
Attached hereto is the Notice of Completion of Construction in the matter of the well and system for this application.

Gentlemen:

This will acknowledge receipt of the returned application No. G-4728 with items No. 1, 2 and 3 on the application completed.

Items No. 3 and 4 on the application indicate that the 6 inch well is to be used for domestic water supply and the 12 inch well is for irrigation. Domestic use, not exceeding 15,000 gallons of water per day, is exempt from filing from a ground water source. This quantity of water is considered sufficient for a twenty to thirty home sub-division development. Unless your domestic needs exceed the exempted quantity, the 6 inch well should be deleted from items No. 2, 3, 4, 8 and the map.

If the domestic use is to be filed on, the application will require an additional \$10.00 recording fee. The number of families to be served domestic water should be designated in the section provided for remarks. The location of the domestic use must then be shown on the map and described in item No. 12 on the application.

I am returning your application and transparency map for correction. The application is endorsed so that in order to retain its date of priority, it must be returned to this office on or before March 21, 1969.

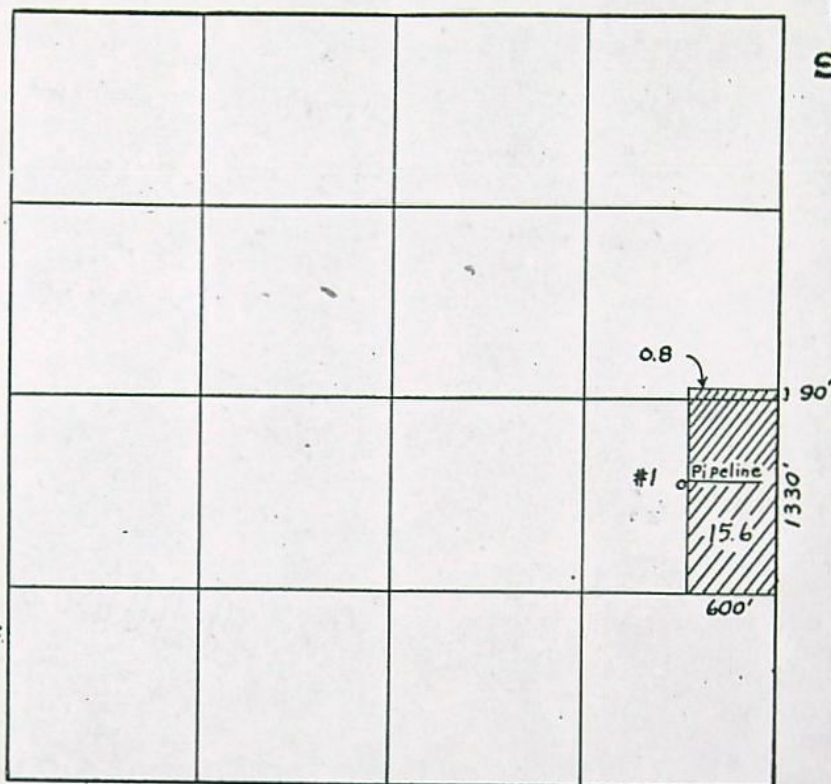
