

SUBJECT: PRE-1909 VESTED WATER RIGHT CLAIM MAPS

Alright you guys, this is a test, DO YOU KNOW WHAT TIME IT IS? The answer is, it's time to get the maps, reports, answers, mylars and all that kind of stuff back to the Water Resources Department. There's talk around the office of putting together a "map-patrol" with a tough leader to travel around and retrieve the required documents.

You may remember, I reviewed maps for compliance with Oregon Revised Statutes and Oregon Administrative Rules submitted to support pre-1909 vested water right claims. For the past few months and up to a year ago I have returned maps, requested mylars, asked for clarification, and asked for reports. Some of these files are getting stale.

It is very important that you give me something, preferably the map, mylar, report, etc. but at minimum you must give me a submittal date. The review of the files cannot be completed without the map, report, etc. It is a deterrent to the claimant, your client, for this issue to go unresolved.

If you need copies of anything in the files, just let me know. I have hand written below the file numbers of those I returned to you. The toll free number is 1-800-624-3199.

DEAR MAURICE E. FARR,

The Water Resources Department (WRD) received a little over 500 surface water registration statements in December, 1992. All of the files have been set up and receipts for the fees have been sent. The next step is to insure the maps received in support of the claims are acceptable based on Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) and Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR).

I am returning the map you prepared for Claran H. or Marjorie D. Jesse. You will find the item which requires completion or correction shown below. I have the description followed by the ORS or OAR site and paraphrased statute or rule.

conveyance

ORS 539.120 "...the location of .... and each ditch, canal, pipeline or other means of conveying the water..." The claim is for domestic and stockwater but I cannot tell from your map which structures are delivered water by what conveyance. You must clarify what water is used where for what purposes under the claim to a pre-1909 vested water right.

You must return the map before the claim can be processed. If you cannot have the map to the WRD within 60 days, please inform me as to when it can be expected. Please mark all correspondence with the file number.

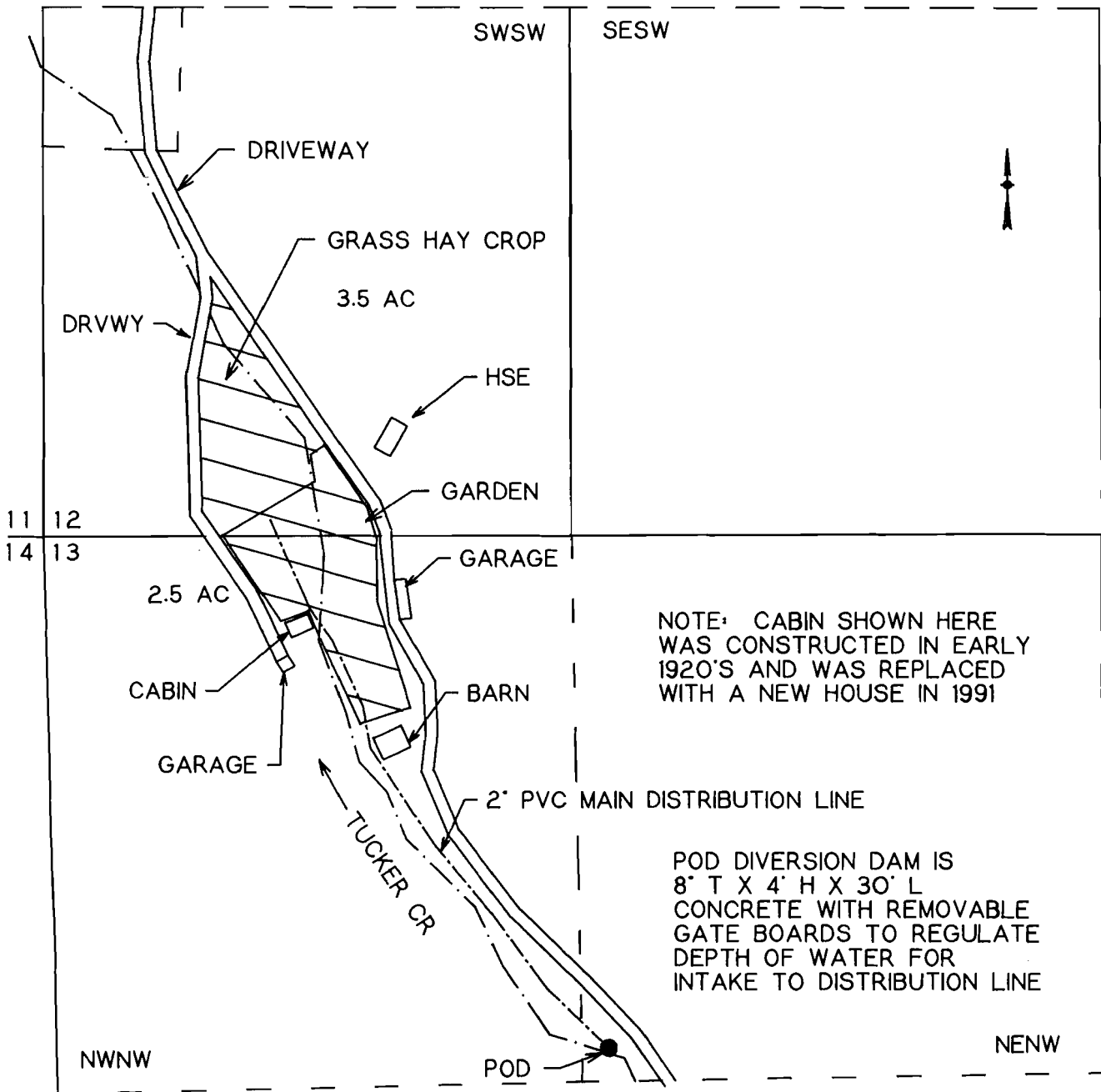

I, Claran H. Jesse and my wife Marjorie D. Jesse talked with Nora Wilson Helias many times about the history of the property that we bought from her and her husband. This is the property for which we are requesting a Water Right. She and her husband bought the property in 1922-23. When Wison died she married Eugene Helias. Water was used continuously on the property for irrigation of garden, orchard and the field below it. It was also used for domestic and for animals. She said the previous owners used the water for similar purposes.

Nora Helias died in 1990 at the age of 100.5. She had a very clear mind and did not use glasses for reading. I talked to a neighbor, Mrs. Winnie Melton, who married Jack Melton in 1924 and a few years later moved to this area. She states that the water was used on this place as long as she can remember.

On March 12, 1993, I talked with Mrs. Ada Melton who is now 96 years old. She came to this area at age 12 in 1909. She believes water was used on this property at that time and probably before then.

We have used the water continuously since our arrival here. I have obtained a map of U.S. Interior Geological Survey and it shows a house on the property. The map was printed in 1894-95. This shows that water was used on this property at that time and probably even before the map was made.

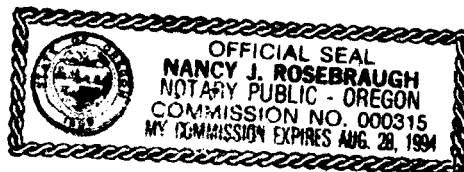
