





Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. Before water use may begin under this permit, the permittee shall install a meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director. The permittee shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order.
- B. The permittee shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

C. The Director may require the permittee to keep and maintain a record of the amount (volume) of water used and may require the permittee to report water use on a periodic schedule as established by the Director. In addition, the Director may require the permittee to report general water use information, the periods of water use and the place and nature of use of water under the permit. The Director may provide an opportunity for the permittee to submit alternative reporting procedures for review and approval.

The permittee shall install, maintain, and operate fish screening and by-pass devices consistent with current Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) standards. Fish screening is to prevent fish from entering the proposed diversion while by-pass devices provide adequate upstream and downstream passage for fish. The required screen and by-pass devices are to be in place and functional prior to diversion of any water. Permittee shall obtain written approval from ODFW that the installation of the required screen and by-pass devices meets the state's criteria or the permittee shall submit documentation that ODFW has determined screens and/or by-pass devices are not necessary.

If the riparian area is disturbed in the process of developing a point of diversion, the permittee shall be responsible for restoration and enhancement of such riparian area in accordance with ODFW's Fish and Wildlife Habitat Mitigation Policy OAR 635-415. For purposes of mitigation, the ODFW Fish and Wildlife Habitat Mitigation Goals and Standards, OAR Chapter 635, Division 415, Section 030 adopted November 13, 1991 shall be followed.

#### STANDARD CONDITIONS

Where two or more water users agree among themselves as to the manner of rotation in the use of water and such agreement is placed in writing and filed by such water users with the watermaster, and such rotation system does not infringe upon such prior rights of any water user not a party to such rotation plan, the watermaster shall distribute the water according to such agreement.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.



# Proposed Final Order

Summary of Recommendation: The Department recommends that the attached draft permit be issued with conditions.

Application History

On July 26, 2004, HAL AND PATRICIA STRAIN submitted an application to the Department for the following water use permit:

- Amount of Water: 0.005 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS)
- Use of Water: DOMESTIC USE EXPANDED FOR ONE HOUSEHOLD
- Source of Water: MIDDLE FORK COQUILLE RIVER, A TRIBUTARY OF SOUTH FORK COQUILLE RIVER
- Area of Proposed Use: Coos County within SECTION 19, TOWNSHIP 29 SOUTH, RANGE 11 WEST, W.M.

On August 20, 2004, the Department mailed the applicant notice of its Initial Review, determining that "the use of 0.005 cubic foot per second of water from Middle Fork Coquille River, a tributary of South Fork Coquille River for domestic use expanded for one household is not allowable, and it appears unlikely that you will be issued a permit." The applicant did not notify the Department to stop processing the application within 14 days of that date.

On August 24, 2004, the Department gave public notice of the application in its weekly notice. The public notice included a request for comments, and information for interested persons about both obtaining future notices and a copy of the proposed final order.

On August 26, 2004, the department received information from the applicant intending to document that no alternate source is available, and that denial of the permit would cause loss of reasonable expectation for use of their property.

In reviewing applications, the Department may consider any relevant sources of information, including the following:

- comments by or consultation with another state agency
- any applicable basin program
- any applicable comprehensive plan or zoning ordinance
- the amount of water available
- the rate and duty for the proposed use
- pending senior applications and existing water rights of record
- the Scenic Waterway requirements of ORS 390.835
- applicable statutes, administrative rules, and case law
- any comments received

# Findings of Fact

The South Coast Basin Program allows the use of water for domestic use.

Senior water rights exist on MIDDLE FORK COQUILLE RIVER, A TRIBUTARY OF SOUTH FORK COQUILLE RIVER, or on downstream waters.

MIDDLE FORK COQUILLE RIVER, A TRIBUTARY OF SOUTH FORK COQUILLE RIVER is not within or above a State Scenic Waterway.

