BACKGROUND

An application to appropriate ground water was submitted in January 1993. The application requested the use of 443 gpm to be applied on 78.82 acres. A conflict involving Certificate of Registration GR-3397 submitted by Ben Kyllo in 1959 was resolved. A permit, G-11778 was issued July 25, 1994 approving application G-13279.

INTRODUCTION

This survey authorized by Rudolph H. Etzel was conducted in the presence of his son<
Nat Etzel on June 17, 1996. The land is under the ownership of Rudolph H. Etzel and Marie
Etzel. The site address is 10510 South Macksburg Road, Canby, Oregon 97013. The site phone
is 266-9190. The elderly Mr. Rudolph Etzel lives on site and is cared for daily by his son, Nat.
The residence phone for Nat Etzel is 266-1443 should it be necessary to acquire additional
information.

SOURCE

CLAC 18476

The source is ground water pumped from a drilled well completed April 6, 1993 by W.W.C. Robert Kern No. 1277. The well drilled to a depth of 315 feet is cased to 295 feet with a 10 inch 0.25 gauge steel pipe and cement sealed to 20 feet below the ground surface. The casing is perforated from elevation 290 to 315 a length of 25 feet.

The static water level was reported at 52 feet below the surface on 4-6-93. The well log reports a yield of 300 gpm for a test period of 40 hours. This water is produced from a zone 290 to 315 feet below ground surface. No drawdown was reported on the well test. The well head has a 3/4 inch capped access vent.

PUMPING UNIT

The pumping unit furnished by Fishers Supply of Canby was reported to be a modified 8 stage Red Jacket pump driven by a 40 horsepower submersible induction motor.

The impellers were trimmed and a pump test dated March 19, 1994 was performed by

Fisher Supply.

The test date sheet shows a static water elevation at 58 feet below the surface at the time of pump start up. The pump test was for a period of 4 hours discharging 400 gpm at a total drawdown of 97 feet (elev. 155 below ground surface).

ELECTRICAL DISTRIBUTION

The pump control panel is a Type 3R General electric CR 340E214F marked 50 horsepower, 3 phase, 60 cycle.

DISTRIBUTION/HEADER SYSTEM

The 40 horsepower submersible pumping unit discharges through a 4 inch galvanized pipe controlled by a 4" surface gate valve. The discharge may also be controlled by a manual regulator. Prior to being buried a 4x4x 3 inch plugged tee is provided for surface lateral connection. Immediately below surface a 6 inch tee provides extension for the buried main to extend to the North. This main is controlled by a 6 inch gate valve 12 feet West of the well casing. The 6 inch main to the North extends 400 feet to the Macksburg Road. The main continues under the road right-of-way a distance of 50 feet to a surface hydrant located 140 feet West of the East property line. This hydrant serves the continuation of a 6 inch surface aluminum main that extends East 140 feet to the East property line and then continues North to a point 30 feet South of the North property line a distance of approximately 760 feet.

The 6 inch main to the South is buried PVC and extends 474 feet to a 6 inch tee that serves a surface 6 inch aluminum main East and West. The surface main has hydrants spaced at 30 feet center to center. Each hydrant serves aluminum 3 inch laterals with 3/4 inch galvanized risers equipped with Rainbird sprinklers Model 30H with 9/64 inch orifice at 40 foot center to center.

The buried PVC 6 inch main continues South 520 feet to a 3 inch hydrant located on the North bank of Dove Creek. The 6 inch PVC main continues under Dove Creek and extends South 445 feet to a hydrant. The buried 6" PVC main then continues East a distance of 210 feet where it comes to the surface. Aluminum 6 inch surface main extends South 900 feet. The 6 inch surface mains and 3 inch laterals with 3/4 inch sprinkler risers are available to serve the area South of Dove Creek.

The risers are variable height ranging from 18 inches to 4 feet. Manufacturer discharge tables show a rate of 3.4 gpm for 9/64 inch nozzles at 35 psi serving a 40 foot radius.

The number of sprinklers operating at each setting is dependent on the type of crop being

irrigated and location. The maximum discharge of the pumping and supply system based on a drawdown at WSL of 155 feet below surface and a discharge pressure of 60 psi (TDH 300 ft) would result in a discharge of 375 gpm. (Taken from manufacturer performance curves).

This calculates to approximately 110 sprinklers.

USE

The primary 1995 crop was sugar beet seed and white radish. Crop rotation for continued production of these products require return of nutrients to the soil. Tall fescue is the present cover crop. An area of volunteer red clover was also found harvested.

Water use varies dependent on the yearly planting.

The use area as shown on the application map for the SW 1/4, NE 1/4 of Section 23 T.4S., R.1E. Has the same total area but a slightly different location. The triangle area between Dove Creek and tributary is not in production. An equivalent area South of Dove Creek has been put into production.

LIFT

USGS Quad Map represent the elevation at the well to be approximately 235 feet. The elevation at Dove Creek approximately 1000 feet North of the well represents the lowest site elevation at 200 feet. This represents an average grade of 3.5%. The maximum change in pressure is a positive 15 psi.

The elevation of the site South boundary is at elevation 230 feet and is 1800 feet South of Dove Creek. This represents a grade of 1.7%.

The elevation at the site North boundary is at elevation 240 feet. The difference in elevation from the well site is negligible (5 ft or 2 psi). The increase in discharge at the nozzle on the 3.5% slope mainline would be approximately 0.08 gpm per 100 feet and a maximum of 0.8 gpm at the low elevation of 200 feet.

