
Gentlemen:

We have been withholding action on your application, pending receipt of the letter authorizing the amendment of your reservoir application to agree with the area and capacity curve submitted and a legal description of the property, as requested in my letter of September 25, 1967. This information has not yet been received.

Therefore, I am returning your applications No. R-43950 and 43951 for completion and correction, and the application map.

Item No. 10 on the reservoir application must be completed to describe the mean depth of water as shown on the area and capacity curve submitted.

Item No. 1 on application No. 43951 must also include the reservoir as a source of appropriation.

Gentlemen:

This will acknowledge receipt of your application for a permit to construct a reservoir and store 4.59 acre feet of water therein for a log pond, a topographical map of the reservoir area, with an area and capacity curve computed therefrom, and a location map with two prints, and the fee of \$20 for which our receipt No. 5549 is enclosed. This application has been filed and numbered R-43950.

Also acknowledged is receipt of your application for a permit to appropriate 0.33 cubic foot of water per second from the Applegate River for a log pond, and the additional fee of \$15 for which our receipt No. 5550 is enclosed. This application has been filed and numbered 43951.

Item No. 10 on the reservoir application indicates the mean depth of water to be 5 feet. The computed mean depth of water from the area and capacity curve is 4.1 feet.

Item No. 1 on application No. 43951 should also include the reservoir as a source of appropriation.

Would you give us written authorization to amend these two items on your applications?
