

The History of a River and Its People

ESOURCES DEPT M. OREGON handwriting. The Spencerian (slanting) System of writing was Othen standard; the Vertical System was adopted in 1900.

George W. Dimmick, who had a contract with Douglas County to operate the ferry known then as the Dimmick and Fryer Ferry, had been appointed county treasurer, and Clen Minter was hired as deputy to tend the ferry. In December 1899, there was an unusual rise in the river. A large tree floating downstream fouled and broke the ferry cable. After the flood subsided, the cable was in the process of being put back into service when Minter was drowned, January 19, 1900.

His death placed upon his wife the responsibility of providing for the family and keeping it together. Well-meaning friends urged her to farm out the three older boys and accept charity from the county for the three youngest children, which she refused.

Mrs. Minter was appointed to administer the estate of her husband. Clen's lease on the farm expired in the fall of 1900. She spent most of the summer settling her affairs, harvesting the crop, and finding a place to live. Wallace Fryer harvested the crop for one-third. Cap Maupin assisted her in finding a place to live by arranging with A. E. Ozauf of Scottsburg to grant her a loan of \$150 to buy eighty-eight acres of unimproved land adjoining the Ziba Dimmick donation claim.

During the summer of 1900, the older boys cut and peeled logs for a barn, and the neighbors helped raise it. Boyd and Henry Rader put up a two-story rough-lumber house, sixteen by twenty-four feet, and a lean-to cover for a woodshed. A chicken house and a hog pen completed the ranch buildings.

By October all expendable property had been liquidated and the family moved in. A few farm tools, a team of horses, two cows, and a sow with six pigs were the extent of farm equipment and livestock; the household furniture consisted of the barest necessities. Chairs were hand-made with rawhide seats. Bedsteads were also hand-made, with slats for springs. Everything was of the plainest sort, but it was home, and home it remained for forty-five years.

Mary Ann Minter, almost single-handed and against great odds, kept the family together and gave them the advantage of a common-school education. Many a night the children were hilled to sleep by the hum of the old spinning wheel she had bought from Mrs. William Moore in 1885 - working up three fleeces of wool into yarn for payment.

Most pioneer women were trained to spin and weave from girlhood, but first they had to prepare the wool. The first step in preparing varn was to take wool fresh from the sheep's back and remove all grease or lanolin. Burrs, pieces of straw, or any foreign matter had to be tediously removed by hand. The wool was then carded for spinning into rolls the size of one's finger. The next step was to spin the roll into a continuous thread, which had to be doubled and twisted into knittable yarn. The yarn was then washed thoroughly before being wound into balls for convenient handling. It could be dyed either before or after knitting. All of this required skill and hard work. Mary Ann Minter made her own varn and sometimes sheared the sheep herself. She knitted the socks and mittens for five boys, and also managed to knit gloves and socks for others; for the latter she received from fifty cents to one dollar per pair.

Besides raising a family of her own, her greatest responsibility was to perform the duties of midwife for the community. She spent the last forty-five years of her life on the land she bought with the help of the Masonic Lodge, of which her husband had been a member. She died in October 1944, at the age of eighty-three and was buried beside her husband in the Kellogg Cemetery.

Early residents of Kellogg, even the second generation, are rapidly thinning as the years pass. The old schoolhouse that Clen Minter helped to build looks neglected and forgotten in its present setting. When the rural school districts consolidated with the Elkton High School district, the old schoolhouse-along with the grounds upon which it stands—was transferred to the American Sunday School Union by Douglas County to be used as a place of worship in the Kellogg Community. After nearly sixty


