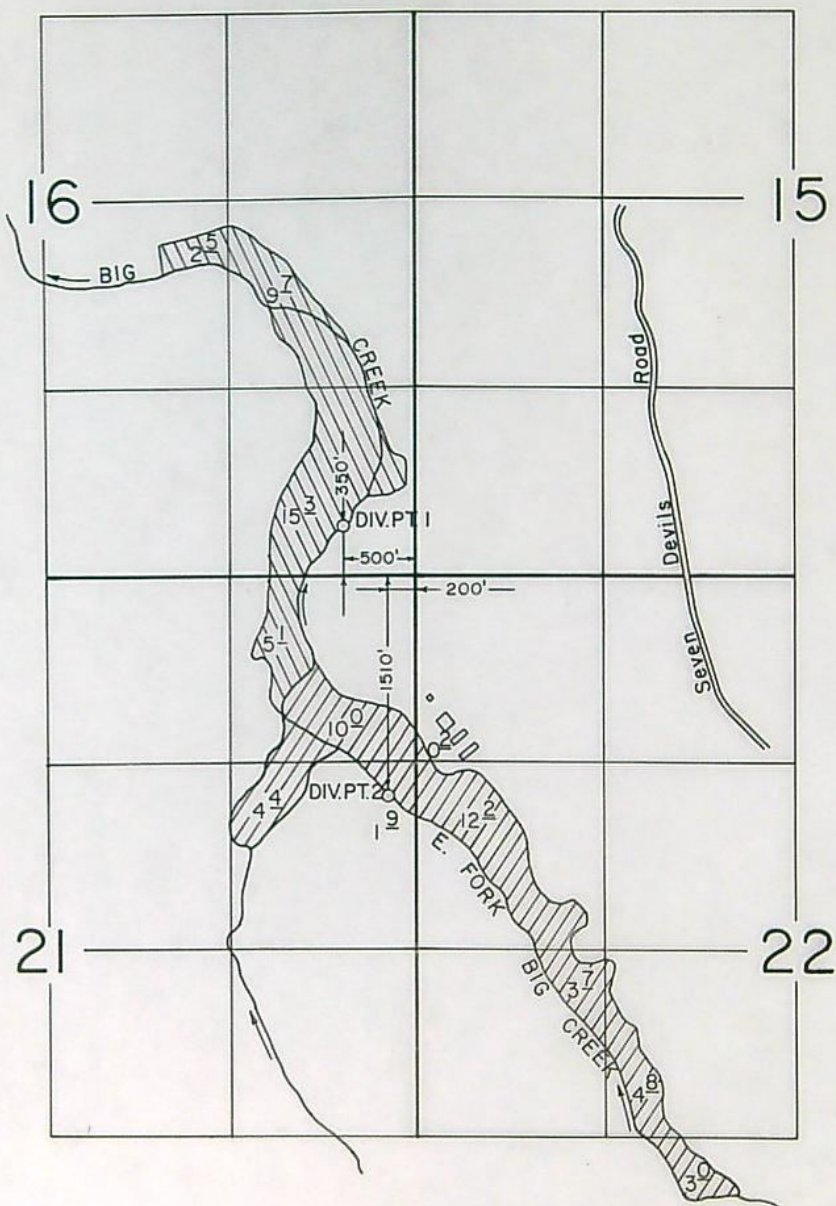

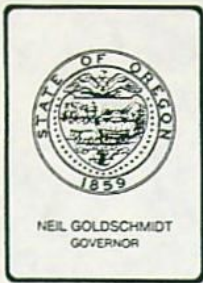

Your Reservoir Application R-69769 describing the proposed construction of the 2 acre reservoir and storage of 9.0 acre-feet of water from Big Creek for irrigation of 126 acres of improved pasture and stock watering, together with the sketch of the proposed sump (reservoir), has been reviewed.

Also, your Secondary Application 69769 describing the proposed use of 1.588 cubic feet of water per second from Big Creek, being use of 1.58 cfs for irrigation of 126.5 acres and use of 0.008 cfs for stock, together with the supporting map, has been reviewed.

Before your applications can be considered for approval, it will be necessary for you to make certain amendments to the applications and supply additional information and supporting data. Also, any public interest issue that may arise will need to be resolved.

Your proposed reservoir is approaching the size that requires engineering data prepared by a licensed engineer. If it is found that a dam or dike is constructed 10 feet or higher or that the reservoir impounds more than 9.2 acre-feet, as built plans, specifications and a statement of adequacy prepared by an engineer licensed in Oregon will be required.

Since you intend to store water for more than one purpose, it will be necessary for you to further state in Item 7 of the Reservoir Application R-69769 the amount of water to be stored for each purpose, being an amount of water for stock watering and the amount of water to be stored for irrigation purposes.

