Ryan,

I pulled the file to see what information it contained regarding notification to the Department that the permit development had been completed. I was able to locate a "Form C" that the permit holders submitted in October of 1991. For your reference, I have attached copies of both the notice and the letter the Department sent confirming that the notice had been received.

As we discussed, due to the priority date of the permit, you have the option of waiting for the Department to survey the extent of the use or hiring a Certified Water Right Examiner:

537.799 Survey for issuance of water right certificate. Any person who has applied for or received a permit or a transfer to appropriate water under ORS 537.211, 537.625 or 540.530 on or before July 9, 1987, shall notify the Water Resources Department that the work has been completed and either:

- (1) Hire a water right examiner certified under ORS 537.798 to conduct a survey, the original to be submitted as required by the Water Resources Department, for issuance of a water right certificate; or
- (2) Continue to appropriate water under the water right permit or transfer issued under ORS 537.211, 537.625 or 540.530 until the Water Resources Department conducts a survey and the commission issues a water right certificate under ORS 537.250 or 537.625. [1987 c.542 §3]

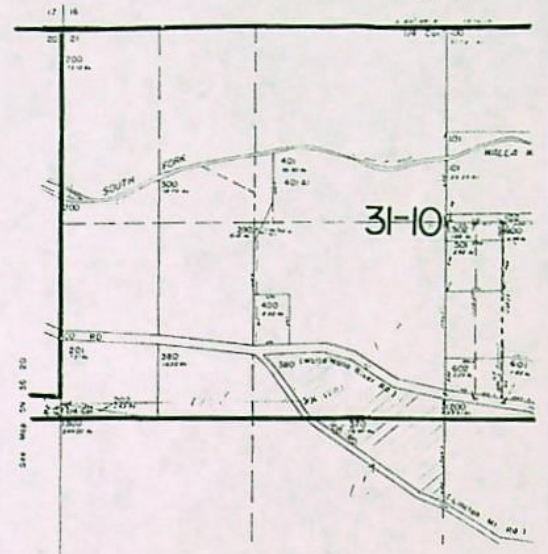

Your permit has been recorded in this office, but you should hold the original permit as evidence of your water right. If the land is sold, an assignment to the new owner must be recorded in this office. Assignment blanks will be furnished upon request.

The permit fixes time limits for beginning of construction, completion of construction and complete application of water to beneficial use. The law requires that you begin actual construction within one year from the date of issuance of the permit or your right will be lost. The Water Resources Director is authorized to extend the time for completion of construction and for complete application of water upon proper showing, but has no authority to extend the time limit for beginning of construction.

Forms A, B and C may be attached for submitting (A) Notice of Beginning of Construction, (B) Notice of Completion of Construction and (C) Notice of Complete Application of Water. If your application has stated that construction has already been started, or that construction work is completed, or that complete application of water has been made, only the required forms will be attached.

The certificate will limit the right to the extent that water has been applied to beneficial use in accordance with the terms of the permit.

Your Application G-11671 describing the proposed use of 0.17 cubic foot of water per second from one well for the irrigation of 13.9 acres, together with the print of a portion of a map and a copy of the water well report, has been reviewed.

Before your application can be considered for approval, it will be necessary for you to make a certain amendment to the application, submit a map or maps meeting our requirements, and submit a legal description of the property upon which the water will be used.

The legal description is needed to verify the place of use of water and may be copied from your deed, title insurance policy, or sales contract.

We will also need a statement relative to the ownership of the properties involved in the development. If any portion of the proposed development will occur on property not wholly under your ownership, you will need to supply the names and mailing addresses of the legal owners of the property. This information may be supplied in the remarks section of the application or on a separate sheet.

The well needs to be located in the first part of Item 2 by a distance north or south and a distance east or west from a public land survey corner. However, if you wish, you may use one distance and one bearing from a reference corner. The northwest and southeast directions presently noted do not meet our requirements. You may also wish to review the identity of the reference corner and the location of the well by quarter-quarter section. According to the map submitted, it appears that the reference corner should have been identified as the southwest corner of the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of the section and that the well would be located within the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of the section. Whichever is in error will need to be corrected.

Prints of a portion of a map, as submitted, do not meet our requirements. If you wish to use prints of the tax assessor's map, it will be necessary for you to submit four complete prints of the entire tax assessor's map, each further completed to properly show your proposed development. Additional requirements for the supporting map are briefly explained on pages three and four of the enclosed booklet relative to ground water applications.

