Appeal Rights

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Application History

Permit G-16129 was issued by the Department on November 30, 2006, and modified by Permit Amendment T-13669 on January 26, 2022. Superseding Permit G-18720 was issued to reflect the changes. The permit specified complete application of water to beneficial use by October 11, 2011. The most recent extension authorized completion of construction and complete application of water to beneficial use by October 1, 2023. On April 14, 2023, Carl Coffman, president of Norway Development submitted an Application for Extension of Time for Permit G-18720. In accordance with OAR 690-315-0050(2), on August 6, 2024, the Department issued a Proposed Final Order proposing to extend the time to fully apply water to beneficial use to October 1, 2033. The protest period closed September 20, 2024, in accordance with OAR 690-315-0060(1). On September 19, 2024, the permit holder submitted a timely protest. On January 17, 2025, counsel for the permit holder requested withdrawal of the protest and issuance of a Final Order consistent with the Proposed Final Order.

FINDINGS OF FACT

The Department adopts and incorporates by reference the findings of fact in the Proposed Final Order dated August 6, 2024.

At time of issuance of the Proposed Final Order the Department concluded that, based on the factors demonstrated by the applicant, any comments received, and information within the file, the permit may be extended subject to the following conditions:

LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS

1. Annual Water Use Reporting Condition

The permittee shall keep a complete record of the volume of water used each month, and shall submit an annual report which includes the recorded water-use measurements to the Department annually, or more frequently as may be required by the Director. Further, the Director may require the permittee to report general water-use information, including the place and nature of use of water under the permit.

2. Checkpoint Condition

The permit holder must submit a completed Progress Report Form to the Department by October 1, 2028, and 2032. A form will be enclosed with your Final Order.

- (a) At each checkpoint, the permit holder shall submit and the Department shall review evidence of the permit holder's diligence towards completion of the project and compliance with terms and conditions of the permit and extension. If, after this review, the Department determines the permit holder has not been diligent in developing and perfecting the water use permit, or complied with all terms and conditions, the Department shall modify or further condition the permit or extension to ensure future compliance, or begin cancellation proceedings on the undeveloped portion of the permit pursuant to ORS 537.260 or 537.410, or require submission of a final proof survey pursuant to ORS 537.250;
- (b) The Department shall provide notice of receipt of progress reports in its weekly notice and shall allow a 30 day comment period for each report. The Department shall provide notice of its determination to anyone who submitted comments.

CONCLUSION OF LAW

The applicant has demonstrated good cause for the permit extension pursuant to ORS 537.630, 539.010(5) and OAR 690-315-0040(2).

ORDER

The extension of time for Application G-16388, Permit G-18720, therefore, is approved subject to conditions contained herein. The deadline for completing construction is extended from October 1, 2023, to October 1, 2033. The deadline for applying water to full beneficial use within the terms and conditions of the permit is extended from October 1, 2023, to October 1, 2033.
