In regards to your Pre-1909 Vested Water Right Claim, Mr. Don Knauer of the State of Oregon Water Resources Department says that the Map I prepared for you is not right, that I should have prepared a FINAL PROOF MAP AND A BENEFICIAL USE REPORT for you to submit along with your claim. On May 29, 1991, Mr. Knauer did send out a memo stating this, of which I placed it in my water right's file along with numerous other mailings from the Department and forgot about receiving his memo when you contacted me to prepare the map.

I was not asked to do a map for a Pre-1909 claim until late in 1992 and early in 1993. The instructions to you that we discussed was only that a map prepared by a CWRE must be submitted along with your claim of use. The instructions to you did not specify that a final proof map and beneficial use report was require. If it had, I would have known what was needed and would have advised you differently and would have prepared the final proof map and the beneficial use report, if you still thought that you had a claim.

To prepare a Final Proof Map, I will need to survey the area of actual use and make a tie to a government corner. To prepare the Beneficial Use Report, I will need to get data from the motor, pump, sprinklers, etc., so to prepare the report. In case of springs, we will have to survey the spring and the lines to the place of use for the map.

For the maps that I prepared from records, I will have to charge for the field survey and the data collected for the beneficial use report, but will prepare the new final proof map at no charge. For the maps that I did do a field survey for, I will only charge for the time spent in gathering the data for and preparing the Beneficial Use Report.

The above four sentenances are a form type letter for you and others. On December 29, 1992, the Water Resources Department received your application map and on September 21,, 1993, Mr. Knauer wrote me a letter that additional information was needed.

Please contact me about what is needed and what only I can show on the final proof map and beneficial use report, if you wish to proceed with your claim. Thank you.







CLAIM OF BENEFICIAL USE REPORT

SWR - 268

On October 5, 1995, I and my transitman met with Carol Ach and others on their property and made a field survey of the existing place of use. The property is on the Foley Springs County Road No. 459, some 5.0 miles Southeasterly of McKenzie Bridge, Oregon. Carol Ach's mailing address is 80232 Highway 99, Cottage Grove, OR 97424. Her phone number is 1-541-942-3638. I do not know how the present system compares to the pre-1909 system used.

The source of water at the Diversion Point for the domestic, irrigation and power uses is Avenue Creek which is a tributary of Horse Creek. The diversion point is the point in Avenue Creek where a 4 inch plastic pipe is set in place to divert water by a gravity system and is located in the Southwest one-quarter of the Northwest one-quarter (SW1/4 NW1/4) of Section 28, Township 16 South, Range 6 East of the Willamette Meridian, in Lane County, Oregon. The Point of Diversion was tied by a survey using a Total Station instrument to a 1939 Brass Cap monument marking the Northwest Corner of said Section 28, By calculations, the Point of Diversion computes to be 1905 feet South and 1140 feet East of the said Northwest corner of Section 28.

The gravity system main lines consist of 4 inch, 3 inch and 2 inch plastic pipes to a point just north of the Horse Creek Road. At this point the 2 inch plastic pipe connects to a 2 inch aluminum pipe which runs on to the irrigated area between the Horse Creek Road and Horse Creek. The areas of use lies within Sections 28 and Section 29 of the same Township and Range as described above.

At this time of the year, the irrigation system was not in use, but the main lines were in place and the 2 inch aluminum pipe with sprinklers were placed in a pile along both of the irrigated areas. The irrigation water is used for a small nursery area, a small garden area and two small fields.

The nursery area is some 0.04 acres in size within the Northwest one-quarter of the Northwest one-quarter (NW1/4 NW1/4) of Section 28 and contained pots with small trees and shrubs. The nursery area is some 102 feet in elevation below the Point of Diversion.

The small garden area is some 0.05 acres in size within the Northwest one-quarter of the Northwest one-quarter (NW1/4 NW1/4) of Section 28 which contained corn, beans, strawberries and other small vegetables. The garden area is some 123 feet in elevation below the Point of Diversion.


The small field south of the Horse Creek Road is some 0.50 acres in size within the Northeast one-quarter of the Northeast one-quarter (NE1/4 NE1/4) of Section 29. The irrigation system used in this field were 2 inch by 30 feet aluminum pipes with up to six Buckner Rainer 856 sprinklers with 1/8 inch diameter nozzle opening. Native grass was the crop irrigated. The point on the main line where the irrigation pipes were connected is some 138 feet in elevation below the Point of Diversion.

The small field north of the Horse Creek Road is some 0.30 acres in size within the Northeast one-quarter of the Northeast one-quarter (NE1/4 NE1/4) of Section 29. The irrigation system used in this field were 2 inch by 30 foot aluminum pipes with up to 6 Bucker Raider 856 sprinklers with 1/8 inch diameter nozzle opening. Native grass was the crop irrigated. The point on the main line where the irrigation pipes were connected is some 202 feet in elevation below the Point of Diversion.

