Additional Information Requested.

- 1) Conveyance: As now shown on the map, the water used for Domestic and Stockwater is conveyed by the 3 inch Aluminum pipe described in the original site report. the buried pipe has reducing TEE's at the places for the stock watering tanks, households and garden area. The household water is used for lawn and gardens.
- 2) Diversion Point Size: The system used during the irrigation season is the shown 3 inch Aluminum pipe, from the point of diversion to the fields to be irrigated. Water lines (1" PVC ) is TEE'ed off at various points to fill the watering tanks for the stock and to irrigate the homes lawns and garden areas.

NOTE: Both residences have another system for their household water (inside the house) used for human consumption. Water from this system is also used during the winter months for stock. Details of which are as follows:







The Water Resources Department (WRD) received a little over 500 surface water registration statements in December, 1992. All of the files have been set up and reciepts for the fees have been sent. The next step is to insure the maps received in support of the claims are acceptable based on Oregon Revised Statutes (ORS) and Oregon Administrative Rules (OAR).

OAR 690-28-025-(4)-(c) "The dimensions and capacity of any existing diversion systems." You must show or describe the system used for domestic and stockwater.

paper

OAR 690-14-170-1 "...in ink on permanent-quality linen or 0.003-inch mylar..." The requirement is for one permanent (linen or plastic) map.



You must return the map before the claim can be processed. If you cannot have the map to the WRD within 60 days, please inform me as to when it can be expected. Please mark all correspondence with the file number.




