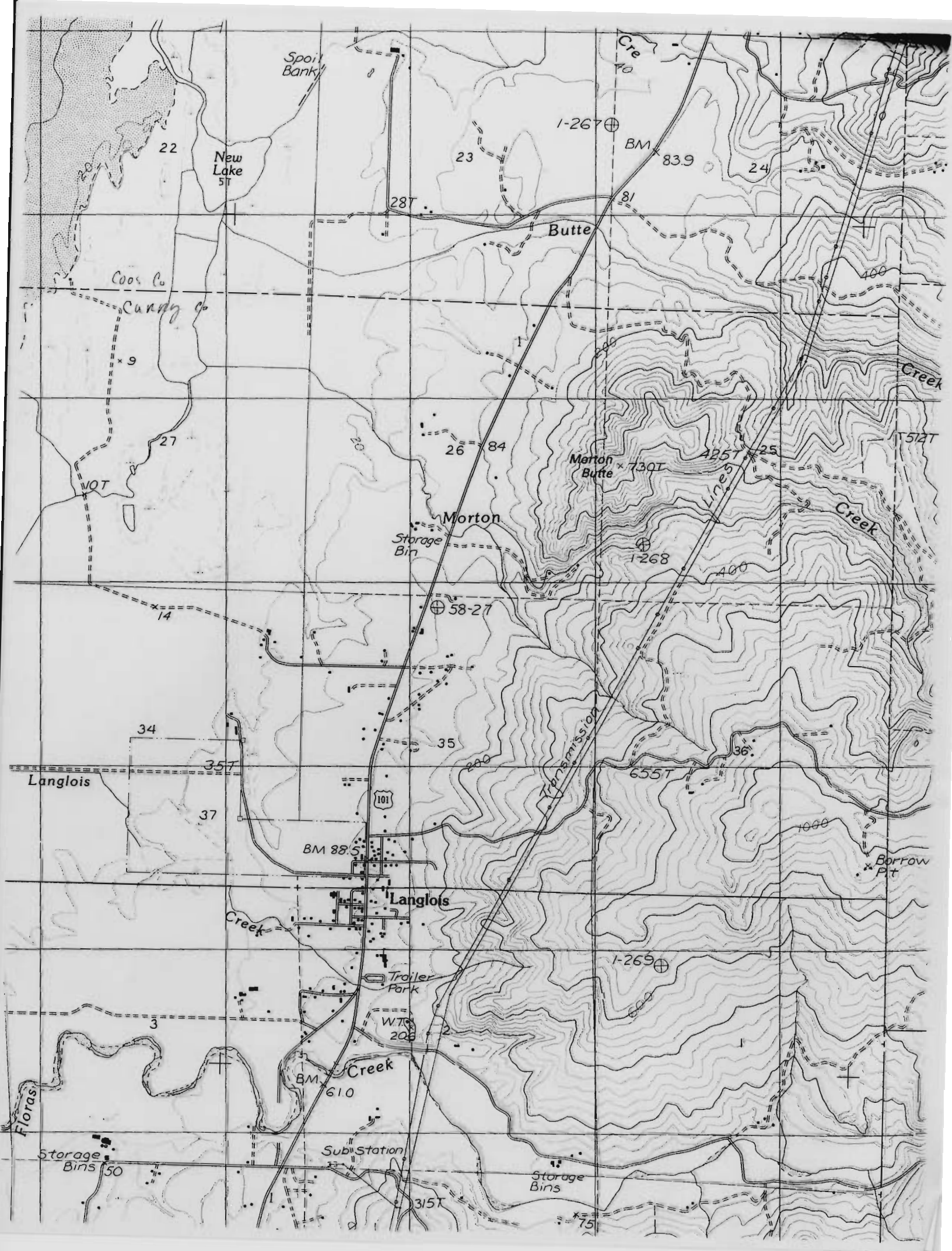

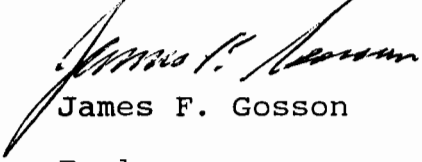

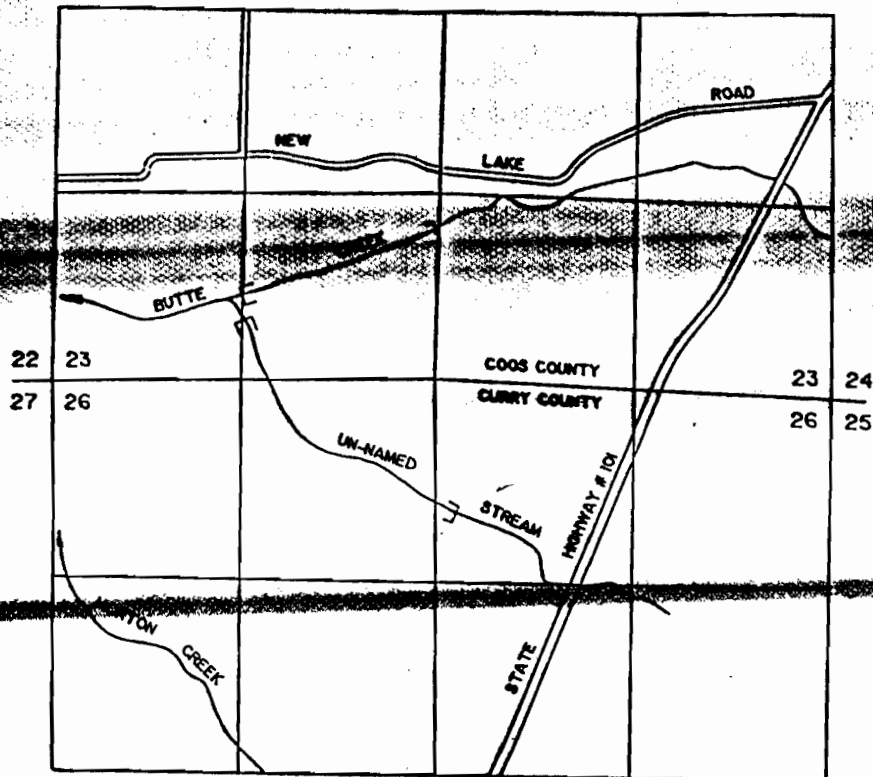

SECTIONS 23 & 26, TOWNSHIP 30 SOUTH, RANGE 15 WEST, W.M.



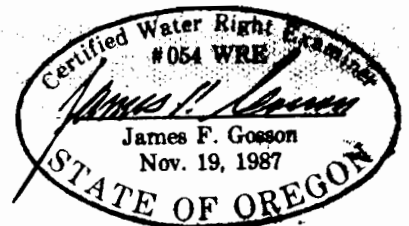

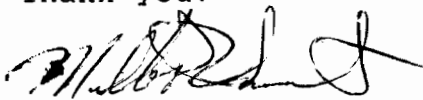

My name is Reed Adelbert Gallier, Jr.

I am a nephew of Edmund Gallier, deceased, and his wife Edith Gallier, deceased, who was the daughter of Wallace Pomeroy and who had a dairy on New Lake Road, West of Highway 101 (then Roosevelt Highway).

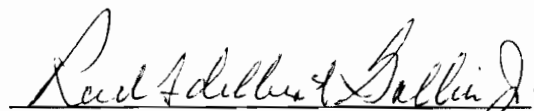
In 1929, when I was an 8-year old boy my mother and father operated a restaurant in Bandon, Oregon. Because of the demands of the business on their time they would send me down to Mr. Pomeroy's dairy to stay with him on weekends and during the summer. I remember I would "get in" the cows (Jerseys) in the dark and we would milk them, putting the milk in cans on a platform out by the road where they would be picked up by the "milk truck".