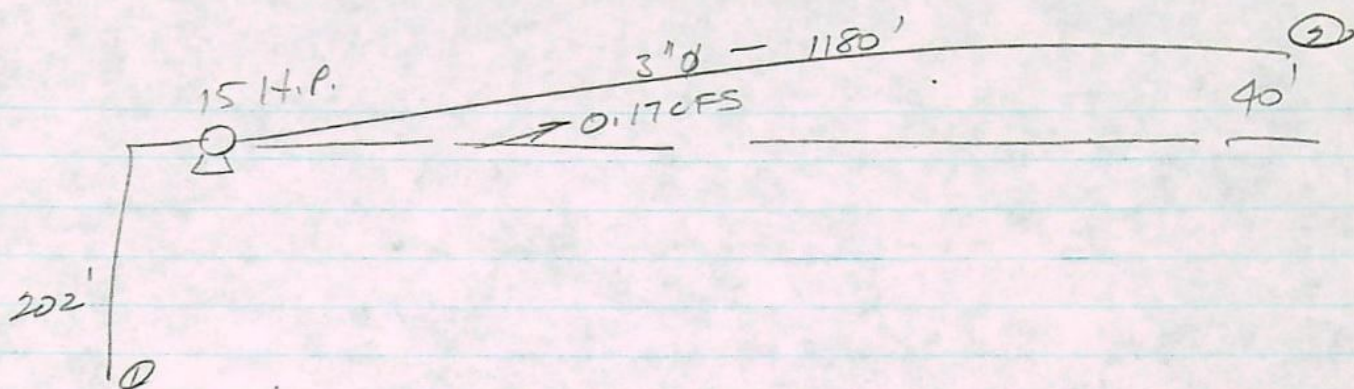

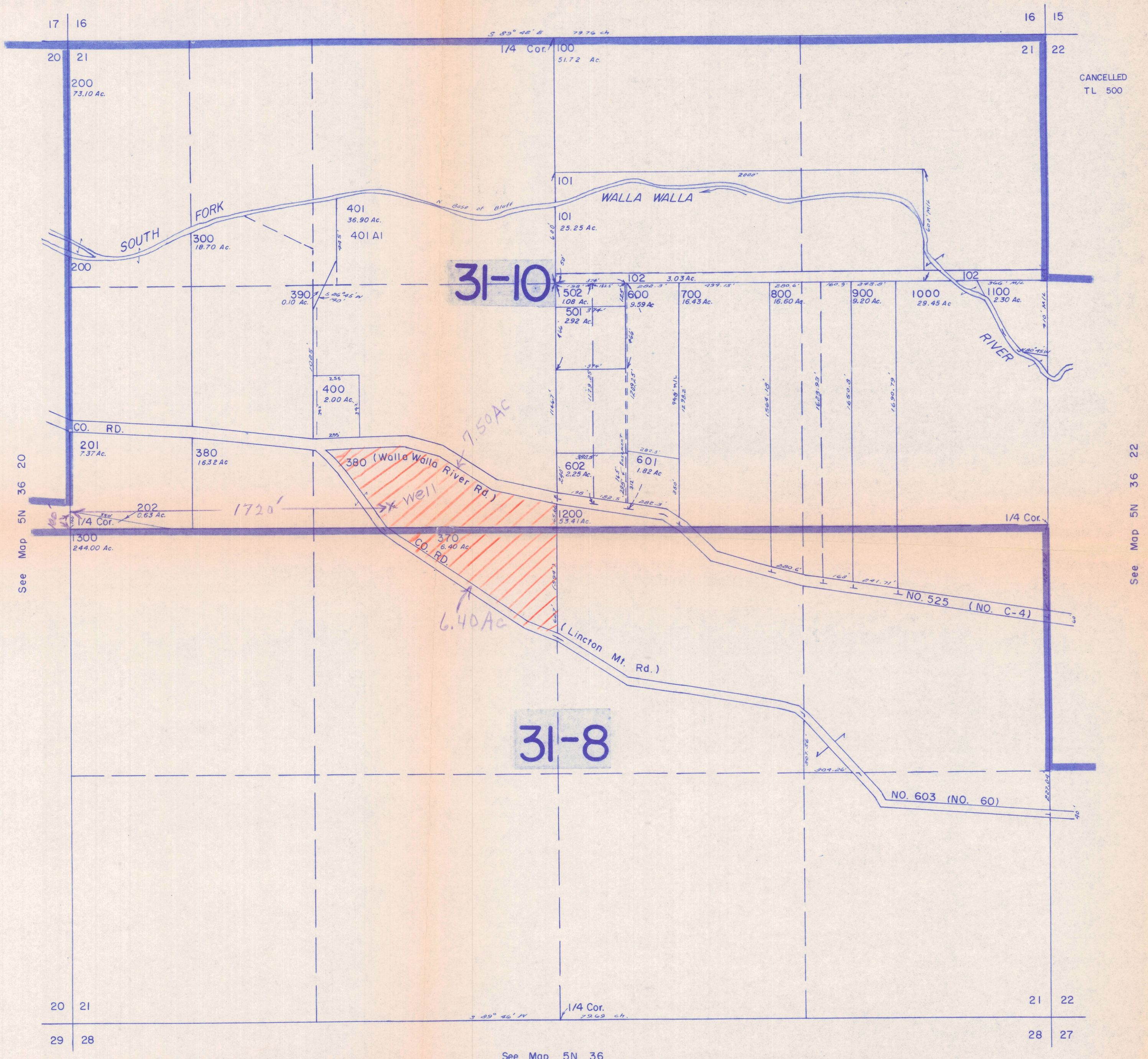
