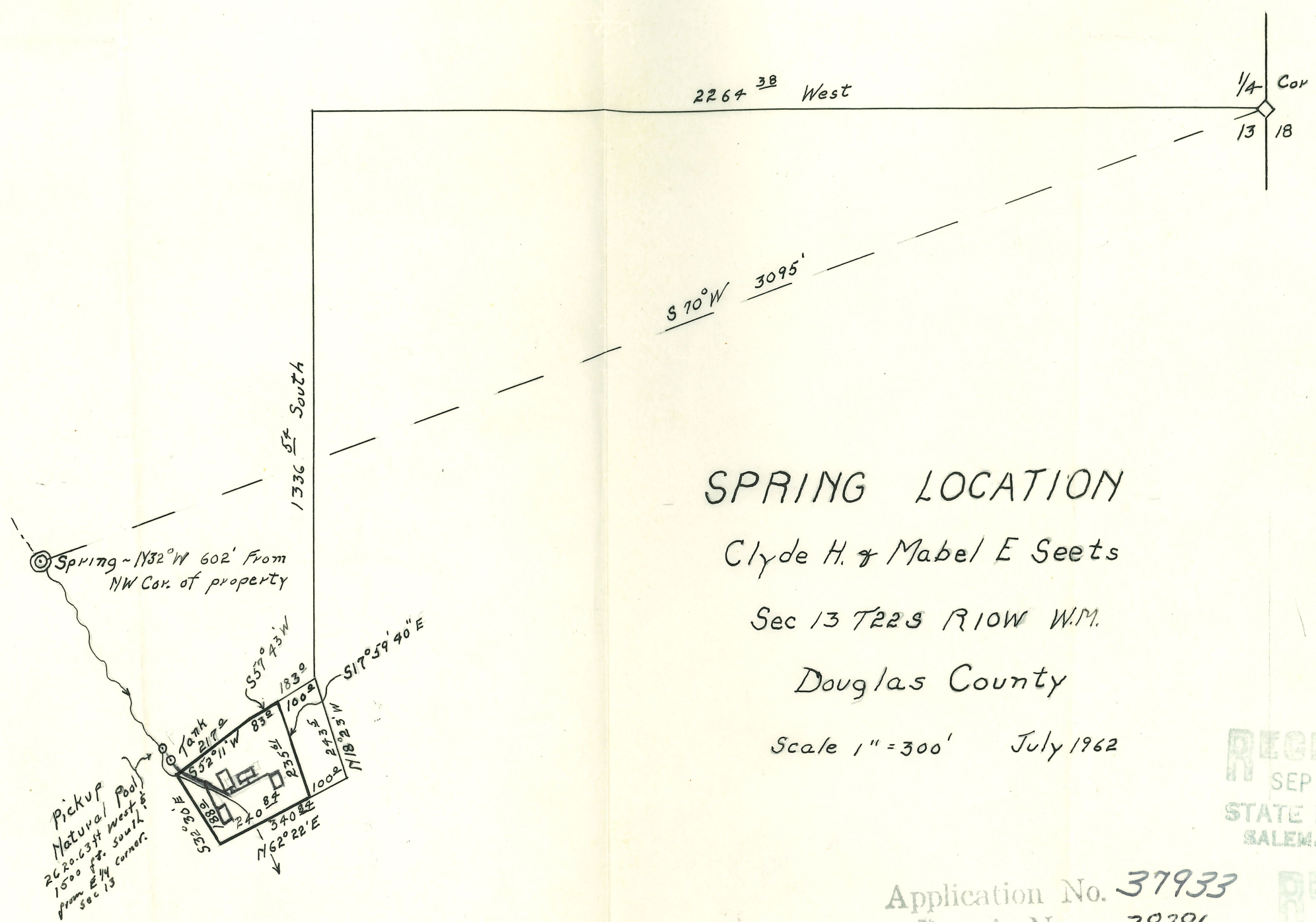

The application which was approved by permit number 28296 describes the proposal to make use of water for four families. Ownership of the land on which the water is to be used is not a requirement, so proof was made up for the four houses using water as found by the field engineer.

Dear Mr. Seets:

This will acknowledge receipt of your application for a permit to appropriate an unspecified quantity of water from an unnamed spring for the domestic use of 4 families, a tracing, and fees in the sum of \$10 for which our receipt numbered 34988 is enclosed.

Your application has been examined and filed under file number 37933. Before it may be considered for approval by issuance of a permit it must be completed as follows.

Item One: The map accompanying your application shows the appropriation to be from a stream rather than a spring. A spring is that point at which the water first arises from the ground. As soon as the water flows from this point it becomes a stream. Your application and the map must be in agreement.

Item Two: The quantity of water you intend to appropriate must be specified.

Item Eight: The quarter quarter section within which the water will be used must be identified.

Map: The map accompanying your application must show the location of each house where water will be used. The general location of the pipe line from the point of diversion to each place of use must be indicated.

Legal Description: A legal description of the property upon which the water will be used must accompany the application. The description should be copied word for word from the deed, abstract, title insurance policy, or sales contract.

