

The following history will explain the associated property use, hand-dug well, and attached chronology of owners as they all apply to the impoundment addressed in the Pre-1909 Water Rights Application No. $\underline{\text{SWR-222}}$, submitted by my mother, Winifred E. Runge.

The data was told to me by several old time residents of Oakland, who are all deceased. The time frames and how they tied to property ownership was not verified until recently. Until we went searching through past deeds, reading each as best as possible, we were uncertain as to acquisition of water rights by past owners. As near as I can tell, the water rights were never acquired.

As I was told by the old timers, the property once had a cemetery on it. They explained the access, road into the well and cemetery, and showed my dad (deceased) and I, the old holes of relocated graves. The road in, some holes, and benched rows of grave locations are still visible. They told us that the Oddfellows Cemetery was moved around 1890 or 1900, and we now know that the Umpqua Lodge #37 of I.O.O.F. bought the parcel in 1873 and sold it in 1893, and must have vacated cemetery about 1893. The location of cemetery is shown on attached plat from Douglas County records.

A similar story was explained to my dad & I by Earl McCain and an old neighbor named Hutchinson, both deceased. They told us that when the cemetery was beginning to be used, most of Oakland proper was located north and east of the present location and along Calapooya Creek; a location most residents know as Old Town. The people came to the cemetery in wagons and on horseback. At the time, somebody decided to dig a well near the cemetery, to water horses and for human consumption. The well is still there, and is about 4-foot diameter, about 14' deep, and rock lined. The well was spring fed and is in a draw slightly uphill and to one side of the low end of the cemetery location.

During the time of the cemetery use, visitors from Old Town got to bringing barrels in their wagons and taking water home with them, since the well had better water than the creek or the wells nearer their homes. Sometime during the period of use of the cemetery, drought hit the area and the small pond was constructed upstream from the well, apparently figuring the stored water would help the spring and maintain consistent water level in the well. I can confirm that the line of thought works since neither has ever dried up in the last 30 years. The pond also collects water from another spring that subs underground in early summer.

Once the cemetery land was sold and the remains moved to the new locations, the well was used for domestic and livestock for the following years. For at least the last 30 years, both well and pond have been used for livestock.

To further confirm the old timers story, they told us that the foundation blocks under the old house, a two-story set up like a boarding house, would be bases for headstones. The old timers also stated that an old single room house and the old barn were constructed on headstone blocks the same as the house, and the three buildings were built about 1890 or so. In 1975, the old two-story house was moved onto the neighbors property, and sure enough, square and rectangular cut stones were found as foundation blocks.

In 1988, I dismantled the old one-room house, which had been used as a small barn, chicken coupe, and general storage over its lifespan. When cleaning up the site of the old one-room house, I unearthed more square and rectangular stone blocks like those used as headstone bases. I didn't check the stones for any inscriptions or markings but doubt actual use of headstones as foundation blocks. The old barn is still standing, although in poor shape, but it appears that some stones were also used for foundation blocks.

Along about 1965, we tried to disk area of old cemetery, which was somewhat In the process, we turned up more square cut and rectangular cut stones just like those found under the two structures that are now gone. We hauled some off and some were still in the area when we finished.


With the knowledge of finding headstone blocks, seeing chronology of ownership and cemetery use, observing old road, abandoned grave holes, benches of land for grave sites, and the well with pond supplying water, I have no reason to doubt the history told to us by the old timers.

The drain system for the pond had a woodstave pipe, which was replaced with a corrugated metal pipe in mid-1960's and I personally rented a dozer and cut a spillway round the west abutment in the mid-to-late 1980's.

The water from the well and pond have been in use for domestic or livestock since construction. Both have been used for only livestock for the last 30

To the best of my knowledge, the above data and history fit what I was told over the years or actually observed.






