Water Right Application S-89845 in the name of GILLIAM FAMILY LIVING TRUST FINAL ORDER APPROVING THE USE OF STORED WATER

Summary: Order approving Application S-89845 and issuing Permit S-55545.

Authority

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. On September 27, 2024, Gilliam Family Living Trust submitted an application for a water-use permit pursuant to ORS 537.147:

- 2. The required examination fees were paid, and the minimum application requirements were met.
- 3. The Department has determined that the proposed use is an authorized use under the water right permit, certificate, or decree that allows the storage of water.

NOTICE OF RIGHT TO PETITION FOR RECONSIDERATION OR JUDICIAL REVIEW

This is an order in other than contested case. This order is subject to judicial review under ORS 536.075 and ORS 183.484. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.484(2). Pursuant to OAR 137-004-0080, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

- 4. On October 8, 2024, the Department provided public notice of the application in the Department's weekly public notice. A 30-day comment period followed.
- 5. The Department has not received public comments related to the possible issuance of the attached permit. Therefore, the Department has determined that no public interest issues as identified in ORS 537.170(8) have been raised.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

1. Application S-89845 is consistent with the requirements of ORS 537.147 and OAR Chapter 690.

<u>ORDER</u>

Application S-89845 is approved, and Permit S-55545 is issued as limited by the conditions contained therein.
