FINAL ORDER

**Summary:** Order approving the renewal of Application G-14756 and issuing Permit G-18939.

***Authority***

The application was processed in accordance with Oregon Administrative Rule (OAR) 690-502-0200. These administrative rules provide the authority to extend a water use permit, for a period not to exceed five years, provided that the groundwater resource can probably support the extended use. **FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. On May 22, 1998, Irwin D. Schimmel submitted an application to the Department for a water use permit. The proposed use is located in the Chehalem Mountain Groundwater Limited Area.
2. On March 16, 1999, the Department issued a water use permit. This permit expired on March 16, 2004. The permit was renewed in August 2004, June 2009, and December 2013.
3. On February 23, 2006, the application was assigned to I.S. Properties, L.P.
4. On May 16, 2008, the applicant submitted a Claim of Beneficial Use.

**CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

1. The Department finds that the groundwater resource can probably support the extended use.

NOTE: When issuing permits, ORS 537.628(1) authorizes the Department to include limitations and conditions which have been determined necessary to protect the public welfare, safety and health.

**NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW**

This is a Final Order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 536.075 and ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

**ORDER**

Application G-14756 has been renewed and Permit G-18939 is issued. This permit shall expire on October 31, 2028.
