This Extension of Time request is being processed in accordance with Oregon Revised Statute 537.230 and 539.010(5), and Oregon Administrative Rule Chapter 690, Division 315.

Appeal Rights

This final order is subject to judicial review by the Court of Appeals under ORS 183.482. Any petition for judicial review must be filed within the 60-day time period specified by ORS 183.482(1). Pursuant to ORS 536.075 and OAR 137-003-0675, you may petition for judicial review or petition the Director for reconsideration of this order. A petition for reconsideration may be granted or denied by the Director, and if no action is taken within 60 days following the date the petition was filed, the petition shall be deemed denied.

Application History

Permit S-55172 was issued by the Department on February 7, 1980. and modified by Permit Amendment T-7490 on <permit amendment issue date>. The permit specified completion of construction by October 1, 1981, and complete application of water to beneficial use by, October 1, 1982. The most recent extension authorized completion of construction and complete application of water to beneficial use by October 1, 2020. On July 25, 2024, Tierra Del Mar Water Co. submitted an Application for Extension of Time for Permit S-55172. In accordance with OAR 690-315-0050(2), on May 13, 2025, the Department issued a Proposed Final Order proposing to extend the time to complete construction from October 1, 1982, or October 1, 2020,

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to October 1, 2034, and the time to apply water to full beneficial use from October 1, 1982, or October 1, 2020, to October 1, 2034. The protest period closed June 27, 2025, in accordance with OAR 690-315-0060(1). No protest was filed.

FINDINGS OF FACT

Except as expressly stated herein, The Department adopts and incorporates by reference the findings in the Proposed Final Order dated May 13, 2025. Modifications to the Final Order are shown as follows: additions are shown in <u>underlined</u> text; deletions are shown in <u>strikethrough</u> text.

At time of issuance of the Proposed Final Order the Department concluded that, based on the factors demonstrated by the applicant, the permit may be extended subject to the following conditions:

LIMITATIONS AND CONDITIONS

1. Progress Report Submittal Condition:

This extension of time is conditioned to require the submittal of Progress Reports (Checkpoints) by October 1, 2029, and October 1, 2033. Failure to submit the Progress Report by the end of October of the years the Progress Reports are due shall result in the termination of this extension of time, and a Claim of Beneficial Use will be required no later than one year from the date the Progress Report was due.

2. Checkpoint Condition

The permit holder must submit a completed Progress Report Form to the Department by October 1, 2029, and 2033. A form will be enclosed with your Final Order.

- (a) At each checkpoint, the permit holder shall submit and the Department shall review evidence of the permit holder's diligence towards completion of the project and compliance with terms and conditions of the permit and extension. If, after this review, the Department determines the permit holder has not been diligent in developing and perfecting the water use permit, or complied with all terms and conditions, the Department shall modify or further condition the permit or extension to ensure future compliance, or begin cancellation proceedings on the undeveloped portion of the permit pursuant to ORS 537.260 or 537.410, or require submission of a final proof survey pursuant to ORS 537.250;
- (b) The Department shall provide notice of receipt of progress reports in its weekly notice and shall allow a 30 day comment period for each report. The Department shall provide notice of its determination to anyone who submitted comments.

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CONCLUSION OF LAW

The applicant has demonstrated good cause for the permit extension pursuant to ORS 537.230, 539.010(5) and OAR 690-315-0040(2).

ORDER

The extension of time for Application S-59355, Permit S-55172, therefore, is approved subject to conditions contained herein. The deadline for completing construction is extended from October 1, 2020, to October 1, 2034. The deadline for applying water to full beneficial use within the terms and conditions of the permit is extended from October 1, 2020, to October 1, 2034.