The well location was measured by instrument and found to be 1235 feet South and 215 West of the North one-quarter corner of Section 23, T.4S., R.1E., W.M.



This permit is issued approving Application G-13279. The date of priority is FEBRUARY 5, 1993. The use is limited to not more than 0.99 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the well.

The well is located as follows:

The well shall be constructed in accordance with the General Standards for the Construction and Maintenance of Water Wells in Oregon. The works shall be equipped with a usable access port, and may also include an air line and pressure gauge adequate to determine water level elevation in the well at all times.

Measurement, recording and reporting conditions:

- A. Before water use may begin under this permit, the permittee shall install a meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director. The permittee shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order.
- B. The permittee shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

C. The Director may require the permittee to keep and maintain a record of the amount (volume) of water used and may require the permittee to report water use on a periodic schedule as established by the Director. In addition, the Director may require the permittee to report general water use information, the periods of water use and the place and nature of use of water under the permit. The Director may provide an opportunity for the permittee to submit alternative reporting procedures for review and approval.

If substantial interference with a senior water right occurs due to withdrawal of water from any well listed on this permit, then use of water from the well(s) shall be discontinued or reduced and/or the schedule of withdrawal shall be regulated until or unless the Department approves or implements an alternative administrative action to mitigate the interference. The Department encourages junior and senior appropriators to jointly develop plans to mitigate interferences.

This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.

Prior to receiving a certificate of water right, the permit holder shall submit the results of a pump test meeting the department's standards, to the Water Resources Department. The Director may require water level or pump test results every ten years thereafter.

Actual construction work shall begin on or before July 25, 1995 and shall be completed on or before October 1, 1996. Complete application of water shall be made on or before October 1, 1997.

Failure to comply with any of the provisions of this permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, civil penalties, or cancellation of the permit.

This permit is for beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.

By law, the land use associated with this water use must be in compliance with statewide land-use goals and any local acknowledged land-use plan.

The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.

The Director of the Water Resources Department has found that the proposed use of water described by this permit, as conditioned, will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest.

TECHNICAL REVIEW

If satisfactory-

Water use Application # 6-13279 received a Satisfactory Report of Technical Review.

The Technical Review revealed that the proposed water use:

- a)-is not prohibited by statute or scenic waterway criteria;

This letter informs you of the current status of your application for a water use permit and accompanies the <u>Satisfactory Report of Technical Review For Water Use Permit(s)</u>. We apologize for the delay in transmitting this information and Report to you and for any inconvenience the wait may have caused you.

The enclosed Report of Technical Review is the Department's summary of a specialized analysis of various legal and scientific aspects of your application and proposed water use. We are required by the state of Oregon's administrative rules (in OAR 690-11-160) to conduct this official technical review of each application submitted to the Oregon Water Resources Department for a water use permit. This process was designed to insure that your application receives a fair evaluation and to secure protection of existing water rights and of the public at large.

AS THE RESULT OF OUR TECHNICAL EVALUATION OF YOUR APPLICATION, WE HAVE DETERMINED THAT YOUR APPLICATION SATISFIES THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE TECHNICAL REVIEW.

The Department will now move your application to the next phase of processing. This phase includes a public interest review of your proposed water use. No final action may be taken on your application until the public interest review is completed.

You should also note that the Report of Technical Review describes conditions currently anticipated which may limit the water use proposed in your application.

If you wish to object to any of the analyses contained in the Report, you must submit your objection to the Department in writing within 60 days of the date of mailing of this Report or by the date specified below. Your objection must allege that the technical review is defective and you may also submit evidence which demonstrates that your proposed water use will not impair or be detrimental to the public interest.

Copies of the Report of Technical Review will be distributed to all persons who have filed comments or otherwise expressed an interest in the water use proposed in your application. Interested parties must also submit their objections within the prescribed objection period.  - A. Before water use may begin under this permit, the permittee shall install a meter or other suitable measuring device as approved by the Director. The permittee shall maintain the meter or measuring device in good working order.
 - B. The permittee shall allow the watermaster access to the meter or measuring device; provided however, where the meter or measuring device is located within a private structure, the watermaster shall request access upon reasonable notice.

- C. The Director may require the permittee to keep and maintain a record of the amount (volume) of water used and may require the permittee to report water use on a periodic schedule as established by the Director. In addition, the Director may require the permittee to report general water use information, the periods of water use and the place and nature of use of water under the permit. The Director may provide an opportunity for the permittee to submit alternative reporting procedures for review and approval.
- 8. Prior to receiving a certificate of water right, the permit holder shall submit the results of a pump test meeting the department's standards, to the Water Resources Department. The Director may require water level or pump test results every ten years thereafter.
- This right is limited to any deficiency in the available supply of any prior right existing for the same land.
- 10. Failure to comply with any of the provisions of the permit may result in action including, but not limited to, restrictions on the use, penalties, or cancellation of the permit.
- 11. The permit is for the beneficial use of water without waste. The water user is advised that new regulations may require the use of best practical technologies or conservation practices to achieve this end.
- 12. The use shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.
- 13. The use of water shall be limited when it interferes with any prior surface or ground water rights.
- 14. If substantial interference with a senior water right occurs due to withdrawal of water from any well listed on this permit, then use of water from the well(s) shall be discontinued or reduced and/or the schedule of withdrawal shall be regulated until or unless the Department approves or implements an alternative administrative action to mitigate the interference.