Incidentally, it would be best not to limit the number of acres to be irrigated or the type of crop to be irrigated in Item 7 on the reservoir application. Only the uses to be made of the stored water should be stated along with noting the amount to be stored for each use.

The amount of water to be stored in the reservoir will need to be stated in Item 8 of the reservoir application without using an approximate figure. The maximum capacity of the proposed reservoir will need to be determined and noted.

Since the "2 acre reservoir" would be considered a source of water, the "2 acre reservoir" needs to be included as a source in Item 1 of the Secondary Application 69770.

The two points of diversion as shown on the map appear to be points in the creek channel. For your type of development, both the point where water will be diverted from the creek and the point where stored water will be diverted from the reservoir will need to be properly located on the map and in Item 2 of the secondary application.

The reference corner used in locating the points of diversion will need to be properly identified in the first part of Item 2 of the secondary application. According to information shown on the supporting map, the reference corner used is the "south 1/4 corner of Section 22". If so, the reference corner needs to be identified as such in the application.

In addition to listing the acreage to be irrigated in Item 3 of the secondary application, the other uses to be made of the water also need to be listed with respect to the proper quarter-quarter section.

The stock watering and barn cleaning are presently listed as two separate uses in Item 5 of your secondary application. As such, it will be necessary to further note the amount of water to be appropriated from each source for each use and we will need a separate recording fee for each use. However, if you wish, you may list the use as "stock barn uses to include stock watering and barn cleaning" as one use in Item 7 of your reservoir application and in Items 4 and 5 of your secondary application.

We will need clarification on your intentions regarding the existing right involved and how water under permits approving your applications will be used in connection with use allowed under the existing right.

We recently sent to you a proposed certificate of water right which is to confirm the right perfected under the terms of Permit 46986. We would not be able to issue you another permit to provide for the use from the same creek for irrigation of the same acreage allowed under the existing right.

However, your secondary application could be completed to apply for the use of water from the creek as a primary source and the reservoir as a supplemental source for the irrigation of acreage not allowed under the existing right and apply for the use of stored water from the reservoir as a supplemental supply for the irrigation of acreage presently having an existing right from the creek or creeks.

Your supporting map will then need to be revised to show in different manners the lands to receive the primary supply and the lands to receive the supplemental supply. The acreage to receive the supplemental supply in each quarter-quarter section cannot exceed the acreage allowed or to be allowed under the existing right perfected under Permit 46986. To assist you, I am enclosing a print of the Final Proof Survey map made in connection with the earlier permit. This map is enlarged to about the same scale as the map submitted with your applications. Any revisions to your application map must be done by a Certified Water Rights Examiner.

There is an issue relative to the identity of the creek that should be resolved. When Cottell Brothers filed for their Permit 46986 in November of 1981, they identified the creek where your proposed reservoir is located as "East Fork Big Creek". Your application and supporting map identify the creek in the vicinity of the reservoir as Big Creek. Other maps in our office indicate that the creek in the vicinity of your proposed reservoir is Big Creek. Based upon your and other parties local knowledge, which do you believe is correct. Also, if you feel that any of our records relative to the existing Permit 46989 or your applications need to be corrected to properly identify the creek or creeks involved, please advise.

The Department of Fish and Wildlife is recommending design and operation conditions for your development. A copy of their letter received in this office March 10th of this year is enclosed. Matters regarding the conditions proposed by their letter will need to be resolved.

I am returning both of your applications and your supporting map for correction and completion. The applications are endorsed, so that in order to retain their priority dates, they must be received in this office on or before October 13, 1989.

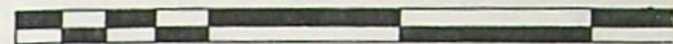
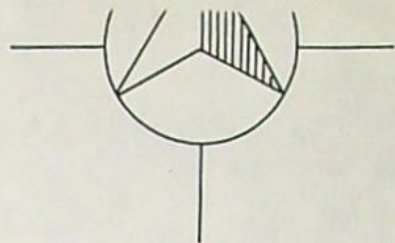

