) we water another 10 acres, still water garden, yards ect., stock still drink from the river and Turkey Crick which runs through our ranch.

The above statement concludes my knowledge of the Bacon Ranch pre-1909 water use on the ranch I now own.

**SURFACE WATER REGISTRATION STATEMENT
IN THE NAME OF GERALD BACON
SITE REPORT**

Diversion Works and Delivery System

The diversion works at the present time consists of either a 40 horsepower electric motor connected directly to a centrifugal pump, or a 7.5 horsepower electric motor connected directly to a centrifugal pump. A 2 or 3 inch screened suction line extends from the pumps into the river. The delivery system consists of 5 inch above ground aluminum mainline with 2 or 3 inch above ground aluminum lateral lines, depending upon the set. Irrigation is by impulse-type sprinklers operating at an estimated nozzle pressure of 55 psi. Assuming one single-jet sprinkler with an 11/64 nozzle, the amount of water delivered is approximately 0.014 cfs or 6.3 gpm. The diversion works and delivery system serve to irrigate 43.6 acres under permit 23703.

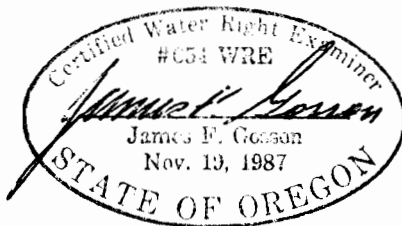



We claim PRE - 1909 VESTED WATER RIGHTS because our Bacon family has continually used water from the main Umpqua River and a small stream named Turkey Crick since 1886 for ranch use; for household, livestock, gardens, fruit dryer and fields. This is already covered in the above Water Right Permit.

Our property is located in Sections 7 & 18 of Township 26S, Range 6 W and was purchased from the heirs of Calvin B. West, Who had Donation Land Claim # 1248, on January 20, 1890. Prior to that date, beginning about 1886, the Bacon family rented the property.

In 1885 the Henry Nieman Bacon family left Greene County, Tennessee for Oregon to join Virginia Winniford Bacon's Uncle and cousins. The Thomas Wilkerson Winniford family who also moved from Tennessee.

They rented until 1890 when they purchased land in TWP 26 R 6 along the Umpqua River in Douglas County. from David S. West.

David S. West was the son of Donation Land Claim owner # 1248 Calvin Burnside West. The claim was issued to the heirs of Calvin B. West and is dated February 2, 1874.

The property purchased from David West was made up of the claim of Calvin B. West heirs, the homestead Patents of David S. West #3067 dated December 20, 1872 and # 1317 dated 13 March 1882 and the homestead # 527 dated July 13, 1875, owned by his cousin Shadrach Hudson.

In 1883 David West purchased the interest of his sisters Anna West Webster and Sarah Abigail West Smith for \$500.00 each

David West and his wife, Merit E. Wright West sold 41.42 acres to George B Winniford on July 28, 1887 and the balance of the acreage 674.85 acres to Henry Nieman Bacon and his wife Virginia Winniford Bacon. *January 20, 1890.*

The Henry Nieman Bacon property descends down to the present owner through Henry's son, John Gannaway Bacon. John purchased the interest of his two sisters and brother, Mel, Kate and George Bacon. John Gerald Bacon, son of John, purchased the interest of sister, Margaret Bacon Hanan.

On 1948 John Gannaway Bacon and his wife Vera deeded 58 acres of this to John Gerald and Doris L. Bacon (file #72766 in Deed Book 150)

John Gerald Bacon and wife Doris L. Bacon , the present owners, inherited the balance of the property from John Gannaway Bacon and his wife Vera Elpha James Bacon. We have all the documents in our possession.

Calvin B. West was a pioneer Circuit Rider ordained to preach in Douglas County. He planned to build a boarding school on his property. This was not accomplished because of death. West died at sea of cholerea while bringing his wife and small children to Oregon.
