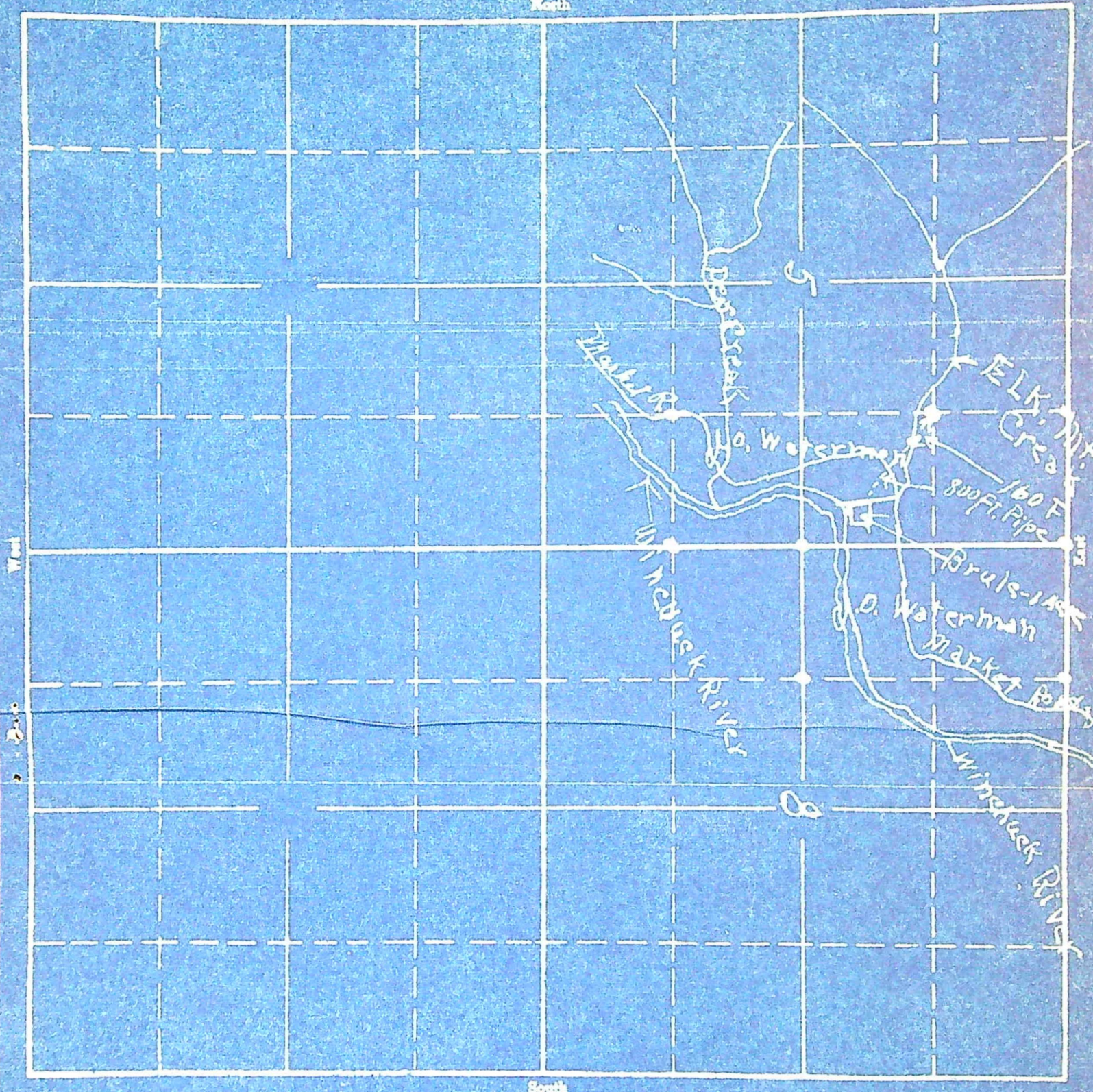

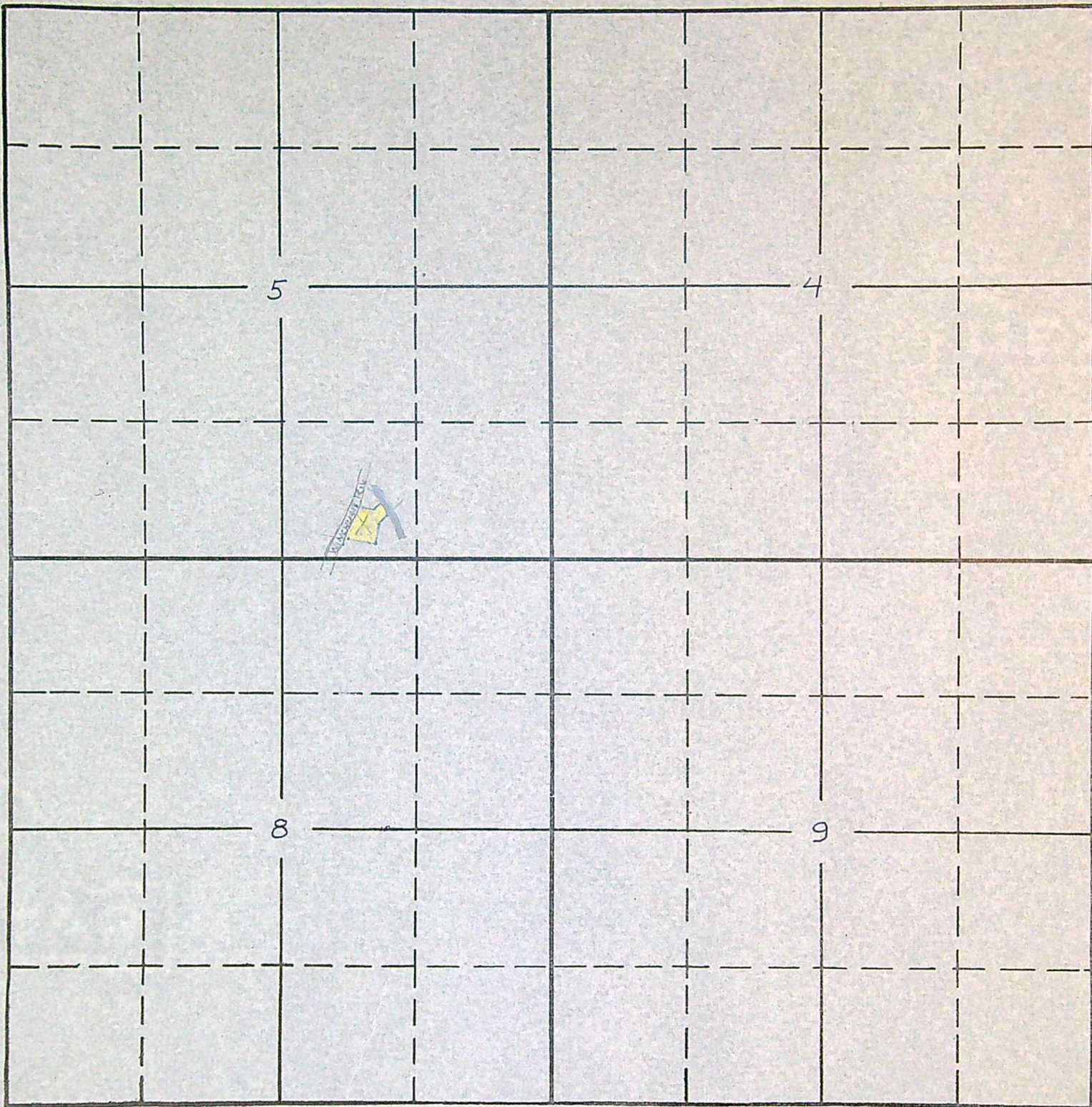

Gentlemen:

I have your letter of January 23 requesting information regarding the filing of water rights for use of water on the property identified by the sketch and legal description received with your letter.

In making a search of our records in regard to the subject property I have found there is a mistake in the records of the rights for use of water on the subject lands.

The certificate recorded at page 16679, Volume 13, State Record of Water Rights Certificates, was issued in the name of W. H. Brule in evidence of the right established under permit No. 15067 to appropriate not to exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second of water from Elk Mountain Creek within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 5, Township 31 South, Range 12 West, W.M., with the priority date of August 25, 1941, for domestic use of one family within the said SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 5.

It appears that at the time the final proof survey was made prior to issuance of the certificate it was determined that a hydraulic ram was being used to pump the domestic water. However, since operation of the ram was not included in the permit as a proposed use of water the certificate could not include the use of water for the ram.

On August 26, 1948 application No. 23383 in the name of Mrs. W. H. Brule was filed in this office for a permit to appropriate 0.01 cubic foot per second from Elk Mountain Creek for operation of the hydraulic ram.

On January 17, 1949 permit No. 18459 was issued in approval of the application and granted the right to appropriate not to exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second from Elk Creek, with the priority

date of August 26, 1948, for operation of a hudraulic ram.

