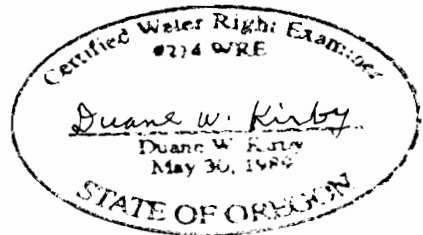

GENTLEMEN: RE: PRE-1909 VESTED WATER RIGHT, T.27 S., R. 6 W.,

AS REGARDS TO THE SAID REGISTRATION STATEMENT FOR THE ABOVE,
FROM MY OWN PERSONAL KNOWLEDGE I CAN MAKE THE FOLLOWING
REFLECTIONS:

PRIOR TO MY 8TH BIRTHDAY, AUG. 11, 1924, I ASSISTED MY
FATHER, HENRY ROSCOE CONN, TO HAUL WATER FOR IRRIGATION FROM
THE SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, TRIBUTARY TO UMPQUA RIVER WHICH
DISCHARGES INTO THE PACIFIC OCEAN. A WAGON WITH GRAVEL BED
CONTAINED 55 GAL. DRUMS WITH THE TOPS REMOVED. THE TWO HORSE
TEAM AND WAGON WERE DRIVEN INTO A SPOT IN THE RIVER WHERE THE
WATER JUST CAME UP TO THE FLOOR OF THE BED OF THE GRAVEL
WAGON, AND BUCKETS OF WATER FROM THE SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER WERE
USED TO FILL THE BARRELS. AFTER FILLING THE BARRELS WITH
WATER, BURLAP SACKS WERE STRETCHED OVER THE TOP OF THE
BARRELS AND AN IRON BARREL MIDDLE HOOP WAS SECURED OVER THE
TOP OF THE BURLAP SACKS. THIS TOP OF BARRELS COVER REDUCED
SPILLAGE OF WATER FROM THE BARRELS UPON PULLING THE WAGON TO
SHORE FROM THE RIVER AND HAULING TO A 40 ACRE PLANTING OF
CAULIFLOWER NEAR THE SOUTHERN PORTION OF THE PROPERTY IN THIS
APPLICATION AS REFERENCED ABOVE.

TWO ITEMS OF INTEREST AND AS INFORMATION, ONLY: 1. ON MY
FIRST HAULING OF WATER BY MYSELF, I DROVE THE HORSE TEAM AND
GRAVEL BED WAGON INTO A DEEPER HOLE IN THE SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER.
MY PURPOSE WAS TO MAKE SHORTER LIFTS OF BUCKETS OF WATER TO
FILL THE BARRELS. TO MY SURPRISE, ALL EMPTY BARRELS STARTED
TO FLOAT AND TURN OVER. I HAD TO WRESTLE THE BARRELS SO THEY
WOULD NOT FLOAT OUT OF THE GRAVEL WAGON BED OF APPROXIMATELY
12 INCH HEIGHT AND GO DOWN STREAM IN THE RIVER. FINALLY
HOLDING BARRELS TOGETHER, I PLACED ONE BARREL UPRIGHT AND
FILLED IT WITH ENOUGH WATER TO STAND AND SO ON UNTIL ALL
BARRELS WERE BACK IN ORDER. ON MY NEXT TRIP, I DROVE THE
HORSE TEAM AND WAGON TO THE SPOT MY FATHER HAD INDICATED.

2. THE CAULIFLOWER CROP WAS CONSIDERED THE MOST BOUNTIFUL AS
EVER GROWN IN THE UMPQUA VALLEY. MID DECEMBER, AN INSPECTION
OF THE WHOLE CAULIFLOWER FIELD WAS MADE AND A DECISION THAT
HARVESTING COULD START WITHIN ABOUT 10 DAYS. THAT NIGHT
REGISTERED THE COLDEST NIGHT KNOWN TO THIS AREA. BY MID DAY
THERE WASN'T A SINGLE HEAD OF CAULIFLOWER WITH LEAVES AS THEY
WERE ALL FROZEN AND DROOPED TO THE GROUND. NOT A SINGLE HEAD

OF CAULIFLOWER WAS EVER HARVESTED FROM THIS PLANTING. PRIOR TO THE SEVERE FREEZE, THE PLANTS WERE MORE THAN 4 1/2 FEET HIGH WITH BEAUTIFUL AND PERFECT HEADS OF CAULIFLOWER FORMING.

