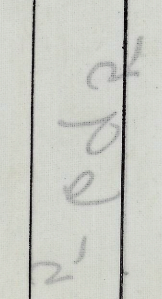

I am enclosing a copy of Permit No. 3497 in the name of the South Side Ditch Company. The fee provided by law for furnishing this copy amounts to 50 cents. I am unable to find any information to show that John Jackson owned this Permit at any time, and if you now own this water right, I would suggest that you secure an assignment of the same from the South Side Ditch Company. I am enclosing a blank which may be used for such assignment, and the fee provided by law for recording same in this office is \$1.00.

You will note that the permit requires that construction work begin on or before September 12th, 1918, and an extension of time was granted until June 1st, 1920, within which to complete construction, and you have until October 1st, 1921, within which to apply the water to the proposed use. Our records show that notices have been filed showing that construction work was begun prior to September 12th, 1918. If construction work was completed prior to June 1st, 1920, the Notice of Completion of Construction should be filed. I am enclosing a blank for such Notice.

On the other hand, if the construction work was not completed, an application for extension of time should be made, setting forth the reasons for not being able to complete construction work within the extension formerly granted. This will place the permit in good standing.
