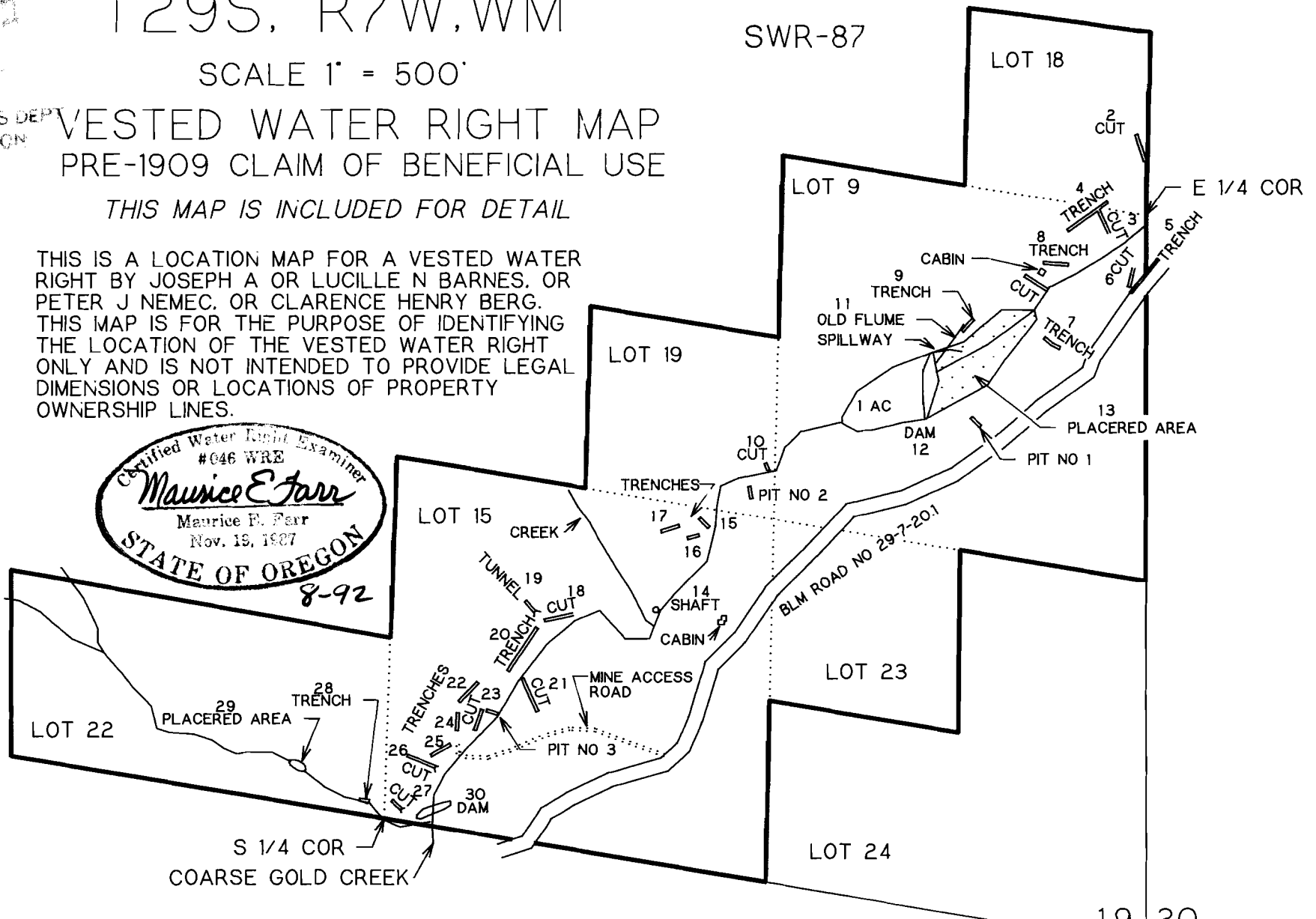

THIS MAP IS FOR THE PURPOSE OF IDENTIFYING THE LOCATION OF THE VESTED WATER RIGHT ONLY AND IS NOT INTENDED TO PROVIDE LEGAL DIMENSIONS OR LOCATIONS OF PROPERTY OWNERSHIP LINES.



NOTE: POD IS SHOWN AT THE SPILLWAY OF THE DAM. HOWEVER, WATER WILL BE DIVERTED AT NUMEROUS POINTS ALONG THE CREEKS WHERE THE PLACER OPERATION IS SET UP AND OPERATING. THE WATER WILL BE TAKEN FROM THE CREEK, USED IN THE PLACER OPERATION, THEN RETURNED TO A HOLDING POND FOR IMPURITIES TO BE SETTLED OUT BEFORE BEING RETURNED TO THE CREEK. NO OTHER POD'S ARE SHOWN WITH DISTANCES FROM A CORNER BECAUSE THERE WILL BE NUMEROUS POINTS USED AND ABANDONED.

