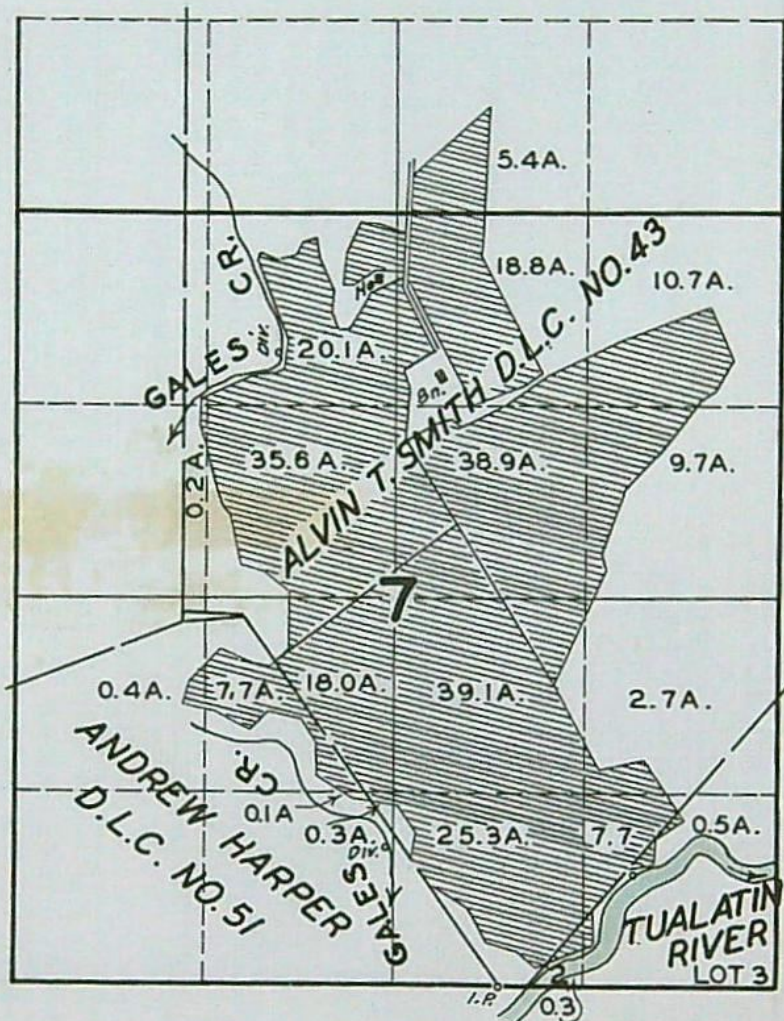

# Certificate of Water Right Ownership Update

## NOTICE TO SELLERS & BUYERS:

By law, all water belongs to the public (ORS 537.110). In almost every instance, a permit or water right certificate from the Water Resources Department is needed before using, diverting or storing water (ORS 537.130). confirms the right to use the waters of GALES CREEK AND THE TUALATIN RIVER, a tributary of WILLAMETTE RIVER, for the purpose of IRRIGATING 200.0 ACRES.

The right has been perfected under Permit 14836. The date of priority is APRIL 10, 1941. The right is limited to not more than 1.50 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND, BEING 0.25 CUBIC FOOT PER SECOND FROM TUALATIN RIVER, AND 1.25 CUBIC FEET PER SECOND FROM GALES CREEK, or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the source.

The point of diversion is located as follows:

GALES CREEK - NE 1/4 NW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN DLC 43, SE 1/4 SW 1/4, AS PROJECTED WITHIN HARPER DLC 51, TUALATIN RIVER - LOT 3 (SE 1/4 SE 1/4), SECTION 7, T 1 S, R 3 W, W.M.

On April 6, 1977, an application was filed in the office of the Water Resources Director by Glen W. Zurcher for a change in place of use under an existing water right of record, pursuant to the provisions of ORS 540.510 to 540.530.

The certificate recorded at Page 17149, Volume 14, State Record of Water Right certificates, in the name of Glen W. Zurcher, describes a right which includes the use of not to exceed 0.25 cubic foot per second from the Tualatin River and the use of not to exceed 1.25 cubic foot per second from Gales Creek for irrigation of, among other lands, a certain 20.2 acres in SW $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$ , 1.7 acres in NE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$ , 2.7 acres in NW $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  and 1.6 acres in SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 7, Township 1 South, Range 3 West, W.M., with a date of priority of April 10, 1941.

