On November 18, 1992, I made a survey of the above listed property and viewed the water system installed and in use. I used an assessor map and an aerial photo during the course of preparing this final proof survey and site map.

SOURCE: Water is taken from Cavitt Creek, tributary to Little River, the North Umpqua River, and the Umpqua River.

DIVERSION POINT: The diversion point is a natural depression in the south side of the Cavitt Creek.

PUMP: Century 1/2 hp motor, type C-S, Part # 8-11-9091-20, SFA 10.0/5.0, SF 116, 3450 RPM, 60 cycles, 115/230 volts, 7.4/3.7 amps, connected to a centrifugal pump, capacity of the pump is 6 GPM.

PIPE: The water distribution main line is 3/4" diameter PVC from the point of diversion to the cabin.

USE(S): Water is used for domestic one family.

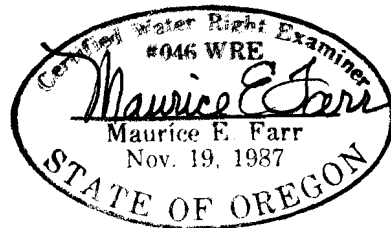
HEAD: Elevation difference between the point of diversion and the cabin was estimated to be twenty five feet.

	pump discharge	0.013 cfs	6.0 GPM

POINT OF BEGINNING: Assessor's maps and aerial photos were used to draw the accompanying map.

REMARKS: Existing Water Right, domestic for one family, Permit No. 34651, Certificate No. 39979, 0.01 cfs, priority date September 8, 1969.

The final proof survey and inspection of the use as found to be completed under terms and conditions of File# SWR-177 was completed by me on November 9, 1992, and the facts contained in this report and accompanying vested water right map are correct to the best of my knowledge.

Gentlemen:

In filing application for 'Surface Water Registration Statement Pre-1909 Vested Water Right Claim' I wish to make the following comments:

- ✓ 1. I have enclosed the report from the Douglas County Title Co. showing the land holders from 1906 to the present on my property, Section 14, Township 27, Range 03, Southeast corner of the Southwest corner of Cavitt Creek.
- ✓ 2. Enclosed is the map by the Certified Water Rights Examiner, Maurice E. Farr, 1960 S. W. Burdette Drive, Roseburg.
- ✓ 3. Also enclosed is my check for \$200.00 covering the fee for single family domestic use.
- ✓ 4. I presently have in my possession a domestic use Water Right Permit #34651 which was approved June 4, 1970.
5. As evidence that the water has been under continuous use since February 24, 1909, the enclosed report from the Title Company shows continuous ownership. In addition, I'm enclosing pictures of the log cabin that was on my property built by shepherders. I have since razed the cabin because it was so old, I felt it was a hazard to my family.

Since we are talking about domestic use of the water, I believe that water from the creek was continuously used by all the previous owners listed on the title report. My neighbor tells me that there was an old saw mill on the property and I see evidence that the land had been logged. There are many large moss covered stumps with spring-board marks that indicated they were using cross-cut saws when they logged this area.

My late husband's parents (the O. J. Feldkamps) purchased the property from John T. Nelson, who was living on the property at the time, in 1946. They used the cabin every weekend until they died

and they took water from Cavitt Creek for their use since there was no well, and no evidence there ever had been a well. From 1946 until the present time, I can personally attest to the continuous use of water from Cavitt Creek.

Nellie Palouse, an Indian, was allotted this property by President Theodore Roosevelt in 1906. I know Mr. William West who remembers a family in the area named Palouse whom we feel are descendants of Nellie. Mr. West went to school within 12 miles of the Cavitt Creek property during the 1930's. This would indicate the Palouse'es have lived in this area for a long time.

As I come upon further evidence of the continuous use of the stream, I will forward it to your office. In the meantime, I hope this satisfies my eligibility for a pre-1909 vested water right.