An assessment of water availability has been completed. This assessment compared a calculation of natural streamflow minus the consumption portion of all relevant rights of record. A copy of this assessment is in the file. This assessment determined that water is available for further appropriation (at an 80 percent exceedance probability) during the period December 1 through April 30. The reason water is not available is due to instream water rights. The Department has consulted with ODFW regarding the instream water rights and the proposed use, and the water use proposed under application S-86060. The Department and ODFW have determined that instream values can be protected if the permit is properly conditioned, including limiting the use to human consumption during the period May 1 through November 30.

The Department finds that the amount of water requested, 0.005 CFS, is an acceptable amount.

In accordance with OAR 690-33-330, an interagency team reviewed this proposed use for potential adverse impacts on sensitive, threatened and endangered fish populations. This team consisted of representatives from the Oregon Departments of Water Resources (WRD), Environmental Quality, Fish and Wildlife (DFW), and Agriculture. WRD and DFW representatives included both technical and field staff. The interagency team recommended that additional limitations or conditions of use be imposed on this application as follows:

The permittee shall install, maintain, and operate fish screening and by-pass devices consistent with current Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) standards. Fish screening is to prevent fish from entering the proposed diversion while by-pass devices provide adequate upstream and downstream passage for fish. The required screen and by-pass devices are to be in place and functional prior to diversion of any water. Permittee shall obtain written approval from ODFW that the installation of the required screen and by-pass devices meets the state's criteria or the permittee shall submit documentation that ODFW has determined screens and/or by-pass devices are not necessary.

If the riparian area is disturbed in the process of developing a point of diversion, the permittee shall be responsible for restoration and enhancement of such riparian area in accordance with ODFW's Fish and Wildlife Habitat Mitigation Policy OAR 635-415. For purposes of mitigation, the ODFW Fish and Wildlife Habitat Mitigation Goals and Standards, OAR Chapter 635, Division 415, Section 030 adopted November 13, 1991 shall be followed.

# Instream Water Right Findings

The proposed diversion is necessary to uses designated in ORS  $536.310\,(12)$ , specifically human consumption use (cooking, drinking, and sanitation).

After considering various alternative water sources, including groundwater, stored water, purchased trucked water, community and municipal suppliers, and transfers of existing water rights, the applicant provided documentation that there are no reasonable alternative sources of water.

The Department has considered the following factors:

The maximum economic development of the waters involved: The applicant has demonstrated that denial of this application would result in loss of reasonable expectations for use of the property.

The control of the waters of this state for all beneficial purposes, including drainage, sanitation and flood control: Human consumption includes uses of water for sanitation (OAR 690-300-0010(24)). Because the applicant has no other reasonable source of water to provide sanitation to their home, human consumption use is necessary to provide the beneficial use of sanitation to the applicant.

The amount of waters available for appropriation for beneficial use: Water is not available for the proposed use during the full period requested.

The prevention of wasteful, uneconomic, impracticable or unreasonable use of the waters involved: The use will be conditioned to require reasonable use of the water and installation of equipment to permit water use measurement and reporting.

All vested and inchoate rights to the waters of this state or to the use of waters of this state, and the means necessary to protect such rights: Issuance of this right may increase the likelihood that water may not be available for all water rights. However, those rights are protected by their respective relative priority dates, the prior appropriation doctrine, and established regulatory procedures.

The state water resources policy formulated under ORS 536.295 to 536.350 and 537.505 to 537.534: ORS 536.310(12) provides that "[w]hen available supplies of water are insufficient for all who desire to use them, preference shall be given to human consumption purposes over all other uses." Because the proposed use is human consumption there is a preference for this use over all other uses.

Applying these factors one may conclude that the proposed use could increase the likelihood that water may not be available for all existing water rights (including those for the protection of fish and wildlife) because water is not available for the proposed use during the full period requested. However, because the proposed use is preferred above all other uses, is for sanitation and will not be wasteful, uneconomic, impracticable or unreasonable, and because denial of this application will result in the loss of reasonable expectations for use of the property, the public interest in the proposed use outweighs water availability concerns.

