The vested use as reviewed and presented on the enclosed map, registration statement and personal statements is based on ownership records dating between 1880 and 1906, personal testimony of continued use, and my observation and personal knowledge of the Dement Ranch and family history. Any variations from documented pre-1909 use are being applied for under a separate 1992 surface water right application (involves P.O.D. #1 only).

The only historical changes to the use have been through the maintenance or replacement of pipe lines, troughs, and spring protection fencing.

SOURCE: 15 springs with flows ranging from 10 G.P.M. to .10 G.P.M. All flow year round, however only seasonal runoff contributes to tributary flows.

DIVERSION POINTS: All headgates are small, compacted earth and rock containments with basins pooling approximately 2 to 5 gallons. Gravity pipe lines have screened inlets and are held in place by compacted earth. A majority of the springs and troughs are fenced to control access.

MOTOR/PUMP: Troughs are all gravity feed.

PIPE: Sizes vary from 3/4" to 1 1/2" x 25' to 50'.

USE: Stockwater; the Ranch generally carries 300 cow/calf pairs, 100 replacement heifers and bull stock, and 10-14 horses. The distribution is open range.

CALCULATIONS: Based on review of reference manual nomograph for the flow of water in small pipes, all P.O.D.'s exceed the amount of water claimed or put to beneficial use, as follows:

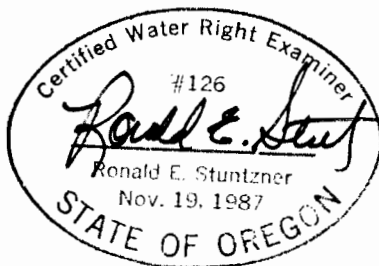

I am applying for pre-1909 water rights on all the springs and streams on our ranch for watering livestock. A map indicating the location of these springs and streams is included.

Also included are the documentations of ownership since the late 1800's and the legal descriptions of the properties.

My grandfather came to Oregon with his parents by covered wagon on the Oregon Trail in 1852. His father took up a Homestead near the present community of Broadbent and began raising cattle. Grandfather acquired a homestead in 1968 near his father's place and over the years bought out other small homesteaders located in northern Curry County. Most of these properties were natural prairies or mountain meadows for the most part and were intermingled with timber lands that covered most of the region. The early homesteaders were looking for open lands that did not need to be cleared so they took up claims on these prairies. Because of soil conditions and topography these lands were not suited for farming, and being too small to make a living in just raising cattle, they sold out.

My Dad later acquired these lands from his father and rented a nearby ranch belonging to the J. A. Haines Estate. He was able to buy the Haines Place in about 1927. Dad operated this ranch for most of his life and I grew up working with him on the place. I was able to acquire the ranch in 1968 and have operated it since.

Livestock have been continually on this ranch since the late 1800's and have watered in the streams and from the springs from the time these lands were first settled.

These springs vary in flow from maybe a gallon every thirty minutes to perhaps a gallon a minute. Very few of these springs give water that flow off the property and none of them contribute any water to the flow of the Sixes River during the dry months of the year. Our ranch is located almost entirely in the Sixes River watershed and if we didn't use any of the water during the dry months the main continuously running part of the river wouldn't be affected, nor would it if we used it all.

I am 72 years old and have spent most of my life on this ranch. During this time I can honestly say that I have not seen any indication of riparian damage caused by livestock using the streams to get their water. We are producing more pounds of beef per acre now than ever and the condition of our range is as good if not better than ever before. This family has been in the cattle business for four generations and I just hope that someone in the family will still be raising cattle for many generations to come.

To whom it may concern:

My father, Edward M. Hoffman, was born in 1858, and lived at the Powers Junction, 3 miles south of Myrtle Point, from the age of six weeks to eighty one and one half years.

When he was a teenager and for several years, he helped his friend, Russell Dement, to round up beef cattle in the Eckley Area, drive them to Empire, and load them on the coastwise ships for the San Francisco market. These herds of cattle belonged to Russell's father, Samuel M. Dement, who settled on the

South Fork of the Coquille River soon after my grandfather and grandmother settled at the Powers Junction in 1854.

Samuel M. Dement and his family were good neighbors and friends to my grandmother, Jemima Hoffman, widowed in 1862, with 3 children under five years of age. She continued to live at Powers Junction until her death in 1924, age eighty three. Samuel Dement was a blacksmith and made a set of andirons for grandma's fireplace. These were used in our fireplace during my growing up years.