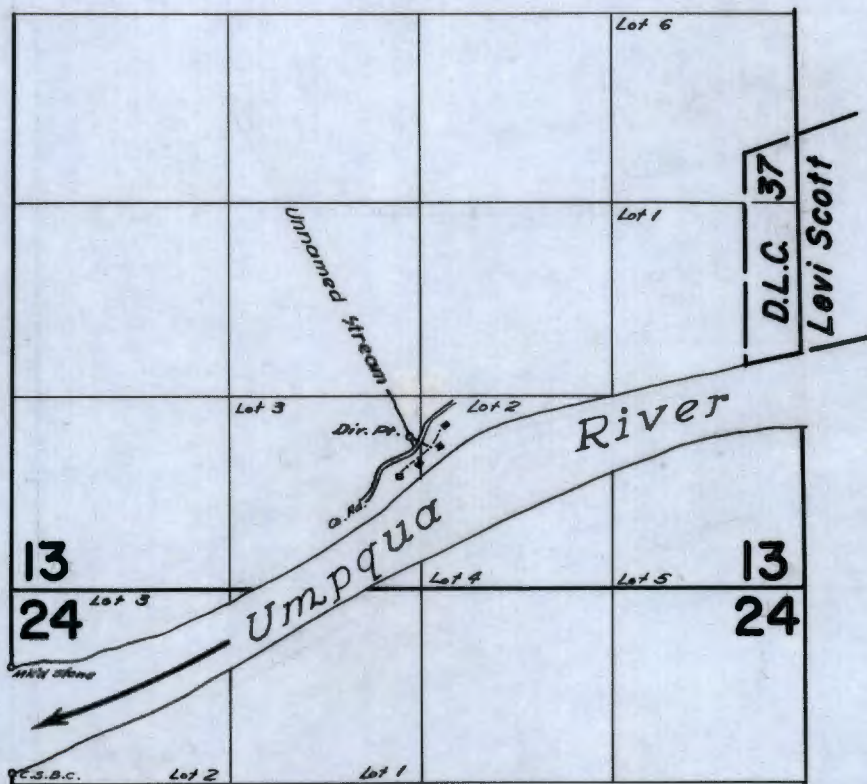

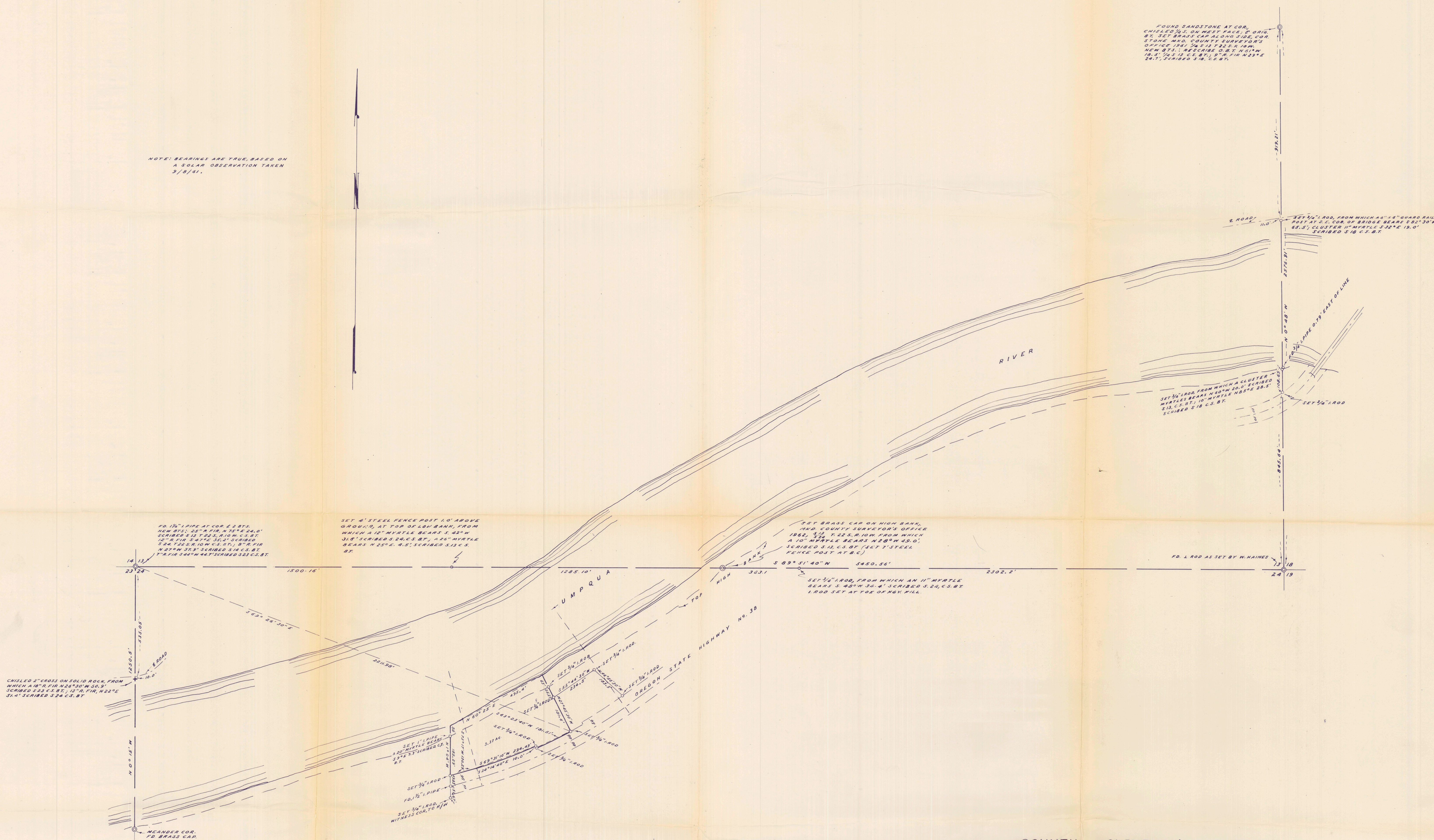