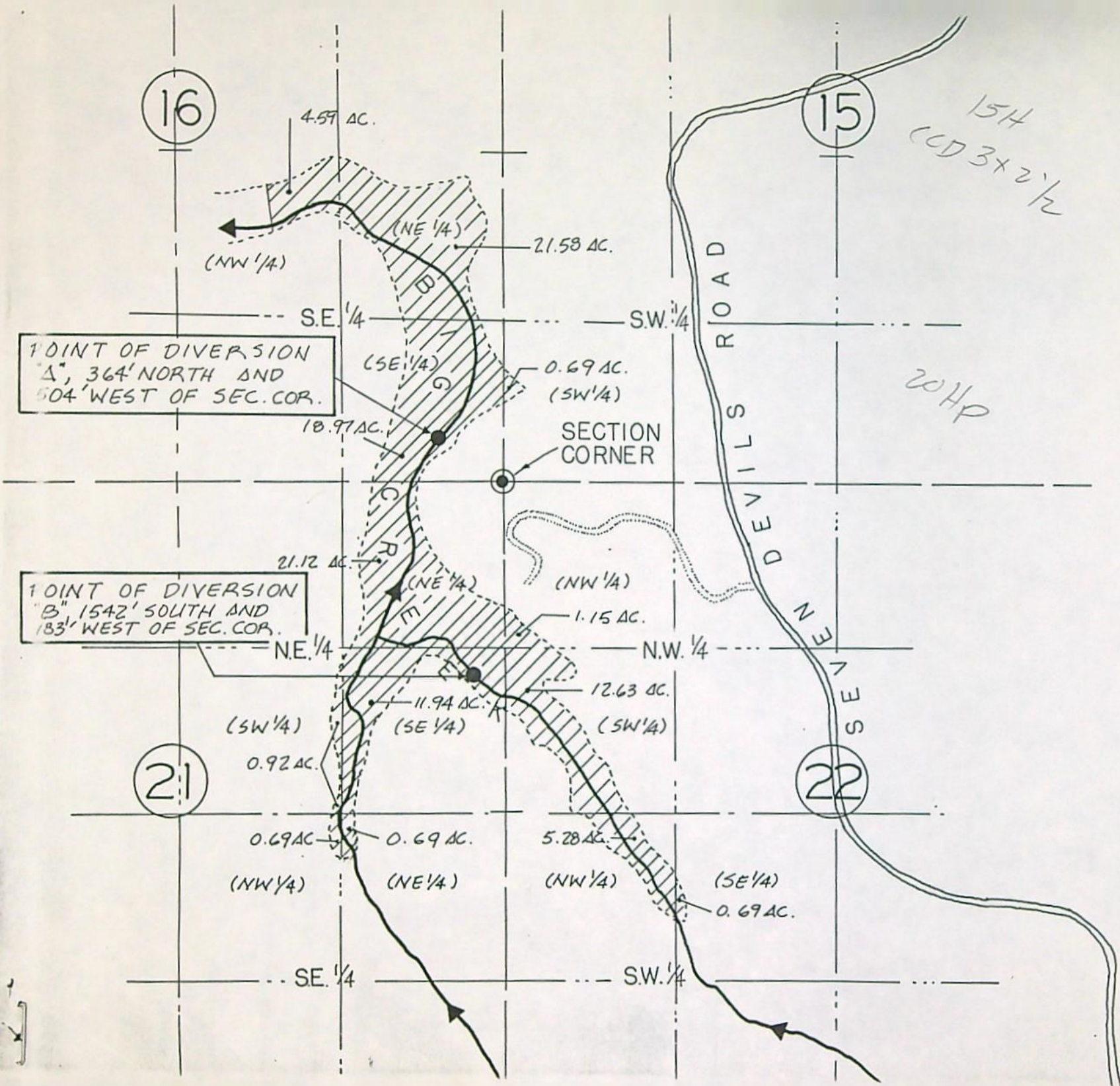

confirms the right to use the waters of BIG CREEK AND EAST FORK BIG CREEK, a tributary of PACIFIC OCEAN, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 72.8 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 46986. The date of priority is NOVEMBER 16, 1981. The right is limited to not more than 0.91 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND; BEING 0.41 CFS FROM BIG CREEK AND 0.50 CFS FROM EAST FORK BIG CREEK, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The points of diversion are located as follows:

SE 1/4 SE 1/4, SECTION 16, SE 1/4 NE 1/4, SECTION 21, T 26 S, R 14 W, W.M.; BIG CREEK - 350 FEET NORTH AND 500 FEET WEST, EAST FORK BIG CREEK - 1510 FEET SOUTH AND 200 FEET WEST, BOTH FROM THE SE CORNER OF SECTION 16.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

Your Application 63047 describing the proposed use of 1.252 cubic feet of water per second from Big Creek for irrigation of 100.34 acres, along with the accompanying map, has been reviewed.

From your map and the description of the system's operation, it appears that certain lands will be irrigated from each diversion point.

According to your map, the source of water for each point of diversion is not the same water, and that you may be irrigating certain lands from each source. It appears that there would be water available at Point of Diversion A which would not be available at Point of Diversion B. If this is the case, you should clearly define the two sources of water in Item 2, the lands to be irrigated from each source in Item 3, and on your map, and define an amount of water to be appropriated from each source in Item 4.

The location of the land described by Item 3 is not in total agreement with the map. You should check the acreage as shown on your map for the $E\frac{1}{4}$ of the $SE\frac{1}{4}$, Section 16 and make the necessary corrections to make Item 3 and your map agree with one another.

The permit, when issued, is for the beneficial use of water. By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan. It is possible that the land use you propose may not be allowed if it is not in keeping with the goals and the acknowledged plan. Your city or county planning agency can advise you about the land-use plan in your area.
