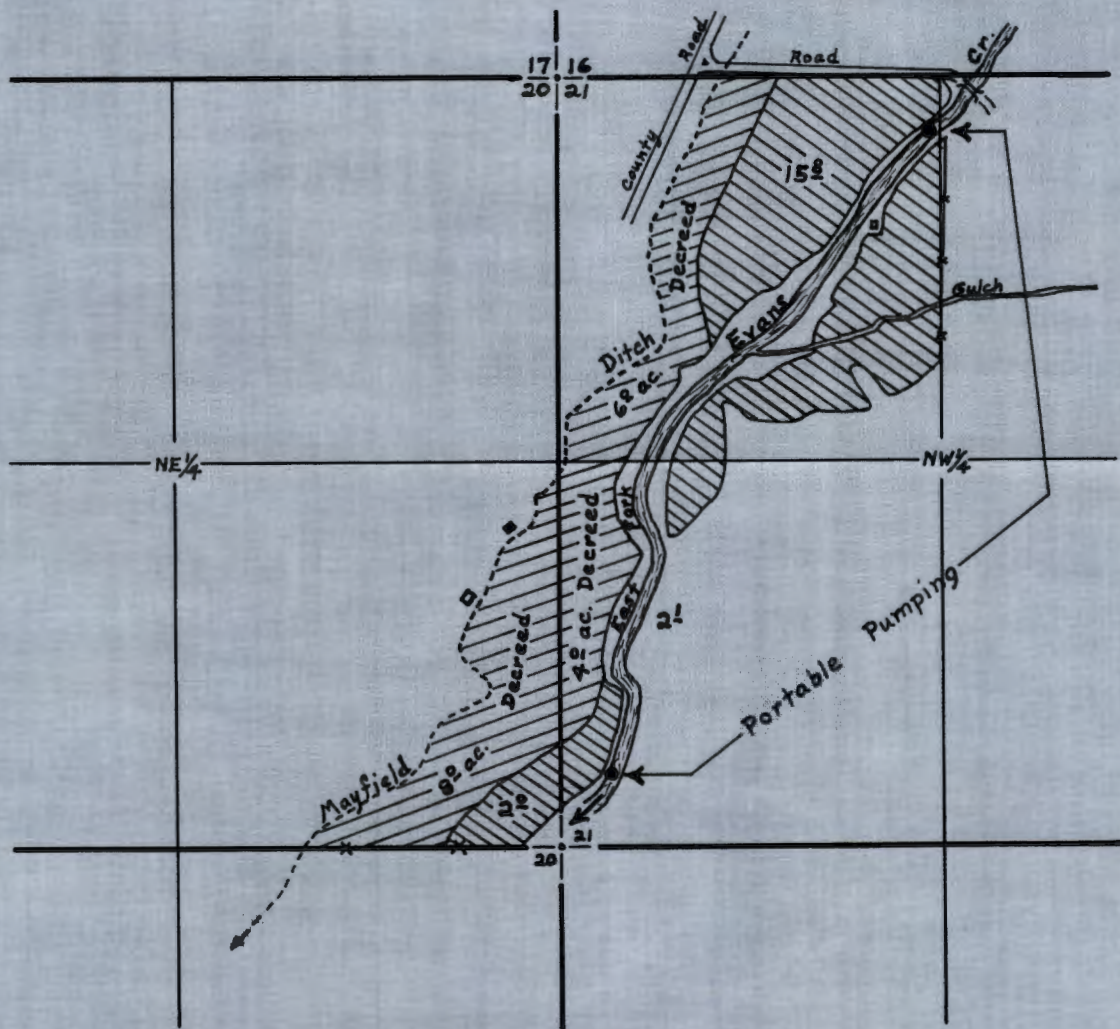

CERTIFICATE OF WATER RIGHT

This Is to Certify, That **A. B. SINGLER**

of **5343 Table Rock Rd., Central Point**, State of **Oregon**, has made proof to the satisfaction of the **STATE ENGINEER** of Oregon, of a right to the use of the waters of **East Fork Evans Creek** a tributary of **Evans Creek (Rogue River)** for the purpose of **irrigation of 19.9 acres**

under Permit No. **20422** of the State Engineer, and that said right to the use of said waters has been perfected in accordance with the laws of Oregon, that the priority of the right hereby confirmed dates from **July 9, 1951**

that the amount of water to which such right is entitled and hereby confirmed, for the purposes aforesaid, is limited to an amount actually beneficially used for said purposes, and shall not exceed **0.25 cubic foot per second**

or its equivalent in case of rotation, measured at the point of diversion from the stream. The point of diversion is located in the **SW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$ & NW $\frac{1}{4}$ NW $\frac{1}{4}$, Section 21, T. 34 S., R. 2 W., W.M.**