The point of diversion from the Tualatin River is located 750 feet North and 1675 feet East from the South quarter-corner of Section 7, being within the SE $\frac{1}{4}$  SE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 7, Township 1 South, Range 3 West, W.M.



It would be impossible with the present personnel to make an examination of the work performed by the following applicants, together with that of all other applicants for extensions of time, and funds are not available for employing additional engineers to make such examinations,

It is urgent that a decision be made upon these applications within a reasonable time in order that the applicants may proceed with the work required in order to apply the waters to be appropriated under the permits to beneficial use,

The State Engineer in this instance is therefore compelled to judge the matter of diligence entirely on the statements contained in the respective applications for extension without an examination of the work performed,

The statements contained in the applications for extension filed by the following, when considered in connection with the present national emergency and the resulting acute shortage of the labor and materials necessary to the completion of the projects represented, indicate that each has shown such reasonable diligence as entitles him to an extension of time, and

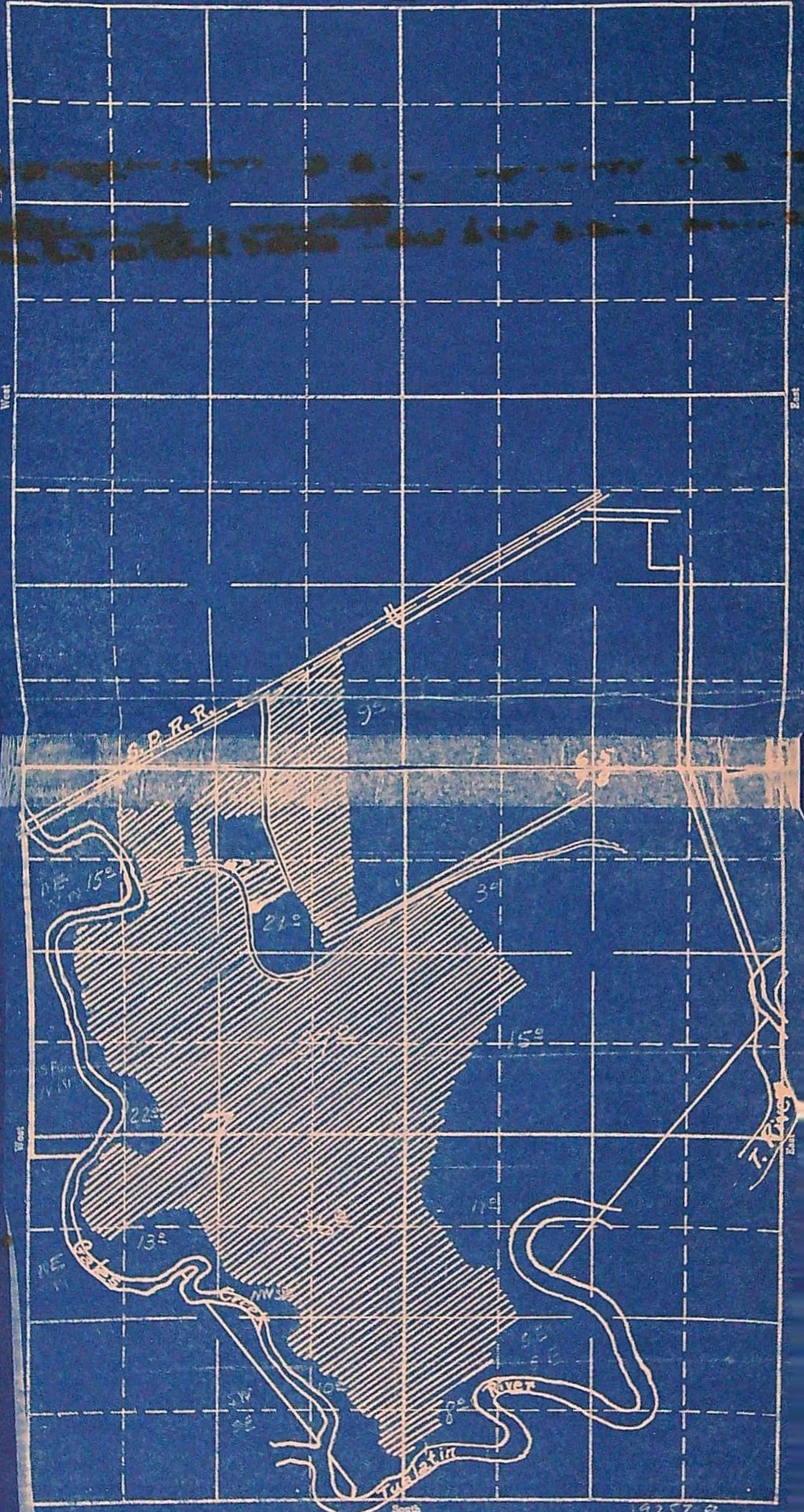

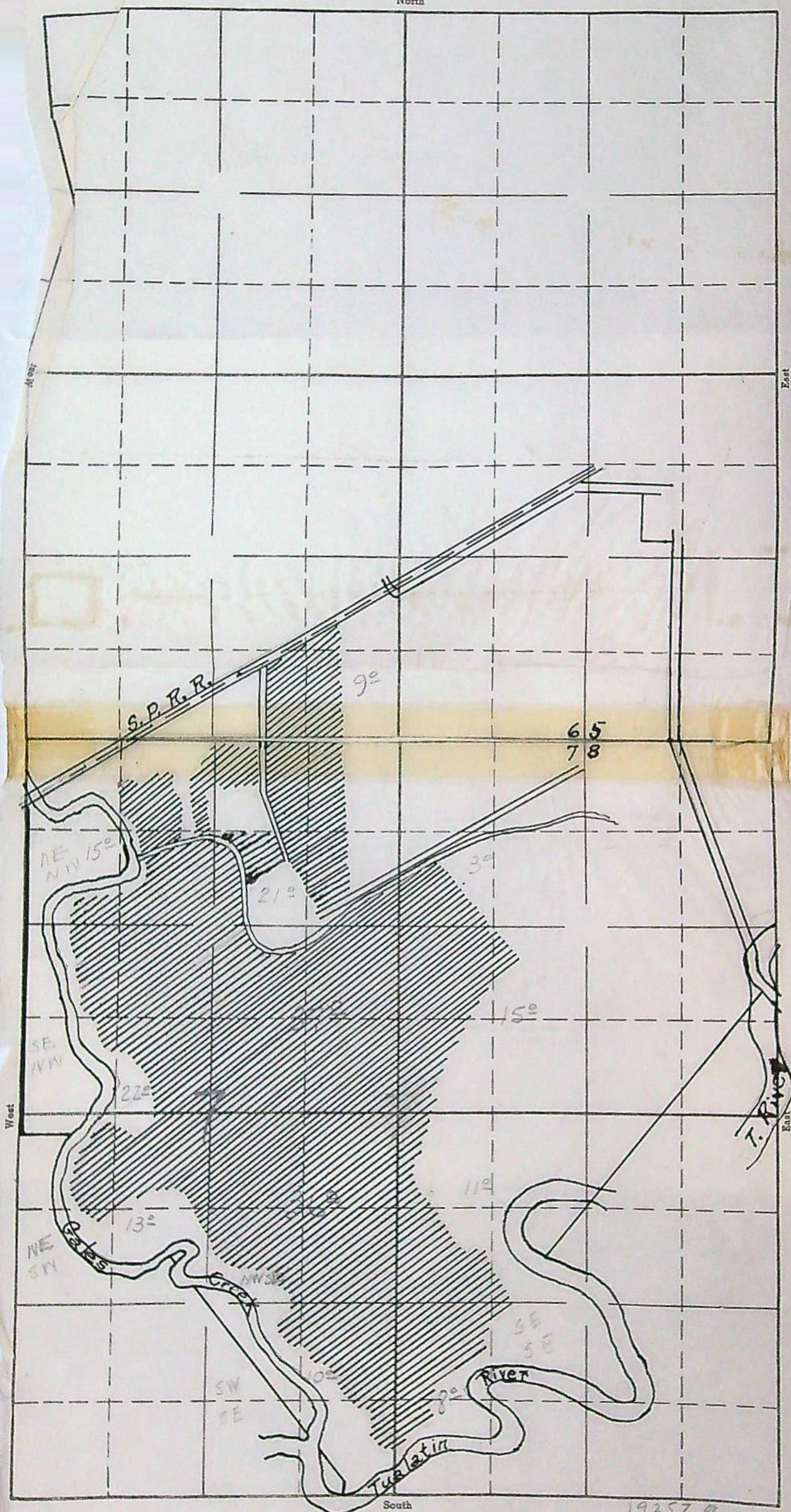