I remember part of my duties was to clean the manure out of the barn. We then milked again in the evening.

I recall that my Aunt Edith used to tell stories about how she had to help with the milking and the chickens in the early morning before they saddled her horse for her ride to school in Langlois. She also was required to assist with the evening milking. I remember this to be remarkable because she was only 9 years old. She was born in 1901.

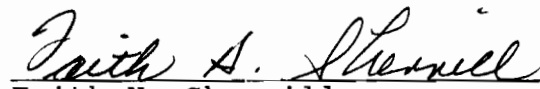
When I was there in the summer I recall helping with the haying and manure spreading on the pastures. Mr. Pomeroy had a brother who had a dairy about a quarter section to the West, which cornered on a section corner.

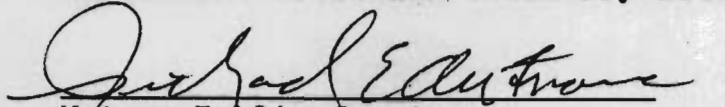

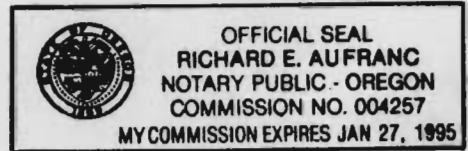

My husband, the late Paul Smith, and I bought the remainder of the Wallace Pomeroy property from Art Aldropp. Aldropp had sold part of the property before we contraced to buy in 1951.

Wallace Pomeroy homesteaded this property in 1902. I have lived in this areas all my life and knew and went to school with neices and nephews of Mr. Pomeroy. I visited Wallace with these "kids" and horses and cows were on place.

After we got this place, Court Guerin, Wallace's brother in law, visited us and told us he helped Wallace build the barn. Court said he helped Wallace with his hay almost every year; this was before tractors and balers. Horses were used exclusively. We have the hay fork that was used to pull the hay into the mow.

Mr. Pomeroy had livestock on this place until he sold the stock and farm to Clayton. Aldropp did not milk but leased the farm to Ted Bierman. We bought the milk cows with the place then either sold or traded the dairy cows for beef stock. We have had livestock on the place from 1951 to the present time.

Unfortunately, all three different cheese factories in this area that received milk from this place have all burned so no milk records are available. The farmers income and living from this farm have been from livestock and it has been operated as a farm since it was first homesteaded by Wallace Pomeroy in 1902.

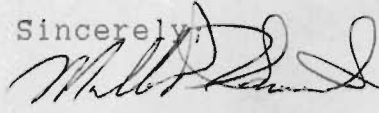

This letter is in verification that the area in question had livestock on the property several years prior to 1909, as well as, on the adjoining farms.

My father, Milton F. Brown, told me why his thumb joints were enlarged and had calluses on them.

When he was ten years old in the summer of 1903, he worked for Wallace Pomeroy for three months. Mr. Pomeroy had a farm on the New Lake Road and some of the duties my father had were milking cows. The older boys told Dad "men" milked "Swiss fashion" which is pressing the bent thumb against the teats.

After my father learned how to milk on the Pomeroy farm, he milked for other farmers in the area. His thumb joints remained enlarged and callused all his life but no longer sore and blistered like they were when he started milking for Pomeroy.

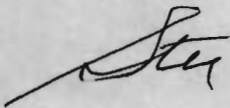
I wish I could recollect enough specifically to help.

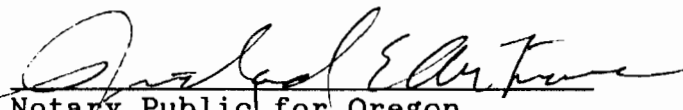

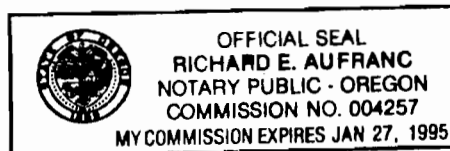