On August 6, 1992, I made a survey of the above listed property and viewed the water system installed and in use. I used an assessor map and an aerial photo during the course of preparing this final proof survey and site map.

SOURCE: Water is taken from Coarse Gold Creek, tributary to Berry Creek, Olalla Creek, Lookingglass Creek, South Umpqua River, Umpqua River.

DIVERSION POINT: The diversion point is located at the spillway on the North West corner of the dam in Coarse Gold Creek.

MOTOR: The engine is an 8 hp Honda gasoline fueled engine, Model No WT30X.

PUMP: The pump is a self-priming centrifugal trash pump with 3" diameter intake line and a 3" diameter discharge line, rated at 343 GPM at maximum 20 feet suction head and 98 feet total dynamic head.

PIPE: No pipe is used to transport the water. The water is directed through nozzles for the mining operations.

USE: Water is used for mining of gold ore.

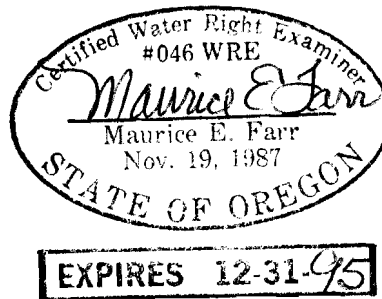
HEAD: No elevation differences were measured. The pump is located near or on the edge of the creek.

CALCULATIONS: Pump discharge 0.764 cfs 343.0 GPM


POINT OF BEGINNING: Assessor's maps and aerial photos were used to draw the accompanying map.

REMARKS: The pump is moved along the creek to the location of the ore deposits.

The final proof survey and inspection of the use as found to be completed under terms and conditions of File# SWR-87 was completed by me on August 6, 1992, and the facts contained in this report and accompanying vested water right map are correct to the best of my knowledge.

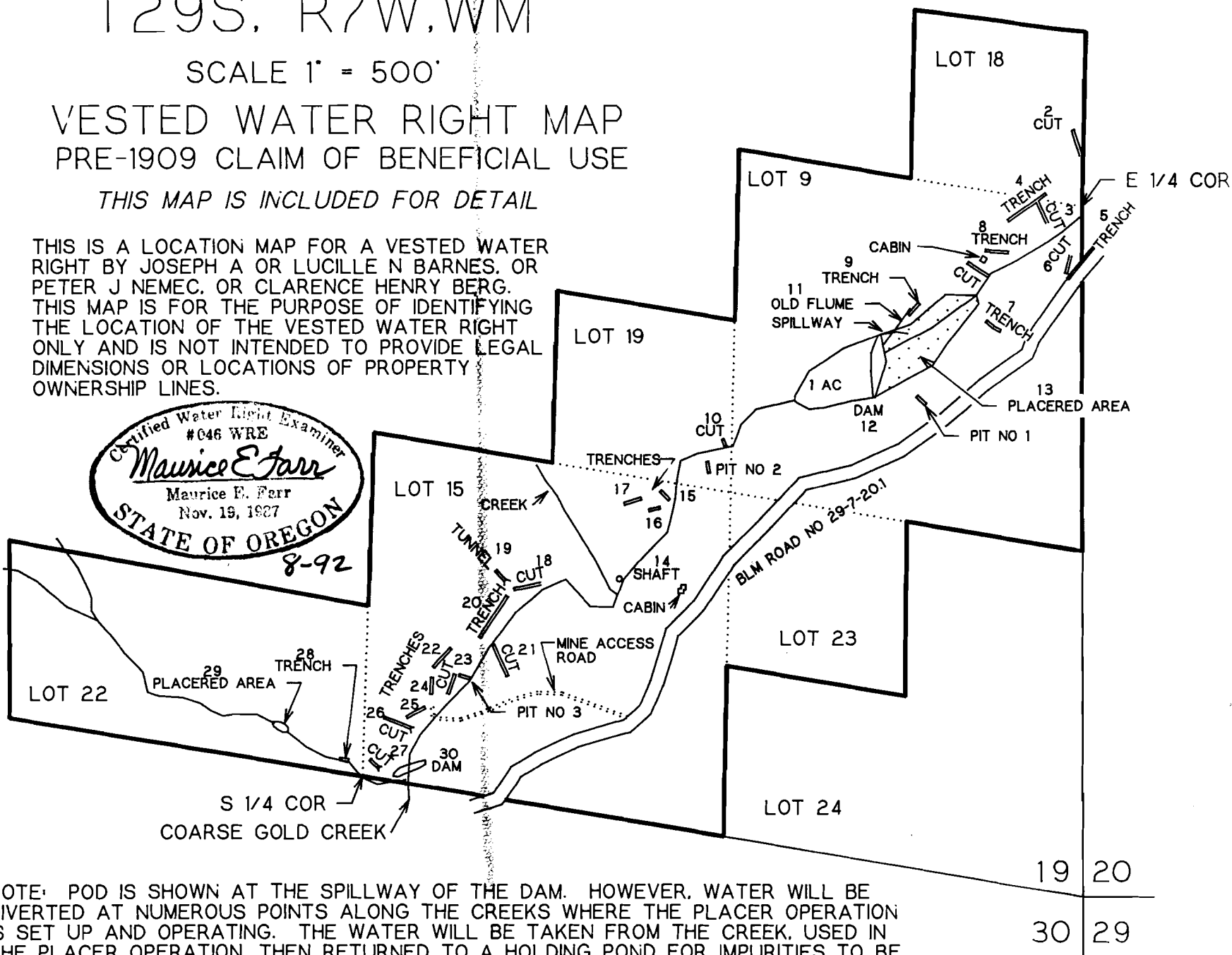
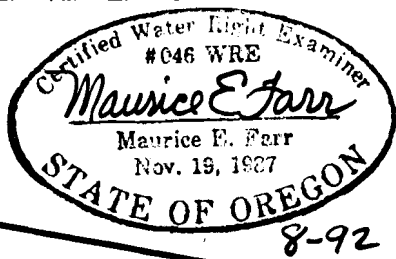

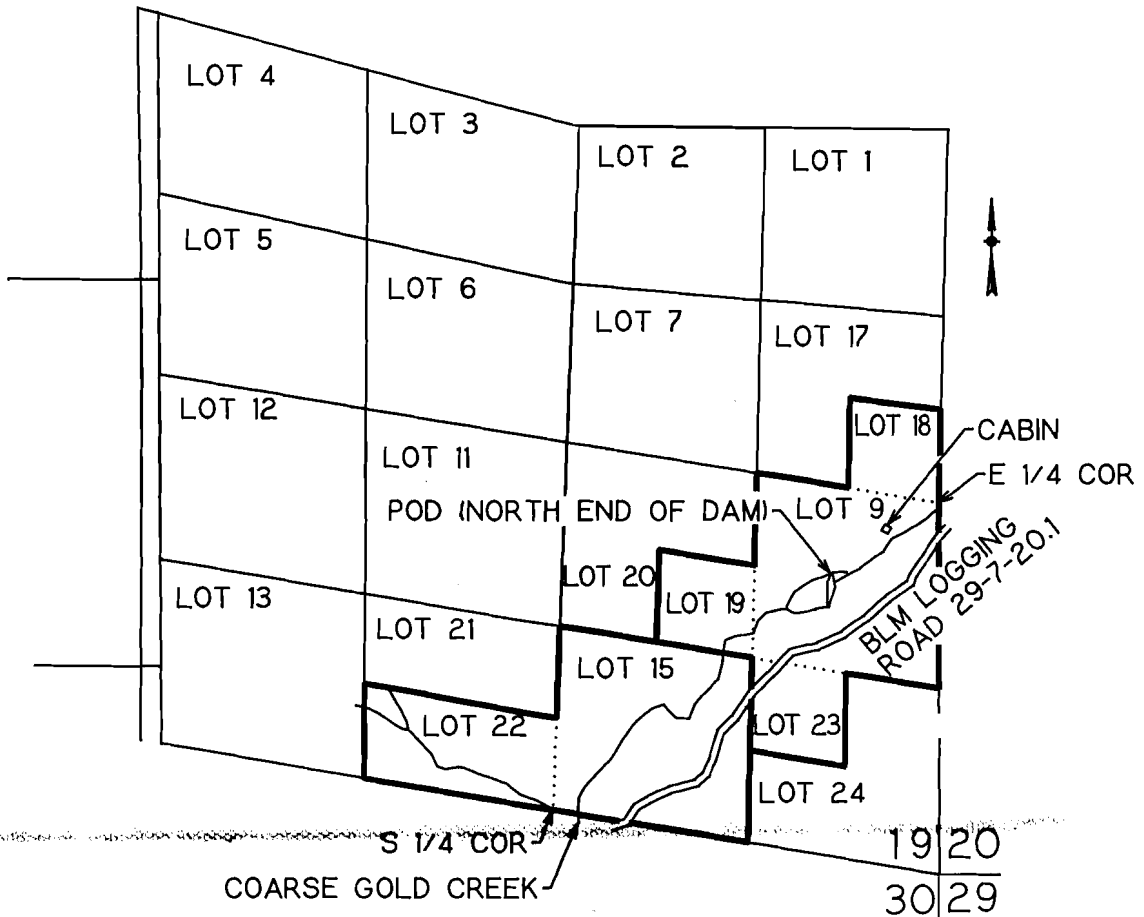

Notice -

Notice is hereby given that the undersigned has located and claim for placer gold mining purposes the following described premises in Sec. 19, Town 29 S R. 7 West in Clatsop Mining District Douglas County Oregon. Beginning two hundred yards below the forks of County Gold Gulch and mining down said Gulch six hundred yards, and fifty yards on each side of the Gulch or Creek for said distance of six hundred yards.
