Dear Ms. Johnson,

Enclosed is the copy of the Surface Water Registration and map we discussed.

The Surface Water Registration is on file with the Department and is considered a vested right by the Department. The Department recognizes the use, but will not regulate for or against it in water short years. A final determination as to the existence and extent of the right, if granted, will be made at the time the source of the domestic use is adjudicated.

In addition, if you are the current land owner for the lands involved in this registration, please provide the Department with a copy of the deed and legal description indicating your ownership along with your name, mailing address and phone number. Provide documentation that the water has been used over the past five years in accordance with the terms of the Surface Water Registration.

The Department is currently involved in the adjudication of the Klamath River where 728 claims were filed and over 5600 contests have been received against either the claim or the Department's preliminary finding. With limited staff, it is impossible to project a specific time when any additional adjudications will commence.