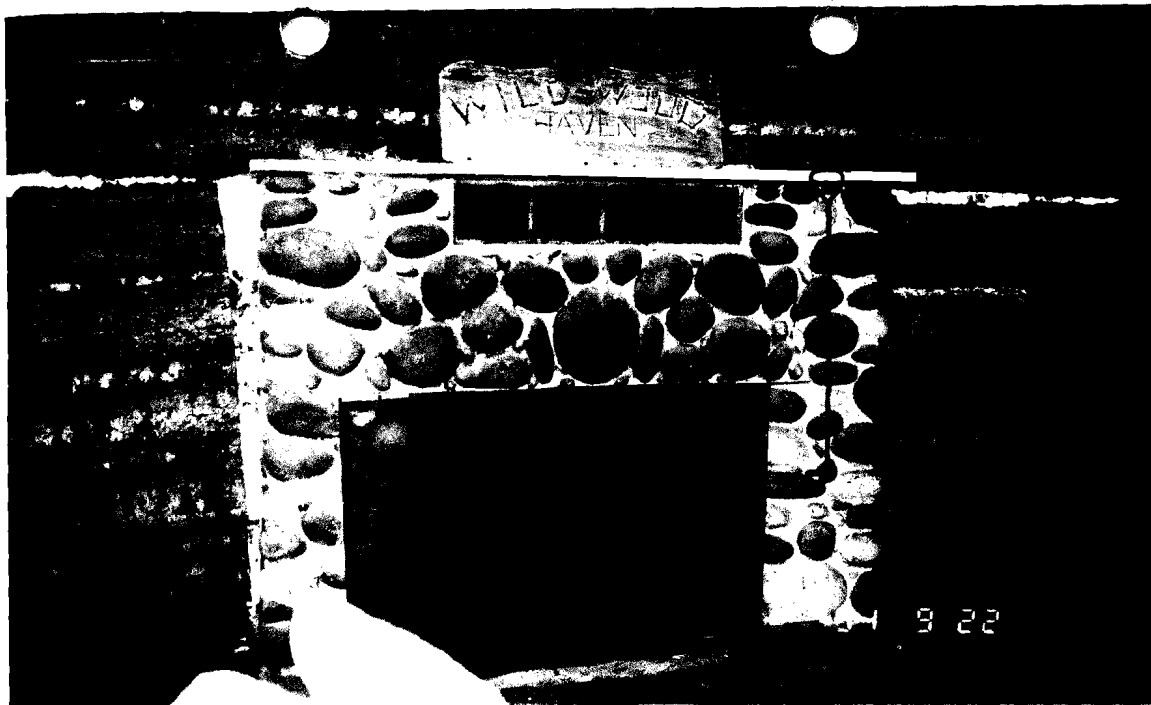
The old fireplace had no foundation and it was sinking into the ground. We tried to prop it up with a brace.

Whereas there has been deposited in the General Land Office of the United States a schedule of allotments approved by the Secretary of the Interior September 29, 1906 whereby it appears that Willie Palouse an Indian of the Klamath and Malilla tribe or band has been allotted the following described lands:

Section 1 of the north east quarter and the west half of the south east quarter of section 12 township twenty seven, south of Range three west of Willamette Meridian, in Oregon, containing one hundred and sixty acres.

And whereas the United States of America in consideration of the premises has allotted and by these presents does allot unto the said Willie Palouse the land above described and does hereby certify that it does and will hold the land thus allotted subject to the provisions of the act of Congress for the period of twenty five years.

And whereas the said Indian, at the expiration of said period the United States will convey the same by patent to said Indian in fee, discharged of said trust and free of all charge or incumbrance whatsoever, if the said Indian does not die before the expiration of the trust period; but in the event said Indian does die before the expiration of that period this patent and the allotment upon which it is based shall be canceled and the said land shall revert to the United States and be thereafter disposed of in the manner prescribed by law.

Provided that the President of the United States may in his discretion, extend said period. And there is reserved from the lands hereby granted a right of way thereon for ditches and canals constructed by the authority of the United States.

In testimony whereof I, Theodore Roosevelt, President of the United States of America have caused these letters to be made Patent and the seal of the General Land Office to be hereunto affixed.



Alright you guys, this is a test, DO YOU KNOW WHAT TIME IT IS? The answer is, it's time to get the maps, reports, answers, mylars and all that kind of stuff back to the Water Resources Department. There's talk around the office of putting together a "map-patrol" with a tough leader to travel around and retrieve the required documents.

You may remember, I reviewed maps for compliance with Oregon Revised Statutes and Oregon Administrative Rules submitted to support pre-1909 vested water right claims. For the past few months and up to a year ago I have returned maps, requested mylars, asked for clarification, and asked for reports. Some of these files are getting stale.

