Water use on the property involved in this report appears to have been quite consistent over the years. The canals and ditches Mr. Markley is using are essentially located in the same locations as originally installed by Jacob Mussell. These ditches are clearly shown on the 1897 GLO survey of the township. I have included with this data, copies of the field notes from this survey including a portion of the plat map prepared at the time.

The only significant change has been in the SE/SF quarter of Section 1, T23S, R46E. The fields were expanded and the ditch moved when leveling work was done.

Note that the diversion point is not the same as originally laid out by Jacob Mussel. The course of Succor Cr. changed during a flood in 1960. The attached photocopy of the SCS aerial photo of Sept. 2, 1954 shows the original diversion site. Also this photo also confirms utilization of the ground in a manner similar to its present use.

The structure at the original diversion is identified as a concrete wasteway on the attached map. Part of the original structure was washed out, and the diversion location was moved to its present site. Further channel changes occurred during the flood of 1984.

The diversion is not located on Mr. Markley's property, but is located on Tax Lot 701. This property is owned by the following individual:

The diversion dam is a low gravel dam across Succor Creek. It feeds an earth canal which reaches the Markley property after approximately $\frac{1}{4}$ mile. This ditch also feeds other parcels under other ownership further downstream.

The following measurements and calculations were made on the ditch at a point 200 ft. downstream of the concrete wasteway shown in Sec. 11, T23S, R46E.

Top Width: 11.3 ft.
Bottom Width: 6.6 ft.
Depth: 3.1 ft.
Grade: 0.0003 ft/ft.
Capacity: 37.0 cfs

The earth head ditches on the property are similar in size:

Top Width - 3 ft.
Bottom width - 1.5 ft.
Depth - 1 ft.

The concrete ditches on the property are of standard size:

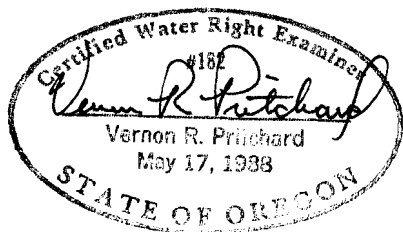
Top width - 3.3 ft.
Bottom width - 1.0 ft.
Depth - 1.2 ft.

There were two other major attempts to construct canals to expand irrigated acreage that cross the Markley property. These are the Schenck and Graff Canals. The Graff canal started construction in 1901. I found no information as to a start date of the Schenck canal. Neither canal was successful and are not in use today, and have not been used for many years. These canals are quite visible in aerial photographs of the area.
