On November 19, 1992, I made a survey of the above listed property and viewed the water system installed and in use. I used an assessor map and an aerial photo during the course of preparing this final proof survey and site map.

SOURCE: Water is taken from an unnamed stream which is tributary to Elk Creek and the Umpqua River.

DIVERSION POINT: The diversion point is a small earthen and rock dam 15 feet long by 2 feet high, with side slopes approximately 2 feet horizontal to 1 foot vertical.

PIPE: The water distribution is through a pair of 4" diameter aluminum irrigation pipes laid on top of the ground, one pipe to each side of the creek. Each pipe is laid on an approximate grade of 1%. The grass hay pastures are irrigated by flooding from this irrigation pipe laid at the upper edge of each of the two pastures.

USE(S): Water is used for irrigation of grass hay pasture.

HEAD: No elevation difference was measured as the water in the distribution pipe is moved by gravity.

a tributary of Elk Creek for the purpose of irrigation of 3.2 acres

under Permit No. 38560 and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from August 21, 1973 that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed 0.025 cubic foot per second

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 as projected within Hancock DLC 45, Section 21, T22S, R7W, WM; 100 feet South and 2080 feet West from East 1/4 Corner, Section 21.

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to one-eightieth of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