### Conclusions of Law

Under the provisions of ORS 537.153, the Department must presume that a proposed use will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest if the proposed use is allowed in the applicable basin program established pursuant to ORS 536.300 and 536.340 or given a preference under ORS 536.310(12), if water is available, if the proposed use will not injure

other water rights and if the proposed use complies with rules of the Water Resources Commission.

The proposed use requested in this application is allowed in the South Coast Basin Plan, or a preference for this use is granted under the provisions of ORS 536.310(12).

Water is not available for the proposed use.

The proposed use will not injure other water rights.

The proposed use complies with other rules of the Water Resources Commission not otherwise described above.

The proposed use complies with the State Agency Agreement for land use.

Because water is not available, the required presumption has not been established.

OAR 690-310-120(2)(b) states that when the presumption is not established, the Department shall determine whether the proposed use will impair or be detrimental to the public interest considering the factors in ORS 537.170(8), and may make specific findings to demonstrate that even though the presumption is not established, the proposed use will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest, and propose approval of the application with appropriate modifications or conditions.

In consideration of findings described above under "Instream Water Right Findings", even though the presumption is not established, the proposed use will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest if approved with the following conditions:

- During the period May 1 through November 30 of each year, the use shall be limited to HUMAN CONSUMPTION FOR ONE HOUSEHOLD at a diversion rate of 0.005 CFS.
- Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:
  - A. Before water use may begin under this permit, the permittee shall install a meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director. The permittee shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order.
  - B. The permittee shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

- C. The Director may require the permittee to keep and maintain a record of the amount (volume) of water used and may require the permittee to report water use on a periodic schedule as established by the Director. In addition, the Director may require the permittee to report general water use information, the periods of water use and the place and nature of use of water under the permit. The Director may provide an opportunity for the permittee to submit alternative reporting procedures for review and approval.
- 3. The permittee shall install, maintain, and operate fish screening and by-pass devices consistent with current Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) standards. Fish screening is to prevent fish from entering the proposed diversion while by-pass devices provide adequate upstream and downstream passage for fish. The required screen and by-pass devices are to be in place and functional prior to diversion of any water. Permittee shall obtain written approval from ODFW that the installation of the required screen and by-pass devices meets the state's criteria or the permittee shall submit documentation that ODFW has determined screens and/or by-pass devices are not necessary.
- 4. If the riparian area is disturbed in the process of developing a point of diversion, the permittee shall be responsible for restoration and enhancement of such riparian area in accordance with ODFW's Fish and Wildlife Habitat Mitigation Policy OAR 635-415. For purposes of mitigation, the ODFW Fish and Wildlife Habitat Mitigation Goals and Standards, OAR Chapter 635, Division 415, Section 030 adopted November 13, 1991 shall be followed.

When issuing permits, ORS 537.211(1) authorizes the Department to include limitations and conditions which have been determined necessary to protect the public interest. The attached draft permit is conditioned accordingly.

#### Recommendation

The Department recommends that the attached draft permit be issued with conditions.

# Protest Rights and Standing

Under the provisions of 537.621(7), you have the right to protest this proposed final order. Your protest must be in writing, and must include the following:



On December 16, 2003 the Planning Department authorized a property line adjustment with an adjacent parcel creating the current configuration of the subject property; therefore, the subject property is a legal lot of record.

FINDING: The applicant has shown on the submitted plot plan there are no other dwellings on the tract, which consists of 2.00 acres. The assessment records and air photo confirm this.

2. There are no deed restrictions established on the lots or parcels that make up the tract which do not allow a dwelling.

FINDING: The deed for the subject property, recorded in 2004 (2004-6742), does not reference any deed restrictions limiting development on the tract.

3. The lot or parcel on which the dwelling is to be located is predominantly composed of soils that are capable of producing the following cubic feet per acre per year:

FINDING: A letter from the Oregon Department of Forestry dated July 2, 2004 states the cubic foot growth estimates for tax lot 400 to be 137 cubic feet per acre per year. The Planning Department Cartography section determined the cubic feet per acre per year for the subject property to be 200.

