It defines the extent to which use of water has been completed within the terms of your permit. The proof should be carefully examined, dated and signed, then returned to this office.

Upon receipt of a signed proof, a Certificate of Water Right will be issued confirming the right. This will be forwarded to you after our records are brought up to date.

Our field examiner found a total of 45.5 acres claimed irrigated in connection with Permit 41308, which exceeds the limit of 40.0 acres under the permit. If you intend to establish a legal water right for the additional 5.5 acres, a permit must be obtained. We will assist in making an application for a permit for the additional land at your request.

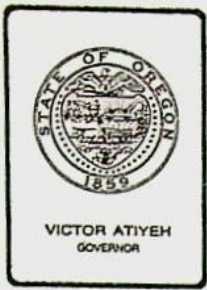

This is concerning file No. 54163 under the name of Rash Dairy.

December 15, 1976, I looked over the area that is involved in the water right. In my opinion, the water they are, and will be, pumping is drainage water. The picture I took accompanying this letter shows the drain ditch and the pumping facility. There is approximately 50 to 100 gpm flowing at this time. The West Extension Canal has been shut off for approximately two months. When the ditch is cleaned and is running again, I would suspect there is a great deal of water flowing in the drain ditch.

Enclosed are pictures of the area. On the back of each picture is a description. I have also enclosed a map showing the location and rambling of the drain ditch.

Upon receipt of the report from the Watermaster, your application will be examined further and you will be advised as to the necessary amendments to your application.

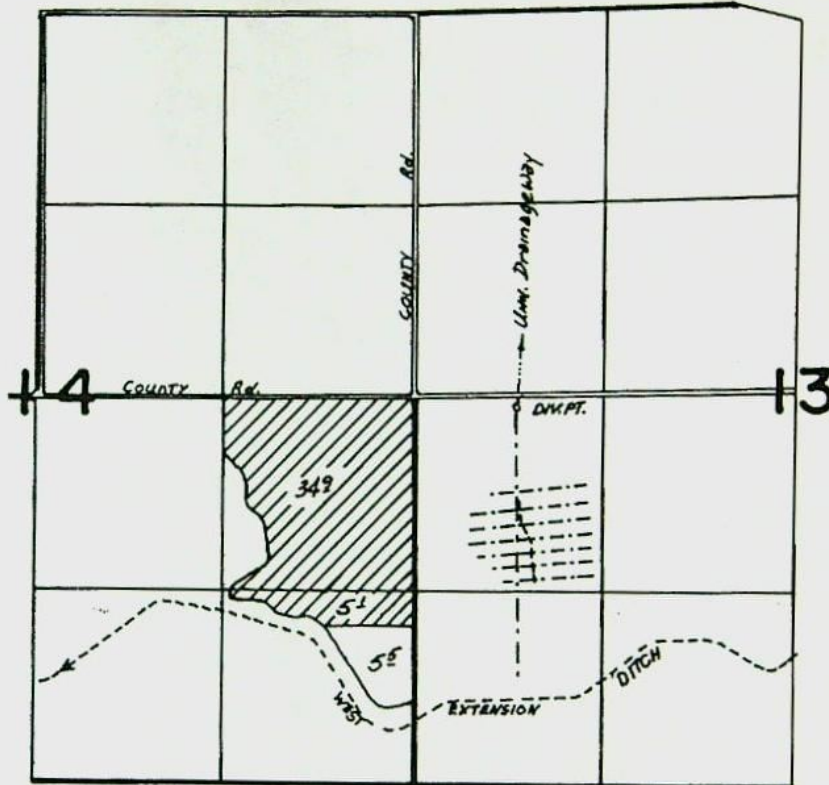

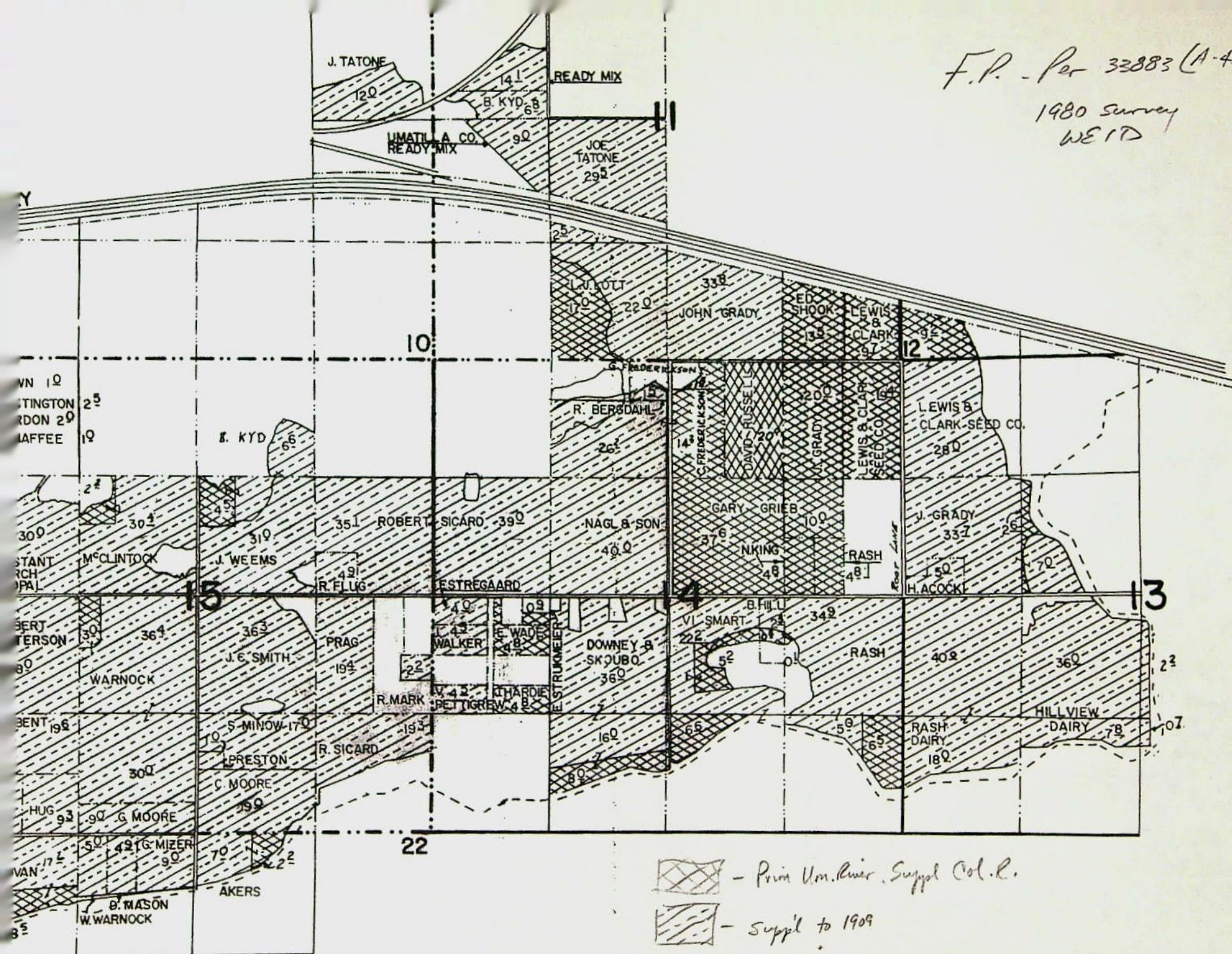
