# SITE REPORT FOR WILSEY RANCH

A site inspection of the water uses was made by me, Ralph W. Swinehart, on November 9, 1993. Ground was lightly covered with snow at time of inspection. The water uses applied for are from 8 springs on the ranch, which flow off the property to drainages of the Grande River at least part of the year, according to the owner.

Spring No. 1 consists of a 3 ft diameter concrete pipe cistern in a field, which has a 1 inch pipe running northeasterly to an old trough at the edge of the field. The trough was not connected at this time and the area around the end of the pipe was swampy. Flow could not be determined at this time.

Spring No. 2 serves the main ranch house complex. It consists of an 8 ft long by 6 ft wide concrete cistern in a fenced off section of pasture. There was about 4 ft of water in the cistern at this time, but no overflow. A pipe runs northwesterly to the main house, which is at a slightly lower elevation. A 3/4 hp Jacuzzi pump rated at 12 gpm at 40 psi is located in the basement of this house. This house has a 100 ft by 125 ft yard (.3 ac) which is irrigated from the spring. The spring presently serves as a supplemental water source to this house, which also has a domestic well as its primary water supply. The cistern also contains a 3/4 hp submersible pump rated at 12 gpm and 40 psi, which supplies water to a mobile home southwesterly from the This home has a 90 ft by 145 ft (.3 ac) yard and garden cistern. which is irrigated from this spring as its sole supply.

Spring No. 3 has a small pond built over it. The pond is about 40 ft wide by 110 ft long and is 4 ft deep. It can store about .2 acre ft. This pond is used for stock water. There is evidence of a house site southwest of the present pond, which originally used water from this spring before the pond was built.

Spring No. 4 has a small pond built over it. The pond is triangular shaped with a dam about 150 ft wide; the pond is about 150 ft long, has a maximum depth of about 6 ft, and stores about .5 acre ft. There are remnants of an old house southwest of the pond, which formerly used water from this spring before the pond was built.

Spring No. 5 has a small pond built over it. The pond is about 70 ft wide and 100 ft long, is about 4 ft deep, and stores about .2 ac. ft. There are remains of an old house west of this pond which formerly used this spring as its water supply.

Spring No. 6 is about 33 ft from an old house which is still standing, and 69 ft from a power pole. It flows 2 gpm in November and is used only for stock water at the present time, although it formerly was the water supply for this house, which is no longer occupied.

Spring No. 7 has a pond built over it which is 45 ft wide, 100 ft long, 6 ft deep, and stores about .2 ac. ft. There are several old homestead buildings and an orchard in the vicinity which formerly used this spring as water supply. Present use of the spring is for stock water.

Spring No. 8 is located about 25 ft from an old homestead smokehouse. The remainder of the homestead building are no longer existing. This spring formerly provided water for a house, livestock, and orchard on this site. There is an old log trough near the spring which was formerly filled by the spring. Current stock water use is directly from the spring area, which flows about 1 gpm in late season.

This final proof survey and inspection of the use for a Pre-1909 water right application was completed by me on November 9, 1993 and the facts contained in this report and accompanying final proof map are correct to the best of my knowledge Water Right Free Water Right Free