Based upon the above criteria the template option required 11 parcels and 3 dwellings established before January 1, 1993, within a 160-acre rectangle centered on the subject tract. The subject property qualifies for a forest template dwelling because there are 11 parcels and 5 dwellings within the 160-acre template.

4. The proposed dwelling is not prohibited by, and will comply with, the requirements of the acknowledged Comprehensive Plan and its implementing measures.

FINDING: The proposed dwelling meets the criteria in Section 4.8.525(B) "Template Dwelling" and the acknowledged Comprehensive Plan.







# THIS IS NOT A PERMIT AND IS SUBJECT TO CHANGE AT THE NEXT PHASE OF PROCESSING.

This letter is to inform you of the preliminary analysis of your water use permit application and to describe your options. In determining whether a water use permit application may be approved, the Department must consider the factors listed below, all of which must be favorable to the proposed use if it is to be allowed. Based on the information you have supplied, the Water Resources Department has made the following preliminary determinations:

# Initial Review Determinations:

- 1. The proposed use is not prohibited by law or rule except where otherwise noted below.
- The use of water from Middle Fork Coquille River, a tributary of South Fork
  Coquille River for domestic use expanded is a classified use under OAR 690-517, the
  South Coast Basin Program.
- 3. Water in the amount of 0.005 cubic foot per second for domestic use expanded for one household is not available from May 1 through November 30.
- 4. Because water is not available for domestic use expanded year round, you may provide additional information that would allow you to pursue a permit for a limited, human consumption (cooking, drinking, and sanitation) use. Please refer to the <u>ADDITIONAL</u> <u>INFORMATION OPPORTUNITY</u> section below for details and additional information required.

The Department has determined there are deficiencies with the application submitted.
 Please refer to the ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REQUIRED section below for specific information.

# Summary of Initial Determinations

Because item #3 above is unfavorable, the use of 0.005 cubic foot per second of water from Middle Fork Coquille River, a tributary of South Fork Coquille River for domestic use expanded for one household is not allowable, and it appears unlikely that you will be issued a permit. At this time, you must decide whether to proceed or to withdraw your application as described below.

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION OPPORTUNITY:

Instream Water Rights for Fish Flows and Scenic Waterway

Due to the lack of water necessary to maintain instream uses protected by an instream water right, water is not available in sufficient quantities to support the proposed use. However, by rule, additional uses may be allowed where public interest in the use is high and the use is conditioned to protect instream values (OAR 690-410-070(2)(a) & 690-310-260(2)). Human consumption of water (cooking, drinking and sanitation) from the proposed source may be considered a high public interest use if there is no reasonable alternative. This may be especially true if denial of the application will result in loss of reasonable expectations for use of the property. If you can provide evidence that this is the case, we will work with the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife to determine conditions which will protect instream values and the scenic waterway during the months listed above in item #3. If necessary, you may request an administrative hold for up to an additional 180 days. You must submit the request in writing, stating how much more time you will need and why you need additional time. If an administrative hold is granted, your application will not be processed further until the requested information is received or the extended deadline has passed.

If we do not receive the requested form by this date and you do not request an administrative hold, we may reject your application consistent with ORS 537.153. If your application is rejected, any fees submitted in excess of the examination fee will be refunded; however, the examination fee is non-



In addition, the Director may require the permittee to report general water use information, the periods of water use and the place and nature of use of water under the permit. The Director may provide an opportunity for the permittee to submit alternative reporting procedures for review and approval.



- You may be required to install fish screens at the diversion to meet Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife specifications for adequate protection of aquatic life.
- The priority date for this application is July 26, 2004.

WARNING: This initial review does not attempt to address various public interest issues such as sensitive, threatened, or endangered fish species. These issues will be addressed as the Department reviews public comments and prepares a proposed final order. You should be aware that, if significant public interest issues are found to exist, such a finding could have an impact on the eventual outcome of your application.

