CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

THIS CERTIFICATE ISSUED TO

KENNETH L. RILEY 739 LONE ROCK ROAD GLIDE, OREGON 97443

confirms the right to use the waters of NORTH UMPQUA RIVER, a tributary of UMPQUA RIVER, for the purpose of DOMESTIC USE FOR ONE FAMILY INCLUDING THE IRRIGATION OF LAWN AND NON-COMMERCIAL GARDEN NOT TO EXCEED 1/2 ACRE.

The right has been perfected under Permit 45160. The date of priority is JULY 25, 1980. The right is limited to not more than 0.01 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

NW 1/4 NW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DIC 41, SECTION 16, T 26 S, R 3 W, W.M.; 880 FEET SOUTH & 850 FEET EAST FROM NW CORNER SECTION 16.

The right shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

A description of the place of use under the right, and to which such right is appurtenant, is as follows:
