



Certificate of Water Right Ownership Update

NOTICE TO SELLERS & BUYERS:

By law, all water belongs to the public (ORS 537.110). In almost every instance, a permit or water right certificate from the Water Resources Department is needed before using, diverting or storing water (ORS 537.130). However, most domestic wells do not require water rights. A certificate of water right stays with the land. In order to keep track of water right ownership, the Department requests that this form be submitted to the Department.

Water that has been used for a long time in one place or that involves a water structure (like a dam) that already exists is no guarantee that there is a water right which would allow the water use to continue.

If you have any questions about this form or water right requirements, please contact your local watermaster or call the Water Resources Department at 503-986-0900.

This Is To Certify, That FRANK CLUSTER

of Riley ,State of Oregon ,has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Chickahominey Creek & Reservoir constructed under Appl. No. R-26155, Per. No. R-1256 a tributary of Silver Creek 1073. for the purpose of supplemental irrigation of 1302.3 acres under Permit No. 20713 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from September 17, 1951

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 21-5 cubic feet per second





On August 18, 1988, James Towery, Robert Young, and Vernon Morgan submitted an affidavit that they are the owners of a certain water right and the lands to which the water right is appurtenant; that they have abandoned any and all interest in and to the said water right and request the same be cancelled.

The water right in question is a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 29362, Volume 21, State Record of Water Right Certificates, in the name of Frank Cluster. It is for the use of not to exceed 3.60 cubic feet per second of water from Chickahominey Creek and Reservoir, with a date of priority of September 17, 1951, for irrigating 8.0 acres NE 1/4 SE 1/4, 20.0 acres NW 1/4 SE 1/4, 37.4 acres SW 1/4 SE 1/4, and 24.8 acres SE 1/4 SE 1/4, Section 2; 31.4 acres NE 1/4 NE 1/4, 37.4 acres NW 1/4 NE 1/4, 25.6 acres SW 1/4 NE 1/4, 17.6 acres SE 1/4 NE 1/4, 21.4 acres NE 1/4 NW 1/4, and 4.8 acres NW 1/4 NW 1/4, Section 11, Township 24 South, Range 27 East, WM.

ORS 540.621 provides that: "Whenever the owner of a perfected and developed water right certifies under oath to the Water Resources Commission that the water right has been abandoned by the owner and that the owner desires cancellation thereof, the Commission shall enter an order cancelling the water right."

NOW THEREFORE, it is hereby ORDERED that the said water right, being a portion of the right described by the certificate recorded at page 29362, Volume 21, State Record of Water Right Certificates, is cancelled.

If is FURTHER ORDERED that the said certificate of water right is cancelled and in lieu thereof, a new certificate be issued to describe the balance of water right NOT involved in this proceeding.

Dear Sir:

The certificate recorded at page 29361 was issued to Frank Cluster for the storage of 4767.0 acre feet of water from Chickahominy Creek for irrigation. Later there was a change in use of the stored water, so 1500.0 acre feet of the storage is held for recreation and public fishery. The remaining 3267.0 acre feet of water is for the supplemental irrigation of 1302.3 acres.

I do not know whom presently owns the land on which the water from the reservoir is used, but the use of water is restricted to the lands described in the certificate recorded at page 29362. The owners of the lands could submit an application for a change in place of use from the lands presently irrigated to other lands for which a valid primary right exists which could be irrigated from the stored water. If the place of use is changed to lands for which no right exists, the direct flow primary right would have to be changed along with the supplemental use from the reservoir.

Water legally stored during the runoff period may be held as long as physically possible for use. There is no restriction as to what part of the irrigation season the water may be used.

As you know the final proof survey in connection with your permits numbered 19525, 19162, 20743 and R-1256 was made in October, 1960. When we attempted to make the final proof forms for your signature a problem developed, in that the land being irrigated is not entirely the same as that described in the applications.

The application which was approved by permit 19525 lists lands in Sections 10, 11, 13 and 15 and a few acres in the northwest corner of Section 14. The application approved by permit number 19162 lists lands in Sections 2, 3, and 11. The land applied for under both of these permits is substantially the same as mapped by our field engineer, but did not include the number of acres we mapped. No problem developes under permit 19162 and the right apparently can be completed to the limit of the permit. This would leave 900 acres not covered; 668.6 of which could be covered by permit number 19162. This leaves 231.6 acres not covered by either permit.

I am enclosing a print of the final proof survey map so you may compare it with maps attached to permits 19162 and 19525.

Permit number 20743 describes the appropriation of water from Chickahominy Creek and Reservoir for supplemental irrigation. The application lists lands in Sections 2, 3, 10, 11, 13, 14 and 15. This is restricted to use of water on lands having a prior right. You will note that Section 14, most of which is covered by an earlier right from Silver Creek, was included in permit number 20743, but not claimed apparently when our field engineer mapped the area irrigated. You will also note that the Wa of Section 2 was not described in any of the applications. The total acres described in permit number 20743 is very close to that listed by our field engineer, but we could not include the 231.6 acres mentioned above in a certificate confirming permit 20743 as this land does not have a primary right.