The water source identified in your application may be affected by an Agricultural Water Quality Management Area Plan. These plans are developed by the Oregon Department of Agriculture (ODA) with the cooperation of local landowners and other interested stakeholders, and help to ensure that current and new appropriations of water are done in a way that does not adversely harm the environment. 

After considering various alternative water sources, including groundwater, stored water, purchased trucked water, community and municipal suppliers, and transfers of existing water rights, the applicant provided documentation that there are no reasonable alternative sources of water.

The Department has considered the following factors:

The maximum economic development of the waters involved: The applicant has demonstrated that denial of this application would result in loss of reasonable expectations for use of the property.

The control of the waters of this state for all beneficial purposes, including drainage, sanitation and

flood control: Human consumption includes uses of water for sanitation (OAR 690-300-0010(24)). Because the applicant has no other reasonable source of water to provide sanitation to their home, human consumption use is necessary to provide the beneficial use of sanitation to the applicant.

The amount of waters available for appropriation for beneficial use: Water is not available for the proposed use during the full period requested.

The prevention of wasteful, uneconomic, impracticable or unreasonable use of the waters involved: The use will be conditioned to require reasonable use of the water and installation of equipment to permit water use measurement and reporting.

All vested and inchoate rights to the waters of this state or to the use of waters of this state, and the means necessary to protect such rights: Issuance of this right may increase the likelihood that water may not be available for all water rights. However, those rights are protected by their respective relative priority dates, the prior appropriation doctrine, and established regulatory procedures.

The state water resources policy formulated under ORS 536.295 to 536.350 and 537.505 to 537.534: ORS 536.310(12) provides that "[w]hen available supplies of water are insufficient for all who desire to use them, preference shall be given to human consumption purposes over all other uses." Because the proposed use is human consumption there is a preference for this use over all other uses.

Applying these factors one may conclude that the proposed use could increase the likelihood that water may not be available for all existing water rights (including those for the protection of fish and wildlife) because water is not available for the proposed use during the full period requested. However, because the proposed use is preferred above all other uses, is for sanitation and will not be wasteful, uneconomic, impracticable or unreasonable, and because denial of this application will result in the loss of reasonable expectations for use of the property, the public interest in the proposed use outweighs water availability concerns.

### PFO MODIFICATION #3:

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In the Conclusions of Law, the paragraphs regarding the basin plan, water availability, etc. should be modified as appropriate to indicate negative findings (i.e. the reason(s) that the presumption is not established).

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### PFO MODIFICATION #4:

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DELETE THE FOLLOWING IN CONCLUSIONS OF LAW: \*\*\*SURFACE WATER\*\*\*

For these reasons, the required presumption has been established.

Once the required presumption has been established, under the provisions of ORS 537.153(2) it may be overcome by a preponderance of evidence that either:

- (a) One or more of the criteria for establishing the presumption are not satisfied; or
- (b) The proposed use will impair or be detrimental to the public interest as demonstrated in comments, in a protest . . . or in a finding of the department that shows:
  - (A) The specific public interest under ORS 537.170(8) that would be impaired or detrimentally affected; and
  - (B) Specifically how the identified public interest would be impaired or detrimentally affected.

In this application, all criteria for establishing the presumption have been satisfied, as noted above. The presumption has not been overcome by a preponderance of evidence that the proposed use will impair or be detrimental to the public interest.

The Department therefore concludes that water is available in the amount necessary for the proposed use; the proposed use will not result in injury to existing water rights; and the proposed use will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest as provided in ORS 537.170.

### \*\*\*GROUNDWATER\*\*\*

For these reasons, the required presumption has been established.