FOR A FEW YEARS, IRRIGATION CONTINUED AS DESCRIBED HEREIN UNTIL A TRACTOR WITH A PULLEY WAS USED TO RUN A PUMP FROM THE SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER TO AN IRRIGATION SYSTEM THAT COULD BE MOVED FROM FIELD TO FIELD. VARIOUS METHODS WERE ADOPTED UNTIL THE PRESENT ELABORATE SYSTEM OF OVERHEAD SPRINKLERS TO COVER THE WHOLE AREA IN THIS APPLICATION, AS REFERENCED HEREIN UNDER PERMIT #45253 AND WITH SUPPLEMENTAL AGREEMENT (COLLINS) DATED 7/89.

MY FATHER, HENRY ROSCOE CONN, WHO WAS BORN IN OREGON DECEMBER 31, 1888, INFORMED ME THAT THE CONN FAMILY IMMIGRATED TO OREGON IN 1853-1854. HE EXPLAINED TO ME THAT HIS UNCLE, NORCISSA CONN, WHO WAS BORN IN OREGON IN 1864 DID IRRIGATION AS DESCRIBED HEREIN, PLUS SOME DITCH DIVERSION AND OTHER USES, BACK TO AND BEFORE THE BEGINNING OF THE CENTURY. HE ALSO TOLD ME THAT HENRY CONN, MY GRANDFATHER, WHO WAS BORN IN 1842 IN INDIANA AND WAS THE SON OF HENRY CONN (SR.), MY GTREAT-GRANDFATHER, WHO DIED IN 1896 IN OREGON HAD ACQUIRED THE WM.MCKINNEY DONATION LAND CLAIM #50 ON 21 NOVEMBER, 1864.

THE SOUTHERLY SIDE OF THE SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER FROM NEAR "ROCKY POINT" TO THE SCOTT PROPERTY WHERE THE MELROSE SCHOOL IS LOCATED, EXCEPTING THE BUSENBARK RANCH, WAS OWNED BY THE CONN FAMILY DATING BACK TO THE EIGHTEEN HUNDREDS AND INCLUDED THE WM. MCKINNEY D.L.C.#50, PURCHASED BY HENRY CONN (SR). 21 NOVEMBER, 1864. ALL OF THIS PROPERTY WAS USED FOR CROPS WITH IRRIGATION, LIVESTOCK OF HORSES, CATTLE, SHEEP, HOGS AND TURKEYS. GENERALLY, WELLS WERE DUG FOR DOMESTIC USE. ANY PROPERTY WITHIN THE ABOVE AREA IS ENTITLED TO PRE 1909 WATER RIGHTS. THE FIRST BREAK-UP OF THIS TOTAL PROPERTY OF HENRY CONN (SR.) WENT TO SONS: HENRY CONN, MY GRANDFATHER; VIRGIL CONN; HARMON CONN; AND NORCISSA CONN. VARIOUS OTHER DIVISIONS HAVE SINCE BEEN MADE WITH MANY IN THE CONN FAMILY.

TO THE BEST OF MY KNOWLEDGE AND BELIEF THE FOREGOING IS A TRUE AND ACCURATE RESUME AND CERTIFIED HERETO, AND USES HAVE CONTINUED SINCE THE DATES LISTED IN THIS APPLICATION.

Right to use the waters of SOUTH UMPQUA RIVER, a
tributary of UMPQUA RIVER for the purpose of IRRIGATING 37.8 ACRES.

The right has been granted under Permit 45253. The date of
priority is JULY 11, 1989. The right is limited to not more than 0.47
CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured
at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

LOT 1 (NE 1/4 NE 1/4), SECTION 5, T 27 S, R 6 W, W.M.; 600
FEET WEST FROM NE CORNER SECTION 5

The amount of water used for irrigation together with the amount
used under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be
limited to ONE-EIGHTIETH of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its
equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a
rotation of not to exceed 2.5 acre-feet per acre for each acre
irrigated during the irrigation season of each year.