The amount of water used for irrigation, together with the amount secured under any other right existing for the same lands, shall be limited to **one-eightieth** of one cubic foot per second per acre, or its equivalent for each acre irrigated and shall be further limited to a diversion of not to exceed **$4\frac{1}{2}$ acre feet per acre** for each acre irrigated during the irrigation season of each year,

and shall conform to such reasonable rotation system as may be ordered by the proper state officer.

Please be advised that according to the terms of your permit, actual construction work preparatory to the use of the water was to have been commenced on or before November 16, 1952, and completed on or before October 1, 1953.

To date, we have not received any notices from you as to the dates for beginning or completion of construction and it is therefore not in good standing according to our records.

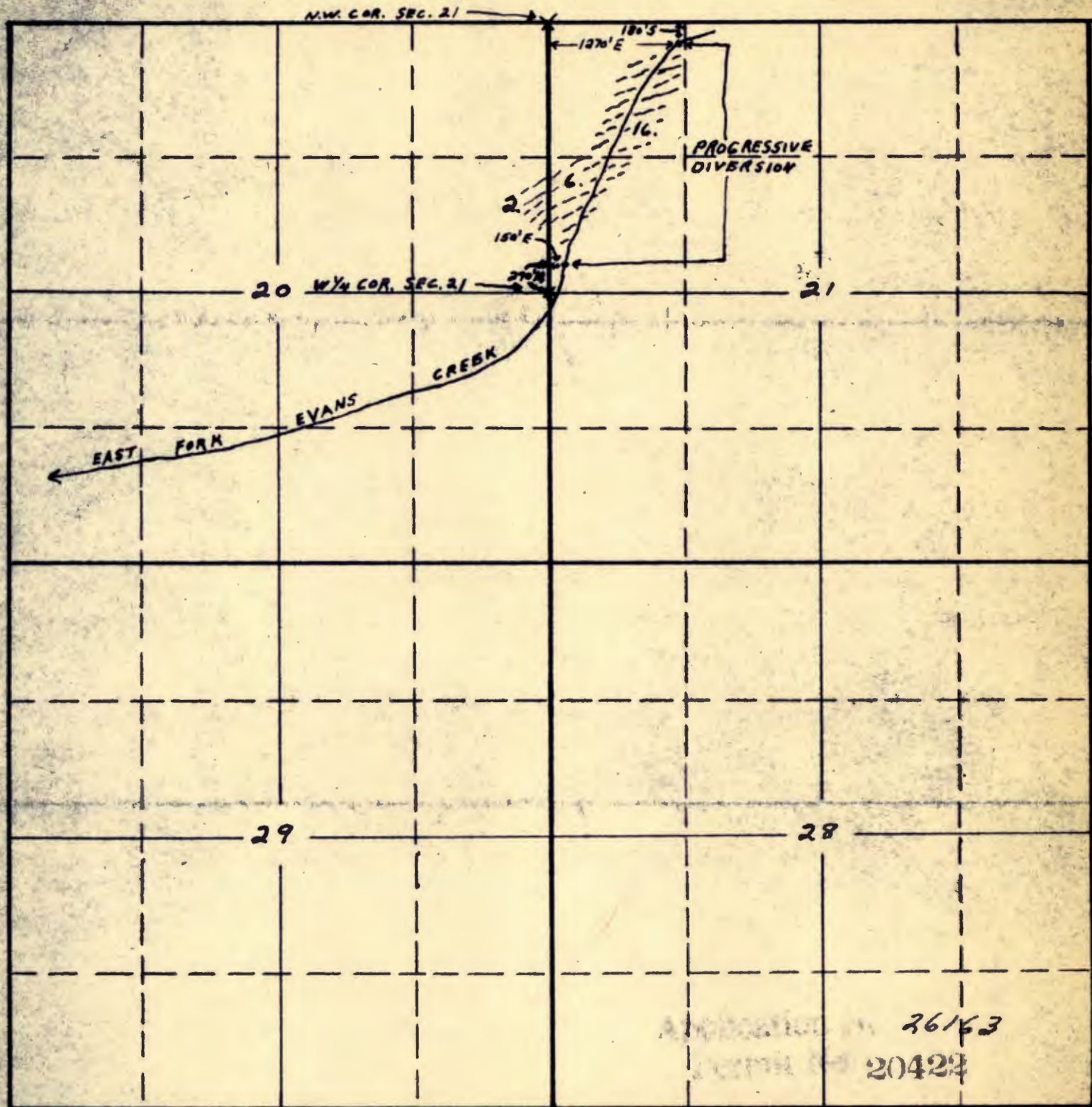

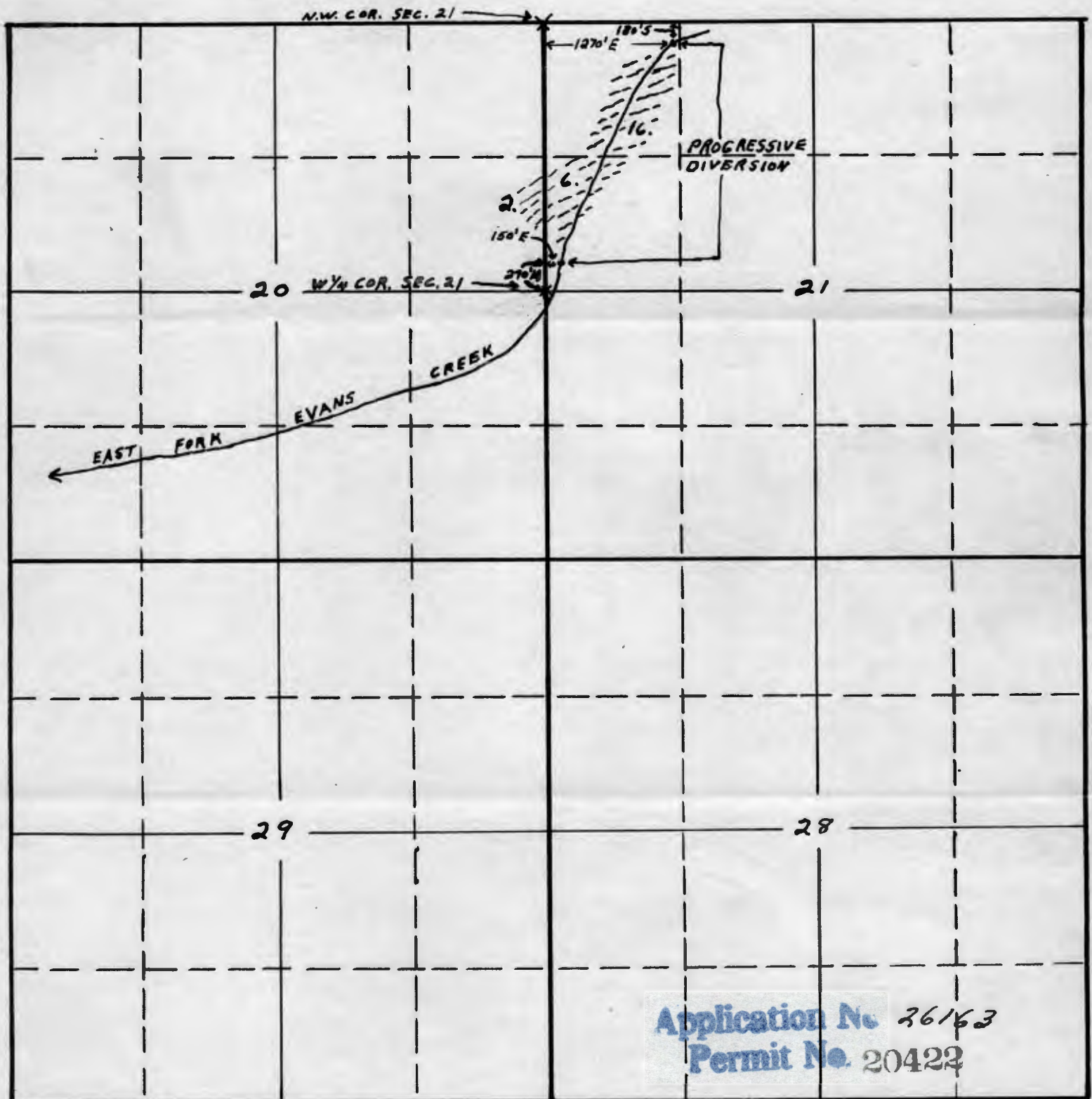
SECTIONS 20 & 21, T 34 S., R. 2 W., W. 11.
