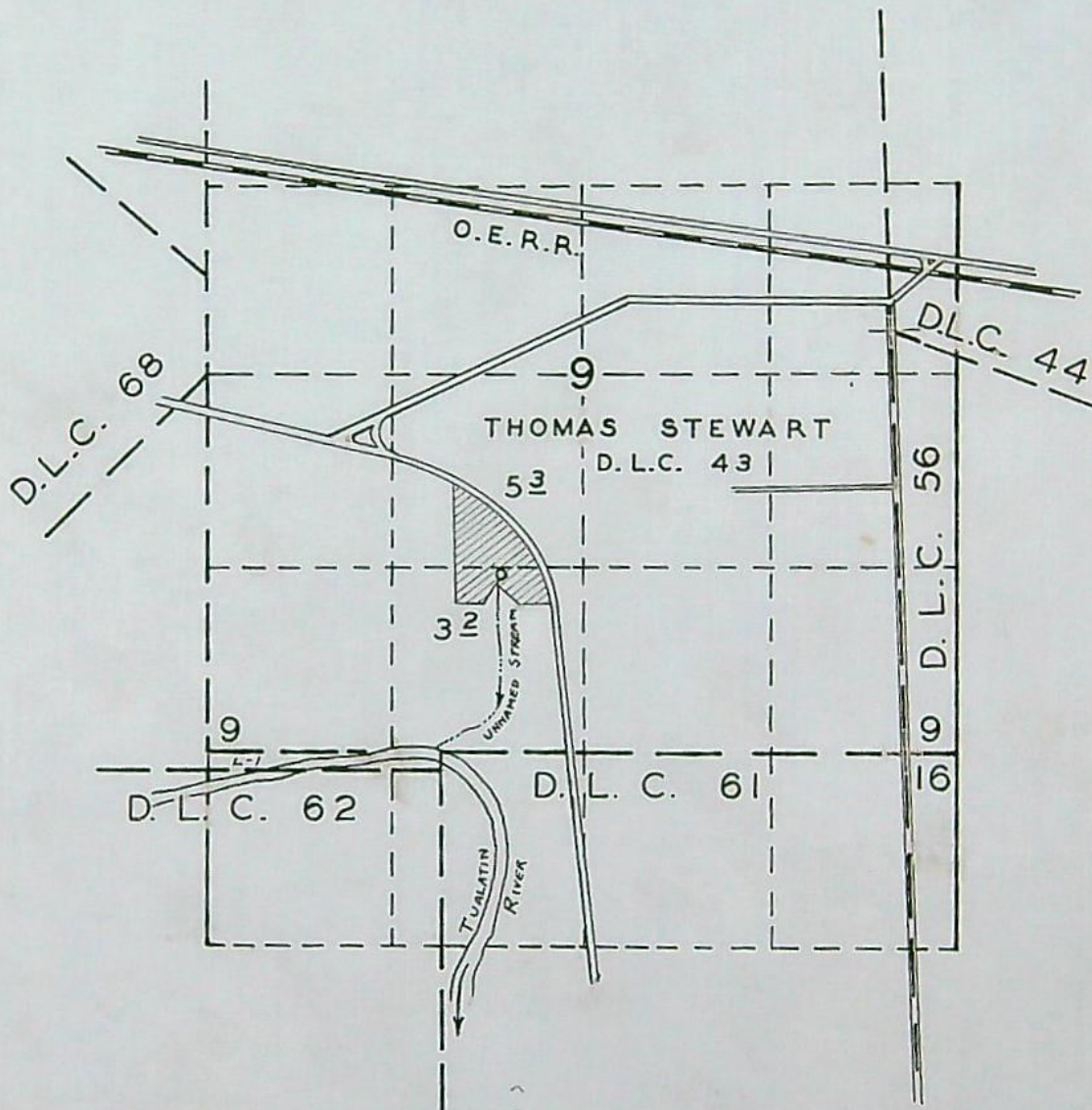

This Is to Certify, That COLAT R. MERRILL

of St. 2, Box 271, Hillsboro, State of Oregon, has made proof to the satisfaction of the STATE ENGINEER of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of an unnamed stream, a tributary of Tualatin River for the purpose of irrigation

Gentlemen:

After discussing with you gentlemen in this office today, the controversy over the use of water of a small unnamed creek by Herman R. Hornecker and Helen Hornecker under Permits Nos. R-950 and 18494, and by Odlat R. Merrill under Permit No. 22406, I offer the following suggestions.

