CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

confirms the right to use the waters of JOHNSON CREEK, tributary to PACIFIC OCEAN, WHEN AVAILABLE WITH ANY DEFICIENCY IN THE AVAILABLE SUPPLY FROM JOHNSON CREEK TO BE MADE UP BY APPROPRIATION FROM UNNAMED STREAM, A TRIBUTARY OF JOHNSON CREEK FOR THE PURPOSES OF IRRIGATION, FROST CONTROL, AND HARVESTING CRANBERRIES FOR 4.3 ACRES.

This right was perfected under Permit 44583. The date of priority is JUNE 12, 1979. The amount of water to which this right is entitled is limited to an amount actually used beneficially, and shall not exceed 0.20 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND (CFS), BEING 0.11 CFS FOR IRRIGATION, 0.11 CFS FOR FROST CONTROL, AND 0.20 CFS FOR HARVESTING CRANBERRIES, if available at the authorized points of diversion, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion.

The points of diversion (POD) are located as follows:

UNNAMED STREAM	29 S	14 W	WM	8	SE NE	970 FEET NORTH & 250 FEET WEST FROM E1/4 CORNER, SECTION 8
JOHNSON CREEK	29 S	14 W	WM	9	SW NW	1415 FEET SOUTH & 824 FEET EAST FROM NE CORNER, SECTION 8

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, is limited to a diversion of ONE-FORTIETH of one cubic foot per second, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated, and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 3.0 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year, for cranberries. If for the irrigation of any other crop, this appropriation shall be limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.

The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use to which this right is appurtenant is as follows:

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than a contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-004-0080, you may either petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

The quantity of water diverted at the new point of diversion, shall not exceed the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion, excluding any substantial inflow between the original and new points of diversion. Original point of diversion location from Johnson Creek is as follows:

The water user shall maintain and operate a headgate or valve, and an in-line flow meter, weir, or other suitable device for measuring and recording the quantity of water diverted.

When required by the Department, the water user shall install and maintain weirs or other suitable devices reasonably necessary for measuring and recording the quantity of water available at the original point of diversion and any substantial inflow to Johnson Creek between the original and new points of diversion. The type and plans of the measuring devices must be approved by the Department prior to beginning construction and shall be installed under the general supervision of the Department.

This certificate is issued to confirm a change in POINT OF DIVERSION approved by an order of the Water Resources Director entered October 5, 1994, at Special Order Volume 48, Page 310, approving Transfer Application 7027, and supersedes Certificate 67139, State record of Water Right Certificates.

The right to the use of the water for the above purpose is restricted to beneficial use on the lands or place of use described.