The domestic use of the water is to supply water to the house. The house is within the Northwest one-quarter of the Northwest one-quarter (NW1/4 NW1/4) of Section 28. A 2 inch plastic pipe takes off of the 2 inch plastic pipe main line and runs to the southeast corner of the house. The ground at the southeast corner of the house is some 111 feet in elevation below the Point of Diversion.

The use of water for Power is to run a Pelton No. 12G Centrifical with water cups to drive a 12 volt Generator by a small V Belt and is within the Northwest one-quarter of the Northwest one-quarter of Section 28. The Pelton was designed and manufactured by the "Pelton Water Company Hydraulic Engineers", product 12G, Order 3418, date 11/13/50. This Pelton has a 2 inch intake and two 2 inch outlets which runs into a small pond and on into an existing drainage channel. This is presently providing electricity for the house. The ground elevation at the Pelton is some 123 feet in elevation below the Point of Diversion.

The Foley Hot Springs is the Point of Diversion for the pool and bathhouse and is located in the Southwest one-quarter of the Northwest one-quarter (SW1/4 NW1/4) of Section 28. By survey, this Point of Diversion computes to be 1385 feet South and 235 feet East of the said Northwest corner of Section 28. A portion of the Hot Spring water is piped downhill to the Bathhouse and pool which lies within the Northwest one-quarter of the Northwest one-quarter (NW1/4 NW1/4) of Section 28. The excess water runs off through an existing drainage channel and discharges into Horse Creek.



By my calculations, using only a 2 inch main line with no friction, 216 psi would be generated at the field of irrigation south of the Horse Creek Road (0.434 x 3.14 sq. in. x -138 ft. elev. = 216 psi) and 275 psi would be generated at the field of irrigation north of the Horse Creek Road (0.434 x 3.14 sq. in. x -202 ft. elev. = 275 psi). But the table for sprinkler capacity by nozzle size for an 1/8 inch diameter is rated for a maximum of 50 psi which equals 3.2 gpm each. By using this table, the 6 sprinklers would use 19.2 gpm at each field or a total of 38.4 gmp or 0.09 cfs if both systems were used at the same time.

The maximum domestic use for the house would be 0.023 cfs.

The use for the garden and nursery probably would be minimal.

The water used for power at the Pelton is returned through the channel and discharged back into Horse Creek.

The spring water is returned from the bathhouse and pool through the channel and discharged into Horse Creek.

The final proof survey and inspection of the use as found to be for SWR-268 was done by me on October 6, 1995 and the facts contained in this report and accompanying final proof map are correct to the best of my knowledge.



Thank you for your letter of October 19, 1994 inquiring about the status of your Surface Water Registration Statement. The Water Resources Department (WRD) received the form, fees and map you submitted on December 29, 1992. These were the required documents to assert your claim to a pre-1909 vested water right.

The map you submitted was prepared by Charles W. Guile, a water right examiner. The map does not meet Oregon Revised Statute and Oregon Administrative Rule requirements. I returned the map to Mr. Guile on September 21, 1993 for corrections and completion. As long as the problems with the map can be remedied before the actual Mckenzie River Adjudication begins, that will be acceptable. I do not know when the adjudication will begin. In the mean time, if a question of regulation comes up, it would be to your advantage to have your claim, to include the map, in proper order.

To answer your question, "... exactly what needs to be done to assure use of water on the property?", your claim (form, map and fees) must be in proper form to be presented to Circuit Court for a water right decree.

This will acknowledge your letter of December 14,1993. I have thought about how I can best address your distress over the problems with the maps you prepared to support pre-1909 vested water right claims. There has been some misunderstanding with regards to the pre-1909 map requirements in the past by both claimants and Certified Water Right Examiners (CWRE). When I took this project over, I made many efforts to provide the necessary information to the folks involved. I arranged and held public meetings, mailed notices and memos, had public notices published in local newspapers, among other things.

I took a look in my files and copied two of the memos I hope will help to show my attempt to inform you of the pre-1909 vested water right mapping requirements. I have always made myself available to the CWRE,s. I do not have a record, nor do I recall, you contacting me about the pre-1909 mapping requirements.

My notes show I sent copies of my checklist, the mapping requirements and the claim of beneficial use sheet while returning the maps for SWR-139, SWR-163 and SWR-268. I am sending you another copy.



On to the problem at hand. You must prepare a "final proof map and a beneficial use report" to satisfy the statutory and administrative requirements for the map to support a pre-1909 vested water right claim.

You have shown a bath house and pool on the map so I need an explaination about the water use and how it is covered in this pre-1909 vested water right claim.

A reminder that the map must be "..in ink or permanent-quality linen or 0.003-inch mylar..".

I am enclosing a copy of the checklist and claim to beneficial use report information used by the adjudication section. You may find it useful in preparing the required map and information. Many Certified Water Right Examiners have seen these and are using them.

You must return the map before the claim can be processed. If you cannot have the map to the WRD within 60 days, please inform me as to when it can be expected. Please mark all correspondence with the file number.
