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The Initial Review (IR) for our client, Bob Gabriel water right Application G-19461 was issued: June 27, 2025

To deny the requested rate of 1.10 cfs due to Potential for Substantial Interference (PSI) but noted if the rate was reduced to 0.672cfs a more favorable review would be likely.
