



Information: The permittee, Mr. Jack Warner, lives on and owns the property described in the application. His address is H. C. 84, box 13 G 91, Myrtle Point Oregon 97458. His phone number is 572-2602. This water system was developed many years ago and is as described on the application except that Point of Diversion No. 2 is north from the 1/4 Corner common to sections 32 and 33, not southeast as shown on the application map. Mr. Warner took me to both P. D.s and provided some of the following information.

Sources: P. D. No. 1 is from the South Fork of Coquille River. P. D. No. 2 is from a spring, the headwaters of a tributary of Roland Creek, a tributary of South Fork of Coquille River

Diversion Points: No. 1 is from a depression in the river bed near the north bank at the foot of an old road. No. 2 is a developed spring. The surface soil was removed; perforated pipe was laid to collect the water and covered with river gravel. The developed area is about 150 square ft.

Motor: For P. D. No. 1 the motor is a Sears submersible 1 h. p. motor and pump unit. The capacity is 20 gals per minute. P. D. No. 2 is a gravity system.


Pipe: P. D. No. 1; from the pump the water goes through about 270 feet of 1½" black plastic pipe to a pressure tank and then through 1" plastic pipe to the stock watering tank and to the two houses.

Uses: P. D. No. 1; this water serves two families, Jack Warner and his son as shown on the attached map. It also serves up to 200 head of stock, mainly beef cattle. P. D. No. 2; this water is for stock watering only and serves up to 200 head of beef cattle.

Lift: From river level to point of use is about 85 feet.

Survey Tie: P. D. No. 1; A compass traverse was run from the P. D. to the Southwest corner of the NW¼NW¼ of Sec. 34, 30-12. This is a fence corner. P. D. No. 2 is 64 feet north and 4 ft. east of the West 1/4 Corner of Section 33, 30-12. The monument is a brass cap on 1½" pipe post standing above ground in the fence line.

The final proof survey and inspection of the use as found to be completed under the terms and conditions of permit No.50434 was completed by me on October 7, 1989, and the facts contained in this report and accompanying final proof map are correct to the best of my knowledge.



I, Jack Warner, agree to the findings of the CWRE and do submit this site report and map as my Claim of Beneficial Use of the water as provided under the terms and conditions of my permit No. 50434.

This will acknowledge that your Surface Water Registration Statement in the name of JACK B WARNER has been received by our office. The fees required for filing your claim are \$200.00. Since permit # 50434 does not cover stockwater from Rowland Creek we can not credit your earlier payment under that permit. Your registration statement has been numbered SWR-220.

The map you submitted with your claim is not acceptable. ORS 539.240 (2) (d) requires the map be prepared by a Certified Water Right Examiner (CWRE). Within 60 days of this letter you must send a letter to this address indicating you have contracted with a CWRE to prepare your map. You should send your letter to my attention. In your letter you must identify the name of the CWRE who will prepare your registration statement map. We will contact the CWRE to arrange a map submittal deadline.

We will not be able to process your claim until we have received your map. If you have any questions regarding this process, please do not hesitate to give me a call.

STATEMENT IN SUPPORT OF PRE-1909 VESTED WATER RIGHT

My wife and I own and operate a livestock operation on a major portion of the William Rowland Donation Land Claim #37 and other lands purchased by my grandfather, William N. Warner in 1866 and certified as a century farm by the Oregon Historical Society in 1966.

From 1866 until his death in 1898, William N. Warner conducted a livestock operation on the property as shown by exhibits. The property consisting of 841.99 acres went through probate proceedings ending August 16, 1905. During that time period a continued use of the property and its resources are shown by enclosed exhibits.


At final probate, my father received his share of the property, resided there and continued to raise livestock until my wife and I purchased the last of the property in 1963 with a Department of Veteran Affairs farm/home loan.

My wife and I reside on the farm and utilize its resources to manage and carry on a livestock operation.


Since the time my grandfather settled here the southfork of the Coquille River and its tributaries have been a year round source of water for livestock and domestic use and on some portions of the property the only source during the summer months. The southfork of the Coquille River flows through the Donation Land Claim for a distance of more than one and one half miles and was always available and used during the period in question. The Rowland Creek property was served by Rowland Creek and its tributaries as an instream use for livestock. I now hold a certificate of water right under permit number 50434 with a priority date of May 5, 1988. I believe that I am eligible for the prior 1909 date.

My present permit would remain the same except for the earlier date and the addition of an instream vested right on Rowland Creek, a tributary of the southfork of the Coquille River in the NE 1/4 of the SW 1/4, Section 33.

The above is a factual and true statement.
