South Fork of West Fork of Bear Creek (Arises Section 8; into W Bear at Section 32) - 20 gallons/minute

Cabin Spring (Section 20) - 3-1/2 gallons/minute

Coal Springs (Section 20) - 2-1/2 gallons/minute

Orchard Springs (Section 20) - 3 gallons/minute

2600 Spring (Section 17) - 2 gallons/minute

Total gallons/minute to West Bear Creek Draining, tributaries 31 gallons/minutes or 7% of one cubic foot per second (cfs)

Above water measurements were made by Bob and Gail Gray on October 15, 1991 using one gallon jug and a stop watch.

### Lost Prairie: T 6 N, R 44 E and T 6 N, R 43 E

Dear Water Resources Department:

I, Samuel Doke Cole, was born at Lost Prairie on December 11, 1909.

My father, James Cole, homesteaded at Lost Prairie on Section 31, NE quarter, in the early 1890's. My grandfather, Samuel Doke Cole, homesteaded on Section 30, SE quarter, in 1888. My father's and grandfather's homesteads were adjacent to each other.

James Madison Fordice homesteaded at Lost Prairie in 1887 (south of and adjacent to my father's place) at Sections 31, 32 and 29 (T 6 N. R 44 E) and Section 5 (T 5 N. R 44 E). James's son W. B. (Willard) Fordice married my aunt Hattie in 1893. W. B. built a good two story house about 1900. In Sections 31 and 32 are very strong springs that not only provided house water but water for the Fordice livestock, year round. Water for the two story house comes from (and still does) a draw directly east of the house. Water collects in a cement spring box, then travels downhill through pipes to the original house site, and three livestock water troughs. A newer house was built in 1957, using the original water supply system. Southwest of the house water draw is another year round strong spring that provides livestock water at springs, ponds, ditches and throughs. This water travels downhill from Section 31 to a lower Section 31 (at the former James Huston Fordice place), fills several livestock ponds, ditches, and canyons. Some of the water - depending on the seasontravels to the Grande Ronde River at Section 25 and 26.

W. B. Fordice's brother, James Huston Fordice, homesteaded at Lost Prairie in Section 31 and part of Section 36 in about 1905. (West of and adjacent to W. B.'s place). James built his house in 1905. Just south of James's house several springs arise, providing water for livestock ponds and a good well that supplies the house water. Some of the water - depending on the season travels downhill through Section 31 to the Grande Ronde River at Section 25 and 26.

William Locke homesteaded at Section 25 in 1888 (T 6 N, R 43 E). He built a two story house at his place in about 1889. Mr. Locke got his water for his house and his livestock from a spring NW of his house, and from a strong year round creek that arises in Section 30, my grandfather's place (now Roberts).

Water has been used continuously for household and livestock since the homesteads were established in 1887, 1888 and 1905.

This will acknowledge your letter of March 15, 1993 requesting an "extension of a site inspection and review of these registrations".
