

EASEMENT AGREEMENT

RECITALS:

- A. Grantee is the owner of two parcels of real property described as Parcel No. 1 and Parcel No. 2 on Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference. The same shall hereinafter collectively be called "Gregg Parcels".

- C. Grantee has an easement over the "Coulson Parcel" which Grantor and Grantee desire to modify.
