Dear Sir: In Re L.L. Porterfield et al Water Right.

I am inclosing herewith proof of appropriation of water in behalf of L.L. Porterfield and wife with check in sum of \$1.00 to cover recording fee.

You will note that the Porterfields have executed the proof containing a statement as to non waiver in regard to the number of acres actually irrigated. Mr. Porterfield is very insistant that there is still an error in the number of actual acres of ground irrigated and has submitted certain measurements in form of notes to me to show his claim. I have no way of ascertaining the accuracy of such information and can only pass along to you his claim. Thus, as to the land shown as unirrigated in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ of NE $\frac{1}{4}$, of Sec. 32, T.38, S.R. 11 $\frac{1}{2}$ E.W.M., Mr. Porterfield claims that there is only $\frac{3}{5}$ acres of such land, and that he will have water on it this year. Also the 23.8 acres as shown as not irrigated near the house, he says that there is actually 1 and $\frac{1}{4}$ acres of such and even that includes the lawn around his home.