When the certificate recorded at page 20479, Volume 15, State Record of Water Rights Certificates, was issued in evidence of the right established through use under the provisions of permit No. 18459, a mistake was made in the handling of the records in this office and the certificate was issued to describe the right as being for the appropriation of not to exceed 0.01 cubic foot per second from Elk Mountain Creek within the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 5, Township 31 South, Range 12 West, W.M., with the priority date of August 26, 1948, for domestic use of one family and the operation of a hydraulic ram within the said SW $\frac{1}{4}$ SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section 5.

Since a certificate cannot include anything that is not in the permit, certificate No. 20479 should not have included reference to domestic use of water.

If the ram is still being used for pumping water for domestic purposes, certificate No. 20479 should be canceled and a new certificate should be issued in evidence of the right to operate the ram.

If the ram is no longer being used, certificate No. 20479 should be canceled without issuance of a new certificate. Therefore, I would appreciate it if you could advise me as to whether the ram is still in existence and being used for pumping.

If water is being used on the property or will be used on the property for any use other than domestic use of water for one family (certificate No. 16679) and the operation of a hydraulic ram for pumping domestic water (certificate No. 20479), the additional use or uses should be made a matter of record by filing an application for a permit to appropriate the required additional water from Elk Mountain Creek for such use or uses.

An application form and a copy of the Rules and Regulations of the State Engineer are enclosed. The sketch and legal description received with your letter of the 23rd are returned herewith.

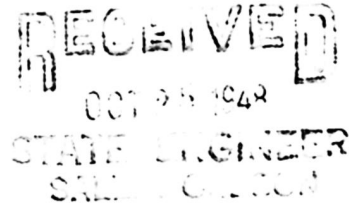