When Russell Dement carried on the beef cattle business in the Eckley area, my oldest brother, Frazer Hoffman,

helped to round up and drive the herds to Roseburg, where they were loaded on the cattle trains to San Francisco or Portland markets for sale. This transportation was much faster & saved much shrinkage of weight.

Russell Dement's son, Ellis Dement, took over the beef cattle business on the Eckley area holdings including the Haynes property, which adjoined the Dements. He rented it for several years & then purchased it, including all water rights, from the Haynes family heirs.

My oldest son, Dean Epperson, a high school student in Myrtle Point from 1940-1944, was Ellis Dement's favorite cowboy, and spent many, many weekends

at Eckley, helping Ellis feed and salt the cattle and worked there part-time in the summers too. I'm sure he could inform you of every waterhole, spring, and stream and salt-lick in the entire Eckley region.

I remember of all my growing up years of seeing the many herds of Dement's beef cattle being driven to market, to Myrtle Point & shipped from there by train after the railroad was built. These herds were from the Eckley area pastures.

Now, Sam Dement and his wife, Dorothy, have operated the beef cattle business in the Eckley Holdings since his father's (Ellis's) retirement. They are the ~~the~~ fourth generation of the Dement family to con-

That prior to 1909 I was acquainted with the Joseph A. Haines family who lived on a ranch at Eckley, Oregon, a community located in the upper Sixes River area of northern Curry County, Ore. My father helped in the construction of the Haines ranch house in the late 1800's and I was also well acquainted with some of the Haines children.

I taught school in the Eckley schoolhouse during both the 1916 and 1917 sessions and boarded with Hattie Haines Hampton and her husband Hugh who lived on the ranch in 1916. In 1917 I lived with Ed Haines and his wife who were living on the ranch that year while I taught school.

The Haines families were cattle ranchers from the time they settled on the ranch around 1870 until about 1914 when Ellis Dement leased the pasture until he finally purchased the ranch in 1927.

The Dements have continued to raise cattle on this ranch and livestock have used the streams and springs for water continuously since the late 1800's.

This affidavit is made and executed as a statement of facts within my personal knowledge in support of an application for perfection of prior 1909 water rights.

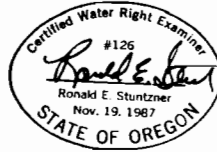

The Water Resources Department (WRD) received a little over 500 surface water registration statements in December, 1992. All of the files have been set up and receipts for the fees have been sent. The next step is to insure the maps received in support of the claims are acceptable based on Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) and Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR).

I am returning the map you prepared for Samuel Dement. You will find the item which requires completion or correction shown below. I have the description followed by the ORS or OAR site and paraphrased statute or rule.

ORS 539.240 (2) (d) (B) "The location of place of use by quarter-quarter section..." You can show these on the map or listed on an attachment.

OAR 690-14-170-1 "The map scale shall be 1" = 1320', 1" = 400', or the scale of the county assessor map..." I'm not going to require you to change the scale of the map. I want you to know what is required for a final proof and pre-1909 map.

My interest right now is to get the map in acceptable form to support the claim to pre-1909 water use. I have listed the two items above of which you only have to add the lines and identify the 1/4 1/4's.

I do have some questions about other items on the map. You have shown the use as "agricultural" but the claimant lists the use as stock water. I need you to explain what you mean by "agricultural" and if the use is actually stock water, you must change the map. In your certification you show "... an accurate representation of the proposed water use...". This is a claim to water use which began prior to 1909 and has continued. I need you to explain what you mean by "proposed water use". A priority date for the livestock use directly from the streams has not been shown anywhere. If you can supply that information I won't have to get it from the claimant.

There are two major problems with this claim. I want you to be aware of them at this time. I will need your help in getting this straightened out. They won't have any affect on the map. I have sent a copy of the OAR's Chapter 690 Division 28. OAR # 690-28-025-2 requires seperate forms for different priority dates and non-contiguous properties. There are a total of eight different priorities dates and the property is not contiguous. This is something the claimant will have to remedy and you may be able to help.

I have seen this handled in two ways. First by sorting out the priority dates and properties and filing the additional forms and fees. The one map would be acceptable to support all of the various claims. Another way would be to change all of the priority dates to the same one. This would have to be the most junior. And again the one map would be acceptable to support the claim. I'm not too concerned about the non-contiguous property considering the amount and use of the water.

You must return the map before the claim can be processed. If you cannot have the map to the WRD within 60 days, please inform me as to when it can be expected. Please mark all correspondence with the file number.