Under the provisions of ORS 537.621, once the presumption has been established, it may be overcome by a preponderance of evidence that either:

(a) One or more of the criteria for establishing the

presumption are not satisfied; or

- (b) The proposed use would not ensure the preservation of the public welfare, safety and health as demonstrated in comments, in a protest . . . or in a finding of the department that shows:
  - (A) The specific aspect of the public welfare, safety and health under ORS 537.525 that would be impaired or detrimentally affected; and
  - (B) Specifically how the identified aspect of the public welfare, safety and health under ORS 537.525 would be impaired or be adversely affected.

In this application, all criteria for establishing the presumption have been satisfied, as noted above. The presumption has not been overcome by a preponderance of evidence that the proposed use would impair or be detrimental to the public interest.

The Department therefore concludes that water is available in the amount necessary for the proposed use; the proposed use will not result in injury to existing water rights; and the proposed use would ensure the preservation of the public welfare, safety and health as described in ORS 537.525.

### REPLACE THE ABOVE WITH THIS:

Because [water is not available, etc.], the required presumption has not been established.

[SURFACE: "OAR 690-310-120(2)(b)" GROUNDWATER: "OAR 690-310-120(2)(b)"] states that when the presumption is not established, the Department shall determine whether the proposed use will [SURFACE: "impair or be detrimental to the public interest considering the factors in ORS 537.170(8)" GROUND: "adversely affect the public welfare, safety and health"], and may make specific findings to demonstrate that even though the presumption is not established, the proposed use will not [SURFACE: "impair or be detrimental to the public interest" GROUND: "adversely affect the public welfare, safety and health"], and propose approval of the application with appropriate modifications or conditions.

In consideration of findings described above under "Instream Water Right Findings", even though the presumption is not established, the proposed use will not [SURFACE: "impair or be detrimental to the public interest" GROUND: "adversely affect the public welfare, safety and health"] if approved with the following conditions:

- The use shall be limited to HUMAN CONSUMPTION FOR ONE HOUSEHOLD at a diversion rate of 0.005 CFS.
- 2. Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:
  - A. Before water use may begin under this permit, a totalizing flow meter must be installed at each diversion point. The totalizing flow meter must be installed and maintained consistent with those standards identified in OAR 690-507-645(1) through (3).
  - B. The permittee shall allow the watermaster access to the meter; provided however, where the meter is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
  - C. The Director may require the permittee to keep and maintain a record of the amount (volume) of water used and may require the permittee to report water use on a periodic schedule as established by the Director. In addition, the Director may require the permittee to report general water use information, the periods of water use and the place and nature of use of water under the permit. The Director may provide an opportunity for the permittee to submit alternative reporting procedures for review and approval.







# THIS IS NOT A PERMIT AND IS SUBJECT TO CHANGE AT THE NEXT PHASE OF PROCESSING.

This letter is to inform you of the preliminary analysis of your water use permit application and to describe your options. In determining whether a water use permit application may be approved, the Department must consider the factors listed below, all of which must be favorable to the proposed use if it is to be allowed. Based on the information you have supplied, the Water Resources Department has made the following preliminary determinations:

### Initial Review Determinations:

- 1. The proposed use is not prohibited by law or rule except where otherwise noted below.
- The use of water from from Middle Fork Coquille River, a tributary of South Fork
  Coquille River for domestic use expanded is a classified use under OAR 690-517, the
  South Coast Basin Program.
- Water in the amount of 0.005 cubic foot per second for domestic use expanded for one household is not available from May 1 through November 30.
- 4. Because water is not available for domestic use expanded year round, you may provide additional information that would allow you to pursue a permit for a limited, human consumption (cooking, drinking, and sanitation) use. Please refer to the <u>ADDITIONAL</u> <u>INFORMATION OPPORTUNITY</u> section below for details and additional information required.

The Department has determined there are deficiencies with the application submitted.
 Please refer to the ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REQUIRED section below for specific information.

### Summary of Initial Determinations

Because item #3 above is unfavorable, the use of 0.005 cubic foot per second of water from Middle Fork Coquille River, a tributary of South Fork Coquille River for domestic use expanded for one household is not allowable, and it appears unlikely that you will be issued a permit. At this time, you must decide whether to proceed or to withdraw your application as described below.

