This will acknowledge receipt of an application for a permit to appropriate 0.01 cubic foot of water per second for domestic use and 0.01 cubic foot of water per second for stock watering and the operation of a dairy, a transparency and one print of a county assessor plat, spring description sheet, and the fee of \$25 for which our receipt No. 10711 is enclosed. The stock watering use and washing of barns and operation of dairy would be considered two separate types of uses. Therefore, a separate quantity of water should be specified for each of these two uses in item No. 2.
