Sometime ago, I discussed your proposed appropriation of water from a spring with Mrs. Becker by telephone. Mrs. Becker described the use of water from the spring as being within 3 4-plex units, each containing 4 families, and also use in a single family residence. She also indicated that water would be used from the spring around the house and the 3 4-plex units for irrigation of lawns and gardens.

Based upon the previous information you have provided, I have prepared a new map and a new application, which I hope describes your intended use of water.

If you agree with the new application, it should be signed by each of you on the space provided, and also you should sign the map indicating your approval.

The new application should be returned to this office along with the original application in order to maintain the priority date.

I am returning the original application along with the new one for your signatures. The application is endorsed so that in order to retain its priority date, it must be received in this office on or before April 5, 1976.

Your application for a permit to appropriate 013 cubic feet of water per second from an unnamed spring for domestic supplies (13) and one-half acre lawn and garden each was received along with the drawing prepared on tracing paper, description of spring sheet, legal description, and the original application form you submitted in June.

The fees of \$45.00 have been credited to your application which has been filed as No. 53390.

Will you please review the location of your proposed project. According to the legal description you submitted, your project would be located in the Southeast quarter of Section 8 instead of the Northwest quarter presently noted in Items No. 4, No. 5, and No. 8 on the application.

Since irrigation use will be listed as a separate use, the "one-half acre lawn and garden each" presently noted in Item No. 3 should be deleted and "irrigation" should be inserted instead. It will then be necessary for you to further state in Item No. 3 the amount of water you intend to appropriate for domestic supplies and the amount of water you intend to appropriate for irrigation purposes. The total should then be entered in Item No. 2.

The place of use of water for domestic supplies must also be listed in Item No. 8 with respect to the proper quarter-quarter sections. This may be accomplished by listing "domestic" under the column headed "Number acres to be irrigated" with respect to the proper fractional parts of the section.

Item No. 10 (b) on your application must be completed by stating the number of families to be supplied water. Item No. 11 should also be completed.

It will be necessary for you to supply additional information on your supporting map. The location of the spring must be shown by distances north or south and east or west from a government survey corner and be in agreement with the information to be supplied in Item No. 4. The location of the houses to be supplied water must be illustrated and the number of acres to be irrigated in each quarter-quarter section must be noted on the map and be in agreement with the information to be supplied in Item No. 8 of the application. The division lines between the quarter-quarter sections must be illustrated and the corners of the sections properly designated.

We will need a more complete description of the distribution facilities for the domestic supplies. This should be the same information as received by the State Health Division.

I am returning your application and map for correction and completion. The application is endorsed so that in order to retain its priority date, it must be received in this office on or before October 6, 1975.

Your application for a permit to appropriate an unspecified amount of water from a spring for the irrigation of an unspecified number of acre, domestic supplies for thirteen families, and/or business does not contain sufficient information, so could not be filed.

A permit, when issued, is simply approval of the application, so your application must describe the project you wish to carry out in sufficient clarity and in sufficient detail so it can be readily understood by anyone else with some technical knowledge of the subject.

I am enclosing our booklet of rules and regulations relative to the appropriation and use of surface water. This booklet briefly explains the entries to be made on the application and the requirements for the map. Unless you have had experience in preparing maps, it is advisable to secure technical assistance in drawing the required map and making the required entries on the application. A new fee schedule will be in effect July 1, 1975. You will be advised of any additional fees that may be required if your application is received after July 1.

I am returning your application, drawing, and legal description. The fees of \$45.00 you submitted have been placed in a pending account and will either be refunded or credited to an acceptable application.

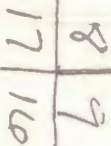