### **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION OPPORTUNITY:**

Instream Water Rights for Fish Flows and Scenic Waterway

Due to the lack of water necessary to maintain instream uses protected by an instream water right, water is not available in sufficient quantities to support the proposed use. However, by rule, additional uses may be allowed where public interest in the use is high and the use is conditioned to protect instream values (OAR 690-410-070(2)(a) & 690-310-260(2)). Human consumption of water (cooking, drinking and sanitation) from the proposed source may be considered a high public interest use if there is no reasonable alternative. This may be especially true if denial of the application will result in loss of reasonable expectations for use of the property. If you can provide evidence that this is the case, we will work with the Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife to determine conditions which will protect instream values and the scenic waterway during the months listed above in item #3. These conditions may include mitigation measures to offset the impact of the requested use.

### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION REQUIRED:

Land use information submitted to the Department signed by the local planning authority has
indicated that conditional land use approval is required for your proposed use. Please submit
notice of compliance with land use planning as outlined by Coos County.

Please complete and return the enclosed "Application Supplement for Human Consumption & Livestock Uses" form and land use information no later than Thursday, September 23, 2004. If necessary, you may request an administrative hold for up to an additional 180 days. You must submit the request in writing, stating how much more time you will need and why you need additional time. If an administrative hold is granted, your application will not be processed further until the requested information is received or the extended deadline has passed.

If we do not receive the requested form by this date and you do not request an administrative hold, we may reject your application consistent with ORS 537.153. If your application is rejected, any fees submitted in excess of the examination fee will be refunded; however, the examination fee is non-

refundable and will not be returned. In addition, the priority date associated with your application will be lost.

Please reference the application number when sending any correspondence regarding the conclusions of this initial review. Comments received within the comment period will be evaluated at the next phase of the process.

At this time, you must decide whether to proceed or to withdraw your application as described below.

### Withdrawal Refunds:

If you choose not to proceed, you may withdraw your application and receive a refund (minus a \$50 processing charge per application.) To accomplish this you must notify the Department in writing by Friday, September 3, 2004. For your convenience you may use the enclosed "STOP PROCESSING" form.

### To Proceed With Your Application:

If you choose to proceed with your application, you do not have to notify the Department. Your application will automatically be placed on the Department's Public Notice to allow others the opportunity to comment. After the comment period the Department will complete a public interest review and issue a proposed final order.

### If A Permit Is Issued It Will Likely Include The Following Conditions:

- Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:
  - A. Before water use may begin under this permit, the permittee shall install a meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director. The permittee shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order.
  - B. The permittee shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.
  - C. The Director may require the permittee to keep and maintain a record of the amount (volume) of water used and may require the permittee to report water use on a periodic schedule as established by the Director. In addition, the Director may require the permittee to report general water use information, the periods of water use and the place and nature of use of water under the permit. The Director may provide an opportunity for the permittee to submit alternative reporting procedures for review and approval.

- You may be required to install fish screens at the diversion to meet Oregon Department of Fish and Wildlife specifications for adequate protection of aquatic life.
- 3. The priority date for this application is July 26, 2004.

WARNING: This initial review does not attempt to address various public interest issues such as sensitive, threatened, or endangered fish species. These issues will be addressed as the Department reviews public comments and prepares a proposed final order. You should be aware that, if significant public interest issues are found to exist, such a finding could have an impact on the eventual outcome of your application.

The water source identified in your application may be affected by an Agricultural Water Quality Management Area Plan. These plans are developed by the Oregon Department of Agriculture (ODA) with the cooperation of local landowners and other interested stakeholders, and help to ensure that current and new appropriations of water are done in a way that does not adversely harm the environment. You are encouraged to explore ODA's Water Quality Program web site at http://www.oda.state.or.us/nrd/water\_quality/index.html to learn more about the plans and how they may affect your proposed water use.
