Dear Ms Cates,

This letter is to remind you of your obligations in filing a pre-1909 vested water right claim. You have submitted the required form. The other two requirements are a map prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner and the fees. I am sending a copy of my letter to you dated June 3, 1993, a copy of your claim form and a copy of the "application" map. I discuss both of these requirements.

It has been pointed out to me that your claim form shows a priority date of Jan - 1921. This process is to put on record the use of water begun before 1909. You will need to clarify the date of first use of water under your claim. To be considered for a vested water right, that date must be before 1909 and you will need to substantiate your claim with any available evidence.

With the irrigation season under way and the possibility of distribution of water by the Watermaster, it is necessary for you to complete the requirements for filing a pre-1909 vested water right or rely on your water right permits.

Dear Ms Cates,

A review of your file in regards to your claim to a pre-1909 vested water right shows that the map you submitted to support your claim does not meet Statutory and Administrative requirements. You submitted a copy of a map for an application for a water right permit. The Statutes and Administrative Rule requirements are quite different between application maps and maps to support a pre-1909 vested water right claim.

A Certified Water Right Examiner must prepare the map in accordance with the applicable requirements. We cannot process your claim until we receive the required map.

I have reviewed the files for application # 7697 and # 72895. I find that application # 7697 was for irrigation of twenty acres filed in 1921 and fees of \$ 6.00 were paid. Application # 72895 was for domestic expanded filed in 1992 and fees of \$ 325.00 were paid. The following fees remain to be paid before we can process your claim:

irrigation of 20 acres = \$ 40.00 - \$ 6.00 = \$ 34.00

domestic = \$ 200.0 - \$ 325.00 = \$ 0.00



stockwater = \$ 200.00 = \$ 200.00

TOTAL DUE = \$ 234.00

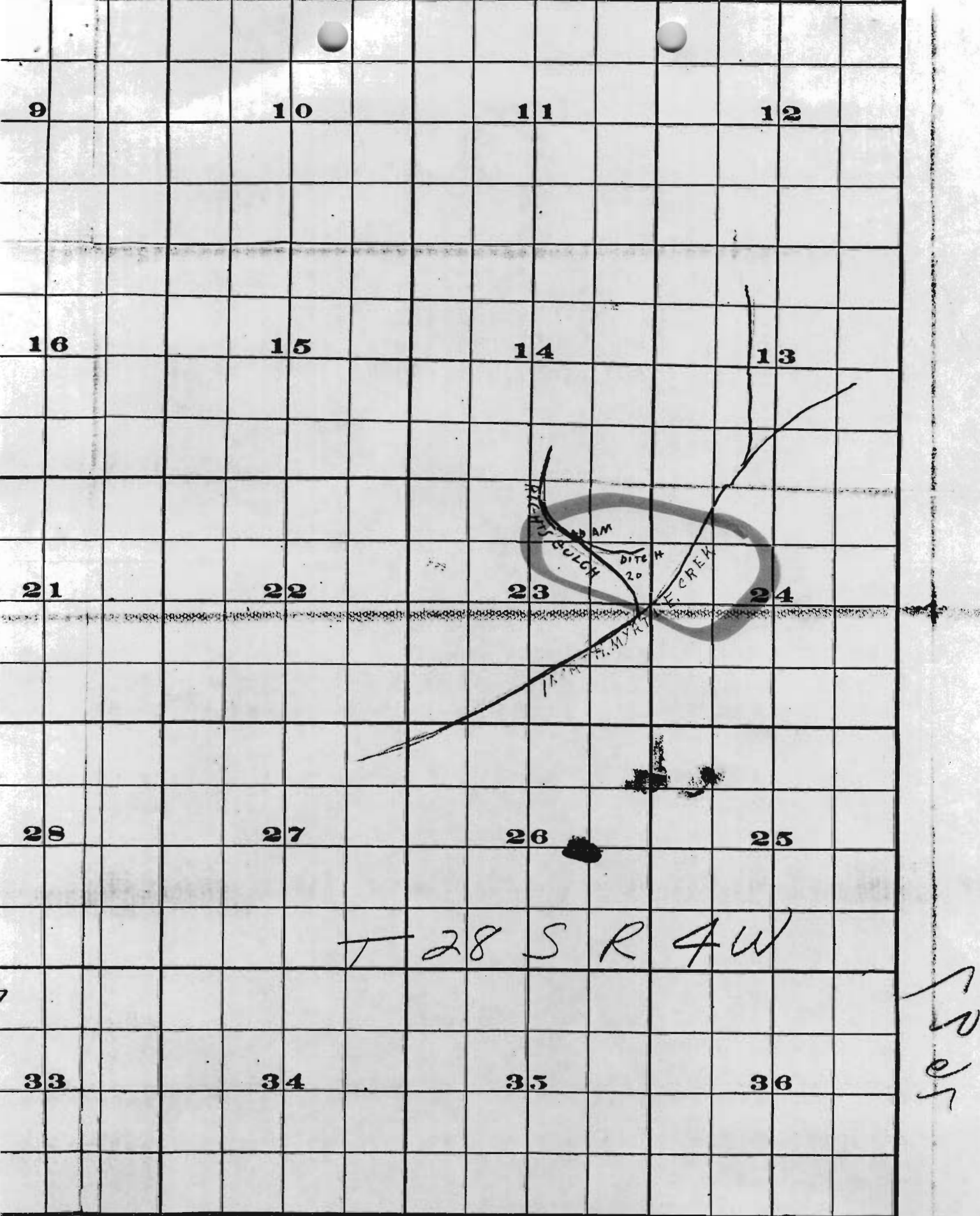

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


Dear Ms. Cates,
