The City of Banks, Oregon, a Municipal Corporation, 150 N.E. Banks Rd., Banks, Oregon 97106 respectfully petitions Oregons Water Policy Review Board to classify our application 65611 for the appropriation of water as municipal use in accordance with ORS 536.380.

During the early 1950's the City of Banks developed two small streams in Section 7, T2N, R3W, W.M. for municipal water supply purposes. Development consisted of intakes and pipelines which connected to an existing supply system. (See attached map). The City did not submit an application for appropriating the water at that time.

The proposed appropriation is for 0.09 cubic feet per second (40 gallons per minute) from each of the two sources.

The City has two other sources of water supply as shown on the attached map. The upper intake (commonly known as the big spring) located in Section 12 can supply 110 gallons per minute. A recently developed well in Section 31 can produce 250 gallons per minute and is used only to supplement the existing gravity sources.

Continued use of the two sources for which application has been made is important to the City as they provide an uninterruptable supply of water on a gravity basis. There are energy and cost savings by virtue of the fact that pumping is not required for utilization of this source.

To the best of our knowledge there are no known objections to the proposed classification, it will not have major adverse impacts, it is not likely to conflict with future applications for classified uses and it is not inconsistent with acknowledged comprehensive plans or applicable land use regulations.

This is in response to your recent telephone call to Klein Engineering regarding energy and cost savings to the City of Banks through the use of two small streams (Water Right Application 65611) as opposed to pumping an equal amount of water from the City's well supply. We understand that this information is significant to the Water Policy Review Board in its determination regarding issuance of a permit to appropriate the gravity water.

First, we wish to advise you that the two small streams for which application has been made have been in continuous use as a source of supply for Banks since 1933. In an earlier letter (October 1983) to the Water Policy Review Board we incorrectly stated that these two small streams were developed in the early 1950's.

If we assume that we receive 80 gallons of water per minute from the two springs on a year around basis in lieu of pumping from the well, energy and cost savings amount to 48,046 KWH and \$1826 (annually) using Portland General Electric Company's rate of \$0.03801/KWH.

In addition to the user rate, PGE has a demand charge which currently averages about \$70.00 per month at the well. It is difficult to pro-rate this charge for the two streams, however, we feel \$120 per year is reasonable which would bring the annual cost savings to about \$1,950 assuming year around operation.

Use of water on a year around basis from the two streams may not be a reasonable assumption at this time, however, with the given growth rate of the City and surrounding area it is conceivable that the streams could be utilized fully within twenty years.

If we assume that the two small streams are only a supplement to the big spring (the primary supply) and are only needed for a 100 day period during the summer months, energy and cost savings are then 13,346 KHW and \$537 annually which includes \$30.00 for demand. We trust that this will give you the needed information.

It should be noted that the City of Banks operates on a very marginal budget and has only part time help in operating and maintaining its water system. A \$500 item is significant.

Notice is hereby given, under the provisions of ORS 536.380, that I intend to accept an application for a water use not included in an existing basin program statement.

The application will be submitted by the City of Banks for municipal use of 0.18 cfs from two springs tributary to West Fork of Dairy Creek. The surface water of Tualatin River and its tributaries are classified in the Lower Willamette River Basin Program for human and livestock consumption only during July 31 through September 15, each year, except for stored water.

The proposed use of water does not appear to conflict with future applications for classified uses or create any known adverse impacts on other water uses in the area.

Under ORS 536.380 (2b) any person, state agency or public corporation of this state or any agency of the federal government objecting to the proposed action must file to protest with the Board within 25 days.

If there is no notification from the Water Policy Review Board of its intent to review the application within 30 days, the party will be advised that the application will be accepted. The application and supporting data will be subject to normal processing procedures including review for conformance with this department's regulations.

Gentlemen,

The City of Banks, Oregon, a Municipal Corporation, 150 N.E. Banks Rd., Banks, Oregon 97106 respectfully petitions Oregons Water Policy Review Board to classify our application 65611 for the appropriation of water as municipal use in accordance with ORS 536.380.

During the early 1950's the City of Banks developed two small streams in Section 7, T2N, R3W, W.M. for municipal water supply purposes. Development consisted of intakes and pipelines which connected to an existing supply system. (See attached map). The City did not submit an application for appropriating the water at that time.

The proposed appropriation is for 0.09 cubic feet per second (40 gallons per minute) from each of the two sources.

The City has two other sources of water supply as shown on the attached map. The upper intake (commonly known as the big spring) located in Section 12 can supply 110 gallons per minute. A recently developed well in Section 31 can produce 250 gallons per minute and is used only to supplement the existing gravity sources.


Continued use of the two sources for which application has been made is important to the City as they provide an uninterruptable supply of water on a gravity basis. There are energy and cost savings by virtue of the fact that pumping is not required for utilization of this source.

To the best of our knowledge there are no known objections to the proposed classification, it will not have major adverse impacts, it is not likely to conflict with future applications for classified uses and it is not inconsistent with acknowledged comprehensive plans or applicable land use regulations.

SUBJECT City of Banks Exception Request

#### Staff Recommendation

Staff recommends that the Water Policy Review Board allow the Director to accept an application by the City of Banks for a permit to appropriate water from the Tualatin Basin for municipal use. The Lower Willamette Basin Program presently allows only human and livestock use during the period of July 31 to September 15 each year from the Tualatin River and tributaries except for stored water. It should also be noted that one of the 75 minimum perennial streamflow applications covers the West Fork of Dairy Creek. This application will be subordinate to that flow if established by the Board. Similarly, withdrawal of the SB 225 streams would also affect use of this source.

Even though there may be a potential conflict with the minimum flow application which will require future resolution, it is the opinion of the staff that acceptance of the application is appropriate for the following reasons:

- 1. The application represents a historic use of water which probably predates the basin program. No new impacts are expected.
- The use involves a small quantity of water which, at least in part, is required for human and livestock consumption.
- 3. The City of Banks has a record of water supply problems.

The resources of this small community are limited. The available information clearly indicates that additional measures are required to meet the city's water demands. It is also apparent that denying access to the long used source will not contribute to the solution of the city's water problems.

#### Background

Exception Process

ORS 536.370 sets up requirements for Board review of proposed actions which are in conflict with basin program statements. The procedures, outlined further in ORS 536.380, allow the Board to permit an action without formal review after notice of the proposed action. The Board is required to review the action if a protest is filed by any person, state agency or public corporation within 25 days. The Board may also conduct