It is very important that you give me something, preferably the map, mylar, report, etc. but at minimum you must give me a submittal date. The review of the files cannot be completed without the map, report, etc. It is a deterrent to the claimant, your client, for this issue to go unresolved.

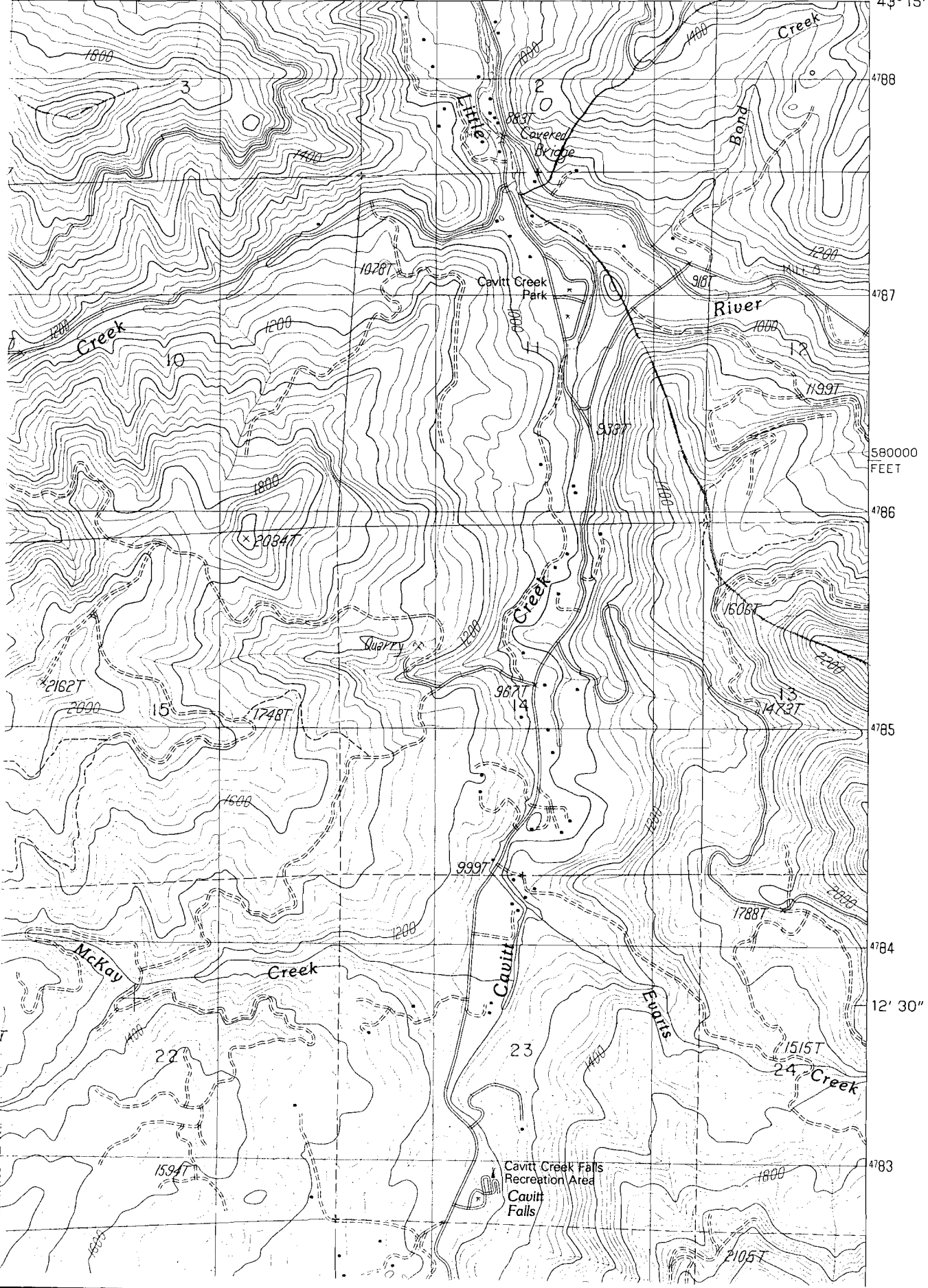
