of Halfway, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of Main Pipe Creek, a tributary of Snake River

, for the purpose of the irrigation of 150 acres of land, and domestic use. under Enlargement Permit No. 69 of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon and duly confirmed by order of the STATE WATER BOARD of Oregon, made and entered

of record in the Record of Proceedings of said Board, at Salem, in Volume 1, at page 182, on the 7th day of April, 1915; that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from May 13, 1910; that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not

Your letter of the 26th inst. has been received. In reply permit me to say that the application for enlargement of the Carson irrigation ditch from Pine Creek, which was filed in this office on May 13, 1910, being application No. 682, has just been approved as enlargement permit No. 69. It will be recorded in a few days and returned to you. This application calls for the irrigation of 185 acres. The map shows certain lands colored green under this ditch which are already irrigated, and colored brown, which it is proposed to irrigate. Of these lands, which it is proposed to irrigate, Zimmerman apparently will irrigate 15 acres, Black 120 acres, and Martin 15 acres, Garrett 30 acres. There is five additional acres given in the application, which can not be located on the map. I presume in contributing to the expense for enlargement of this ditch, the four applicants will assist in proportion to the area of land owned, or for which water right is secured, and that each will then secure his proportion of water allowed under the permit as granted.

No permits have been granted for a greater amount of water than at the rate of one cubic foot per second for 80 acres, and accordingly your application has been limited to 2.32 cubic feet per second. You can compute the amount for each owner in the ditch by multiplying the number of acres which he proposes to irrigate by 1/80 of one cubic foot per second.

With respect to taking in another party, this can be done by filing another enlargement application, the same as you have already done. I therefore inclose herewith blank enlargement application in case you find it necessary to use the same, also copy of instructions and township plat. If you will mark on this township plat the number of acres which each additional person proposes to irrigate in each and every forty acre tract which he owns and refer him to the map on file in this office in connection with application 682, I believe we can save you the expense of having another survey and map prepared.

It will of course be necessary for Mrs. Groll to pay the \$3.00 examination fee, and the graduated irrigation and recording fee beginning with \$.15 per acre up to 100 acres.