The parties to this controversy may wish to enter into a stipulation which would be filed with the State Engineer providing:

- (1) That the time limits for completion of construction and complete application of water under Permit No. 18494 shall be extended until October 1, 1956 with a proviso in the extending order that the right to be ultimately confirmed under this permit shall be subject to any rights which are ultimately confirmed under Permit No. 22406,
- (2) That the rights ultimately to be confirmed under Permit No. 22406 shall be fixed in the stipulation so as to limit them to certain days and hours which may be agreed upon by the parties,
- (3) That no further extension of time after October 1, 1956 shall be granted by the State Engineer to the holders of Permit No. 18494,
- (4) That the order of the State Engineer with regard to Permits Nos. R-950 and 18464 in the name of Herman R. and Helen Hornecker, said order being dated 5th August 1954, shall be vacated, and
- (5) That the appeal from said order of the State Engineer described in the preceding paragraph shall be withdrawn.

Gentlemen:

This will acknowledge receipt of your letter of July 5 transmitting signed copies of a proposed stipulation between Herman R. and Helen Hornecker and O. R. Merrill.

With reference to your letter, the State Engineer could not issue certificates as set out in the stipulation for the following reasons.

In accordance with the provisions of ORS 537.250 and 537.260 and the interpretation that has been applied to these sections by the courts, the State Engineer may issue a certificate of water right confirming the right acquired under a permit only to the extent that the water has been applied to beneficial use in accordance with the terms of the permit.

With reference to the Hornecker permits, the time for complete application of water to beneficial use under the permits expired October 1, 1953. From examination of the grounds and hearing held it was determined by the State Engineer that Mr. Hornecker had not applied any of the waters of the unnamed stream or reservoir to beneficial use for domestic or irrigation purposes.

The portion of the order as quoted in the first part of the stipulation defines the extent to which the State Engineer found the right had been completed and for which a certificate could be issued under the law.

With reference to Permit No. 22406 in the name of O. R. Merrill, it is the policy of the State Engineer to make an examination of the ground for the purpose of determining the extent to which a right has been completed. Mr. Merrill has

reported that he has applied the water to beneficial use but we have not as yet been able to make a survey of the lands. It is planned that this survey will be made later this summer, after which final proof may be made and certificate issued thereunder to the extent that beneficial use has been made.

If Mr. Hornecker wishes to file a new application for uses which he now desires to make of the unnamed stream, the application would be accepted and, from present knowledge, approved by issuance of a new permit. A stipulation could be entered into whereby Mr. Merrill would waive the priority of his right, as suggested in your present stipulation, to Mr. Hornecker's new application. The stipulation of the waiver of priority insofar as it is applicable and does not injure innocent third parties could be followed by the watermaster in his distribution of water.

As promised in our telephone conversation, I have examined the records of this office and it appears that W. E. Francis of Portland, Oregon, filed an application on February 13, 1926 for a permit to appropriate 0.1 second foot of water from an unnamed stream, tributary of Tualatin River, for the irrigation of 8.93 acres. This application was approved and permit issued on March 10, 1926. It further appears that Mr. Francis failed to comply with Oregon laws and the rules and regulations of this office in the matter of perfecting this right and on May 27, 1932 this permit was canceled. This filing, therefore, is of no further effect.

