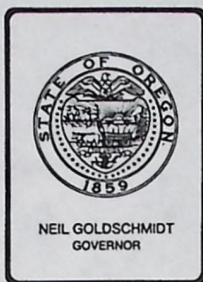

Dear Ms. Willard:

On July 17, 1984, September 30, 1986, and May 15, 1989, inspections were made for your permits 38274 and 41250. These permits allowed for the use of 0.045 cubic foot per second of water from Little River for domestic use of one family and irrigation, and the use of 0.005 cubic foot per second of water from a spring for domestic use of one family. The dates for the complete application of water were October 1, 1978 and October 1, 1979, respectively.

Our first inspection found a burned out mobile home, but no evidence of irrigation. Later inspections found the place in the same condition. It appears that any development done under the terms of the permits was abandoned. Therefore these permits should be cancelled.

Enclosed are forms for you to use to authorize the cancellation of the permits. The cancellations will clear them from our records and avoid the necessity for further notices and correspondence.

The map prepared on tracing paper, legal description, and fees of \$30.00 were also received. Our receipt No. 34688 is enclosed. Your application has been filed and number 50661.

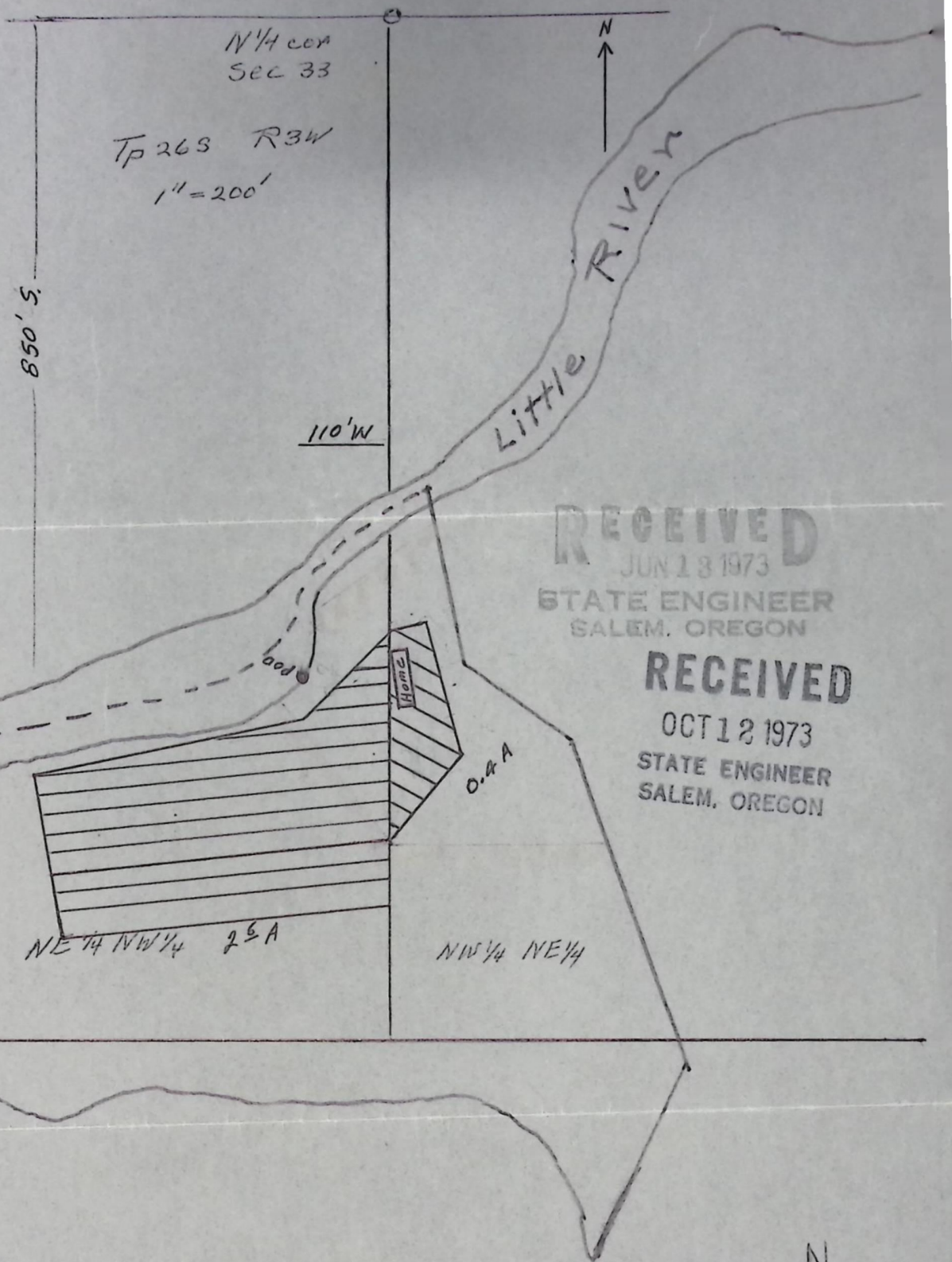
