Mary Barton, Coos County treasurer, came to last week's Coos County board of commissioners meeting to get input about how to facilitate opening the records to the public. 1 . A. A. A.

Barton said the volumes had been transferred to the former law library building where Berning Crug Store was located. The books, which are large and cumbersome to move. are unwieldly due to their size. Barton said she was unsure of how to cess the books.