Please be advised that if the tract of land which you own and desire to irrigate is platted and recorded in the county records, three copies of this map, as recorded, will be sufficient for the records of this office. You can crosshatch the lots or tracts of land you desire to irrigate and tie the point of diversion to one of the tract corners. 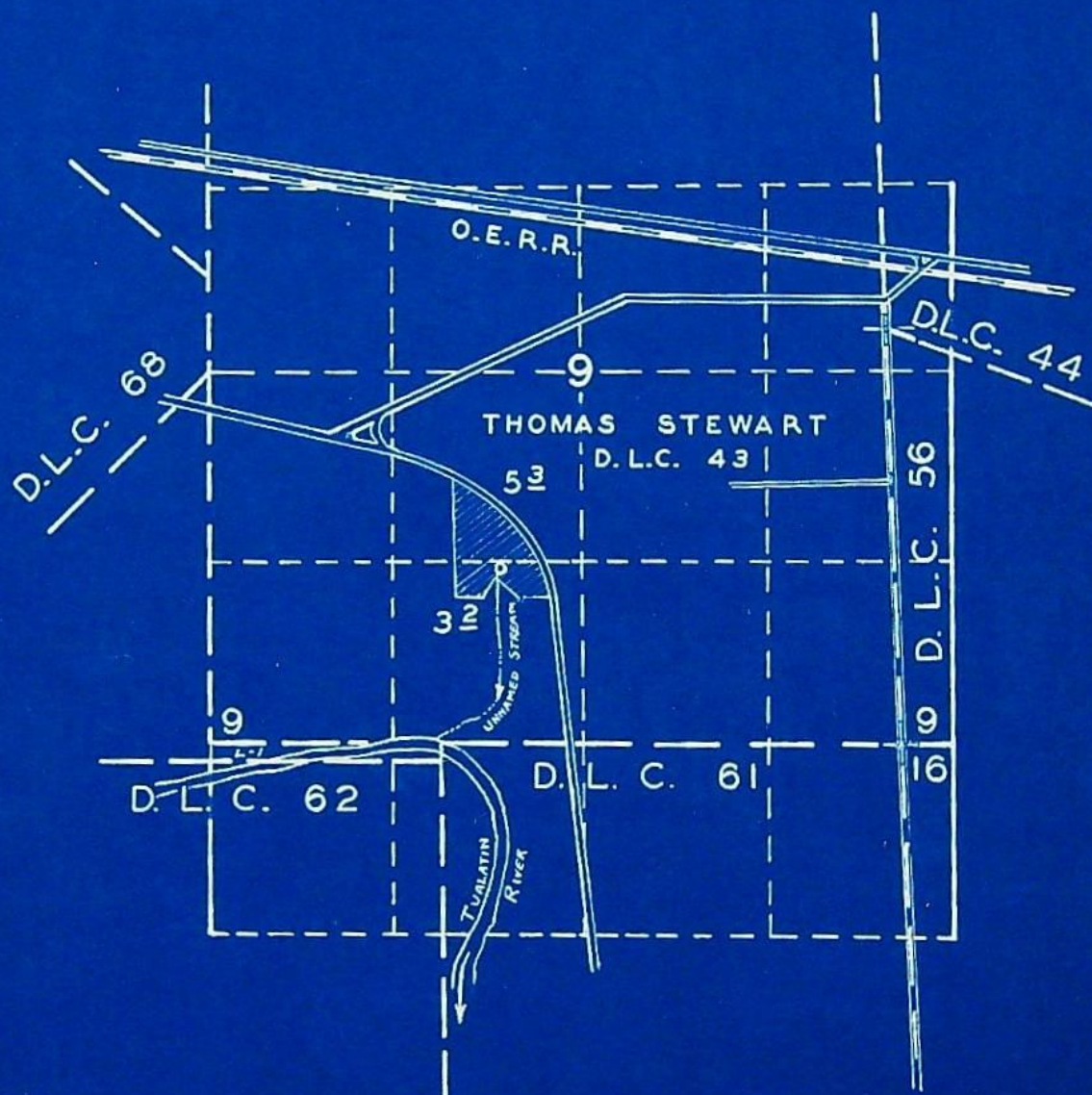
