County ponders plan to access historic

Historic tax records which could help to Coos County residents doing research on water rights should soon be available.

Mary Barton, Coos County treasurer, came to last week's Coos County board of commissioners meeting to get input about how to facilitate opening the records to the public.

Barton said the volumes had been transferred to the former law library building where Benson Drug Store was located. The books, which are large and cumbersome to move, are unwieldy due to their size. Barton said she was unsure of how to access the books. She told the com-

missioners there are 138 of the volumes and when some were put out on tables made of sawhorses, the weight of the books collapsed the tables.

The deadline for filing for the water rights is Dec. 31, but documentation can be done after Dec. 31, the commissioners pointed out.

Doc Stevenson and Jack Beebe said they would visit the building and help figure out a way for the public to access the records.

Natural gas project

The commission heard a report from Economic Development Director Loran Wiese on a proposed plan to bring natural gas to the Coos Bay area. The county has just spent over \$40,000 on a study to determine the best route to bring a natural gas pipe-

line from the I-5 corridor.

The urban renewal agency had determined that delivery of natural gas to the Coquille Valley and the Coos Bay area is critical to the growth of the economy.

In a letter to the board Wiese said, "it is our understanding that three large industrial users—Glenbrook Nickel, International Paper, and Weyerhaeuser—jointly with Northwest Pipeline could be extended to the Oregon coast." He said problems exist with the state over how rates will be determined.

Wiese said an Oregon PUC suggestion that charges for the line extensions be made on an incremental basis would have a negative effect on pipeline development.

Wiese explained that the lines could be paid for by establishing total costs and dividing all expenses among those being served—a system referred to as incremental. The other system is to have each user along the line pay for bringing the line from the last user—the roll in concept. He said that is the most common approach and is most fair.

The problem, as Wiese sees it, is the Oregon PUC has sent signals it prefers the incremental although that concept has never been used in Oregon. Wiese said it would "be too expensive" and would be detrimental to the completion of the project.

Stevenson told the audience he believes "it is important to Coos County to make natural gas avail-

Fair says it won't renew pavilion

The Coos County Fair Advisory board voted unanimously to discontinue its current lease with the city of Myrtle Point and School District 41 for use of the Oak Pavilion.

At its regular meeting, December 17, the fair board acted on a letter

The board agreed to allow continued use of the building so long as liability is shifted to the lessee. It also referred the responsibility to Ris to notify the lessors.

Ed Kreutzer, vice chairman of the advisory board, reported the wind storm Dec. 9 knocked down a tree that fell on the horticulture building. The board received a bid of \$913

Kreutzer of the storm cleanup.

Several board members reported from the Oregon State Fair Convention held Dec. 12-14 in Portland. Two specific subjects discussed were ways to improve merit grading so that all commissioners would be able to rate fairs without discrepancies and Gov. Barbara Roberts' proposed cut of racing funds

send board member Lou Ann Rode and her husband, John, to the Western Fairs Convention in Palm Springs, Calif. The board agreed to reimburse her up to \$250 for convention costs.

The advisory board decided unanimously to apply for an Oregon Economic Development grant to help the fair build a 60 by 200 foot
